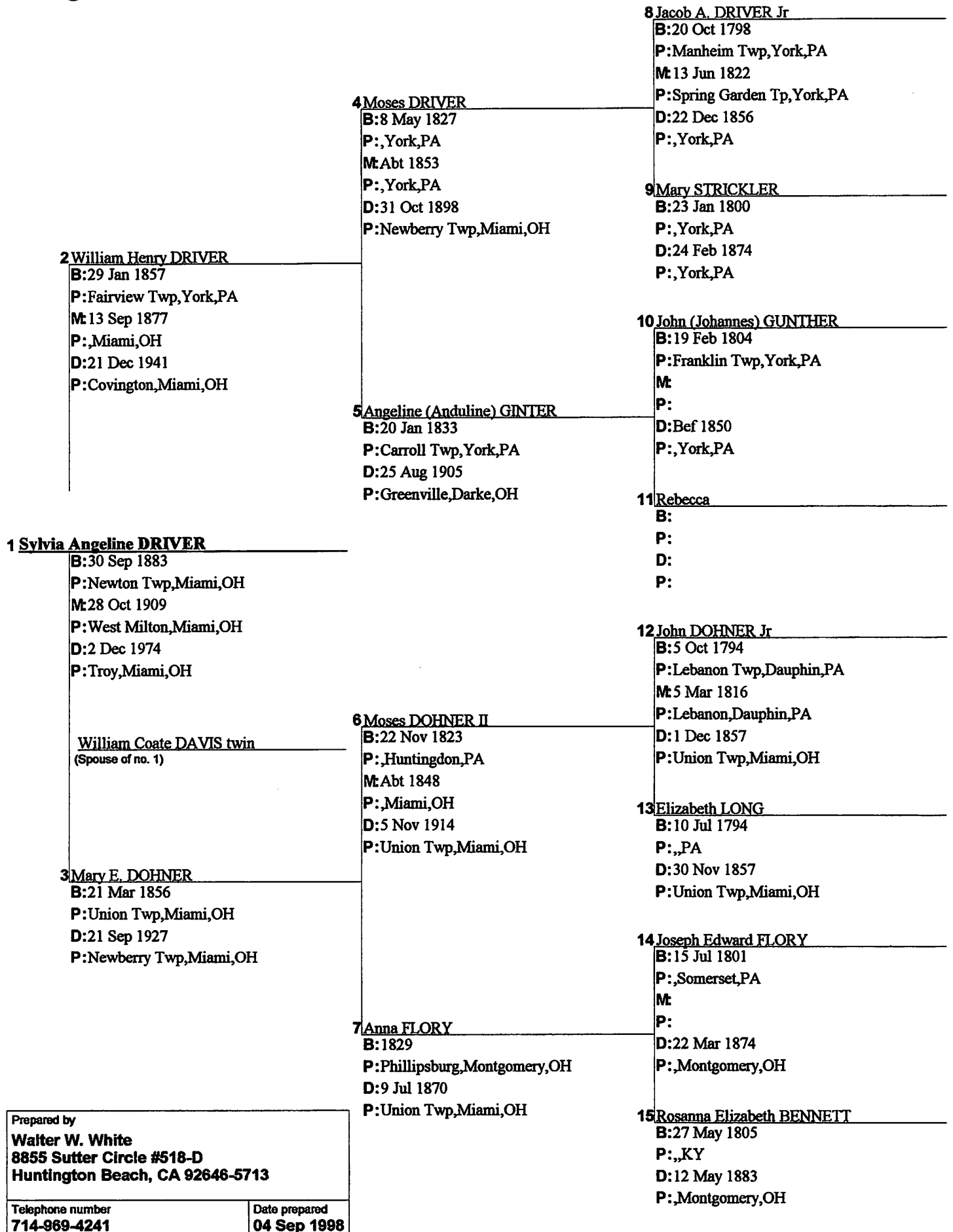

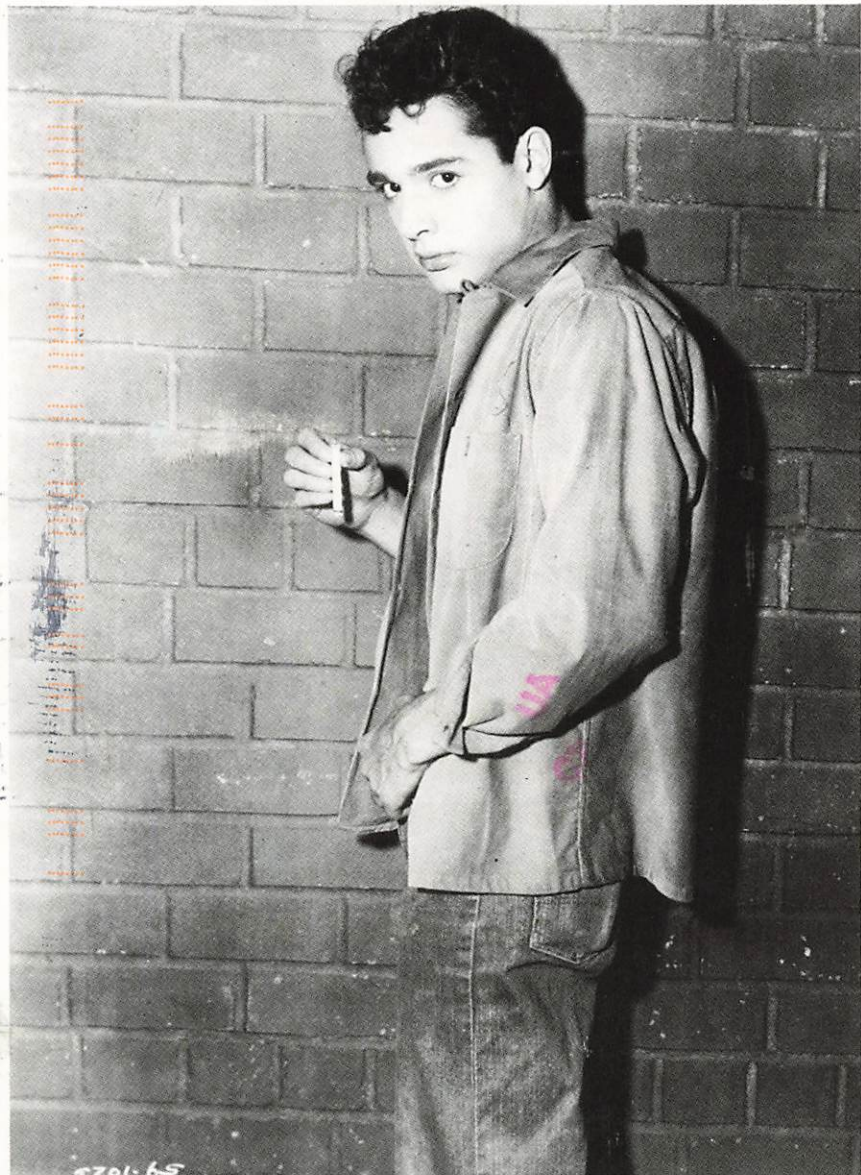


Pedigree Chart

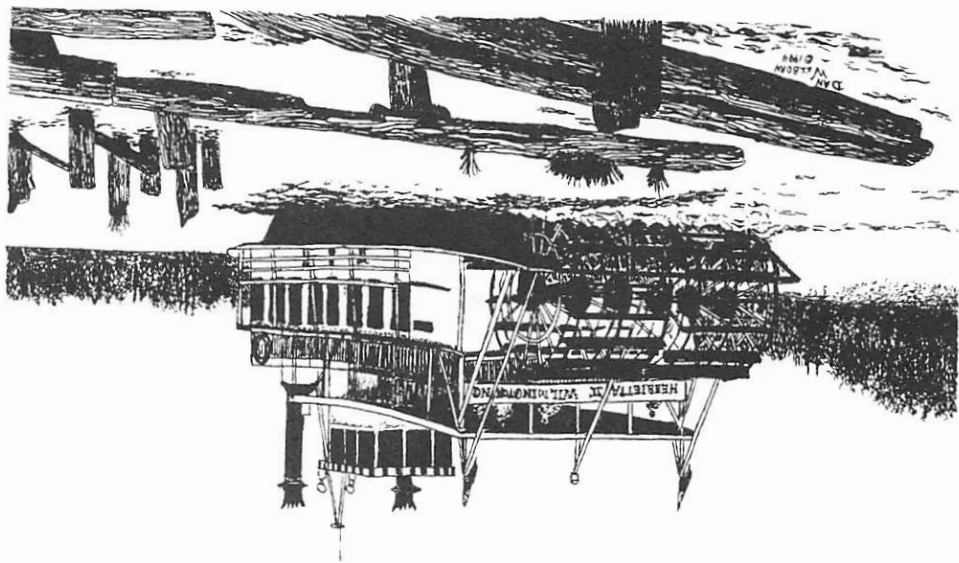
Dear Louisa James,

And, where to obtain form + address to send for social security records if deceased?

If Norton is deceased I would like to do this but how do I find out what state he died?

I plan to somehow access census records around here + try to trace Norton

whereabouts since 1920 census you sent. Do I first locate his name, or do I go state by state + look down lists? I plan to start with Fort Wayne, Ind. since that is where he was in 1920. It is also possible, I suppose, that he was adopted (eventually) by his stepfather, Harold Stewart, (listed on 1920 census).

Any "tips" you can give me as to how to search are appreciated. Again, thanks for your efforts. There's a small token of my appreciation - I'll send

The enclosed article is about my dad - I found him in Ohio! Unfortunately, he died last year, but I have had two really wonderful phone conversations with his 4th! wife Pauline. She sent me photos and this article. I have 3 sibs (half-sibs) who all live in the Washington DC area. Pauline told one of them about me & hopefully the rest of them know by now. I haven't approached them yet, but will probably do so by letter. (They must be in shock!)

