
Dear Cousins & Fellow Researchers:

Seeking information on the following Bates family: Martha Bates daughter of Solomon and Martha Bates. Martha was born 27 Mar 1735 in CT. She married Elisha Cone on 26 May 1756 in Haddam, CT. She died 18 Feb 1823 in Middlefield, CT. Martha and Elisha had 6 children: Solomon, Hannah, Lydia, Joshua, Elisha, and Daniel.

Desire contact with anyone knowing of the family of James Edward Bates born Oct 1852 probably in LA. He left LA for TX, with a John Whittington, about 1870. He married Tabitha Pruett (daughter of Sarah Ann Leatherman and Jacob Pruett formerly of Claiborne Parish, LA) 25 Jun 1874 in Milam Co., TX. They had one daughter, Rose. James died Sep 1876.