I sent Pauline photos and the children's book I put together. And guess what? Pauline is a Mormon, so the family tree & family connections are important to her. Morton had told Pauline that he had another child "out there somewhere." Morton wasn't a Mormon... His life was music and after he retired, ^{from the army} he moved back to Ohio which is where he met Pauline. Sgt. Morton Croy Wheaton Resident's Work Is Played By Army Band

An original symphonic composition, written by Montgomery County resident, Sgt. Morton A. Croy, was presented by the U. S. Army Band at a recent Watergate symphony.

"I've been arranging music for the band for 17 years," Croy said, "but this is the first time one of my own compositions has been presented to the public."

A professional musician since 1927, Croy has been a member of the regular army since 1942. A resident of Montgomery County for eight years, living at 2700 Arvin St., Wheaton, the soldier-musician is also on the circulation staff of The Sentinel.

Public presentation of "The Battle," Croy's symphonic poem that is one of a six-part suite he is currently writing, was in honor of the three days of the Battle of Gettysburg, July 1-3, 1863. Maj. Samuel Loboda conducted the 75-piece U. S. Army Band presentation.

Croy, tall, rangy and Indiana-born, played the piano at

the age of 10, but four years later found the trombone more to his liking. "I turned pro when I was 19," according to Croy, "and played trombone and arranged music for vaudeville, stage bands, road shows and a lot of dance bands you probably wouldn't remember."

He referred to such notable "old timers" as Red Nichols, Charles Teagarden, Ted Fio Rito, Ray Noble and Ace Briggode. He says casually he has done arranging for Eddie Fisher, Steve Lawrence, Kay Armen, Bill Darnell. Operatic greats, Thomas L. Thomas, Leontyne Price and Frank Poretta have also sung his arrangements, he adds.

His varied musical background includes directing Baptist, Lutheran and Presbyterian choirs in the Washington met-

ropolitan area for 10 years. And he sang in the Washington National Cathedral Choir in 1950.

"I tried to enlist in the Marines when World War II broke out," Croy said, "but my eyesight wasn't good enough. The Navy Band at Great Lakes Naval Base at Chicago had all the musicians they needed, so I just waited until the Army drafted me in 1942."

Croy is something of an international musical diplomat. He has arranged, for American band and orchestral instruments, hundreds of foreign folk tunes and national anthems, which are played at social functions, diplomatic affairs, parades and national holidays. Thus, U. S. Army bands all over the world have helped create good will towards America for her interest in foreign music.

"What really excites me right now," Sgt. Croy says, "is this six-part suite I'm working on. 'The Blue and the Gray,' written for symphonic band, with chorus and narrator, is a massive work, a kind of musical documentary of the Civil War years."

Karl Eigsti, formerly with the U. S. Army Band, now a Fulbright scholar studying in England, wrote the narration, and Maj. Loboda supplied many of the choral arrangements. The band music and some of the chorus work is being composed and arranged by Croy.

The narrator opens part one of "The Blue and the Gray," by stating, "This was the century . . . when a front yard, suddenly, tragically, became a battle field, and a corn field became a grave."

This was probably published in the early 1960s in a Washington DC area paper.

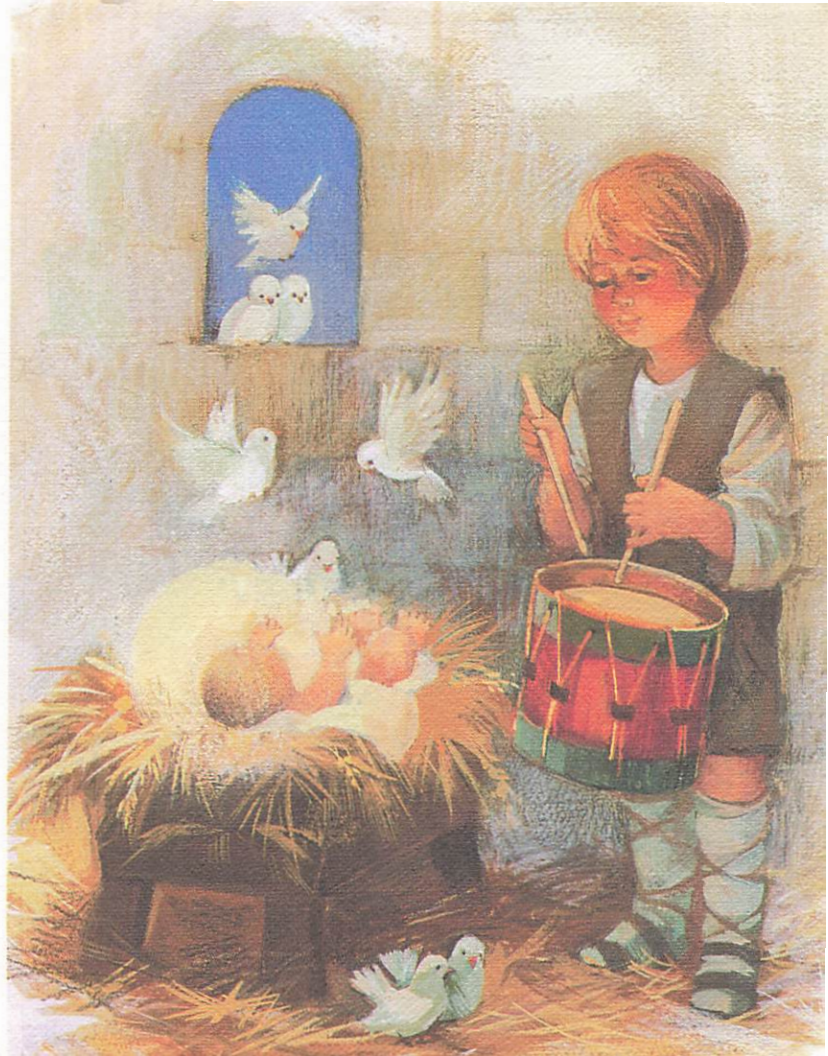

1781. VT gained statehood in 1791) Since Ephraim died after
VT became a state, maybe that's why death certificate says "VT."

It still seems possible to me that Ephraim on pg.
73 in Banvard's book had ^{the} Knott's wife in between
marriages to Elij Ball (m 1764) + Sarah Reed (m. 1820). It
makes sense, too, when I think that, assuming Elij Ball
was 20 when ^{she} married in 1764, she would have been 53 years
old when Lucy was born in 1797. (Their 53 is older than
the average life expectancy was then.) Elij. Knott could be ^{the} TRUE wife #2!

Another idea I had was that maybe the Lucy born
in 1805 was named after ^{her} sister, Lucy, who died in 1797.
Wasn't it a common practice to ^{use} name more than once, if children
died?

I ~~think~~ Banvard's research may have some errors in it,
but maybe he isn't too far off. It might be worth checking
Rev. War records of Ephraim on pg. 73, or other leads from that
page. Re: Foxbury records, I really hesitate to go to Fox-
bury because some of the area is very dangerous + think
you should be aware of this, too. Also, the librarian at New
England Gen. Society said it wouldn't help. So, I hope you can
make inquiry by mail to NEHGS + get their advise as to what
records are now - maybe NEHGS knows. A lot of churches
around here combined with others, or closed down. I do know
that Old South Church in Boston gave ^{many of} their books to the Boston
Public library as they couldn't care for them properly. Their books
are now in rare book collection here. The Bos. Public library, by the
way, is a very good library + may be of help to you too. as they have a
genealogy section. If I can help let me know + also send what you
do know about your Ephraim line as far back as you can. I didn't have
that info.

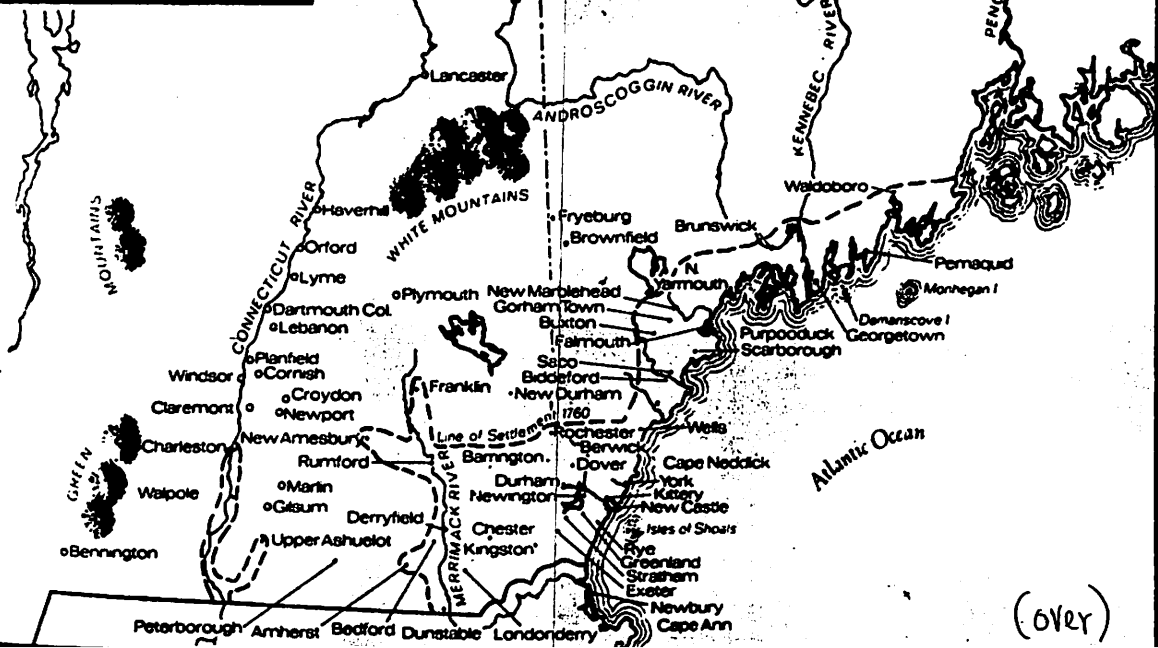
Northern New England in 1760

BIBLE OF PAUL CHAMPLIN

The Bible of Paul Champlin of Middlebury VT may be very old hat to Vermonters interested in the Champlins -- but perhaps not. I was ecstatic when I got it -- my cousin dug it out of a carton of "junk" after the death of my aunt, Esther Smith Wherry in Middlebury VT. The family had moved, way back, to Wisconsin, then to Missouri, then to New York. Esther Wherry was the only one ever to live in Vermont. The copy is handwritten and unsigned, but I am certain it was written by Georgette Smith Long, daughter of Hiram Claudius Smith, son of Peter Perry Smith and Esther Champlin Smith of Manitowoc, Wisc. Esther Champlin Smith was the daughter of Hiram Hyde Champlin (son of Paul of Middlebury) and Almira Boardman Champlin (born in Fairfield Vermont, daughter of Amos Boardman (who died in Corinth Vermont) and Prudence Chapman Boardman). I have copied verbatim.

"Given to me April 1907 by my Grandmother Esther A. Champlin Smith.

"The above named Paul Champlin the eldest of his fathers four sons Paul Hallam James and Silas was married to Esther eldest of Joshua Hyde's two daughters Esther and Lucy Dec. 25 1797. My mothers name was Elizabeth Turner daughter of Payne and Abigail Turner -- was married and lived in New London Connecticut until 1782. My wife's mother's maiden name was Esther daughter of Captain Nathaniel and Esther Everts of Salisbury Connecticut -- She was married and lived in Salisbury until 1783 when with her husband Joshua Hyde and family they moved to Middlebury Vermont.

"My grandfather Champlin's given name was James --his wife's maiden name was Prudence Hallam they were married lived and died in Rhode Island.

"Copied from Paul Champlin's Bible by Esther Champlin Smith his granddaughter in 1891. Bible was then in the possession of her Uncle James Porter Champlin son of Paul Champlin."

If this Bible record is of interest, I am glad. I hope someone will be able to tell me who Paul Champlin's father was. He has been omitted for some reason.

COMPILATIONS OF RECORDS HAVING SOME REFERENCE TO VERMONT

When these records are read, be sure to keep in mind that Sterling was part of the mother-town of Lancaster, Mass. until 1781 when it became incorporated as a separate town. When this area became established as a Parish in 1744, it was known as the Chocksett Parish, or the 2nd precinct of Lancaster. While Chocksett was a parish of Lancaster, all records were recorded in Lancaster, as they are found in the "Register of Births, Marriages & Deaths", edited by Henry S. Nourse (1890).

The Rev John Mellen, graduate of Harvard College, was the 1st ordained minister of Chocksett Parish. He kept no records of death, but merely placed an asterisk in front of a given list of members of the church, indicating that they had deceased. No dates of death were ever recorded by him. Intentions of marriage & actual marriages are interspersed with Lancaster records, therefore one has to look for names in the index for above records, then note by whom the couple was married. Sometimes Rev Mellen's marriage records are listed under his name, but often Chocksett people may have selected a Lancaster minister to perform the ceremony.

The first minister's records are few between 1774 & 1783 for he was kept out of his Parish Church by members who considered him to be a Loyalist. Therefore Rev Mellen met with his loyal parishoners in his home for various types of services, & he did report some vital records to the Lancaster Church after his dismissal. The legal separation of this minister from his church took a number of years to settle.

In 1779 the second minister was ordained. He was Rev Reuben Holcomb, from Conn. & a graduate of Yale. Around 1813/14 when Mr Holcomb asked to be dismissed from his duties as Pastor, there were a series of interim ministers who did not leave any records. Many members joined other churches and their baptisms and marriages may be found in such towns as Bolton, Harvard, West Boylston, Boylston, Holden, Leominster and Princeton. This causes some difficulty in researching family lines.

A few years ago a personal record book used by both Rev Mellen & Rev Holcomb, was found in an attic in Newton, Mass and was returned to the Town Clerk's office. The book contains information not appearing in our Town Records, including death dates. Some of Rev Holcomb's marriages also appear here.

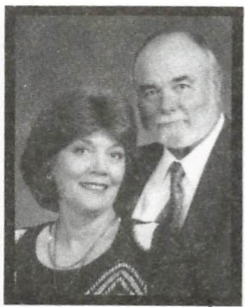

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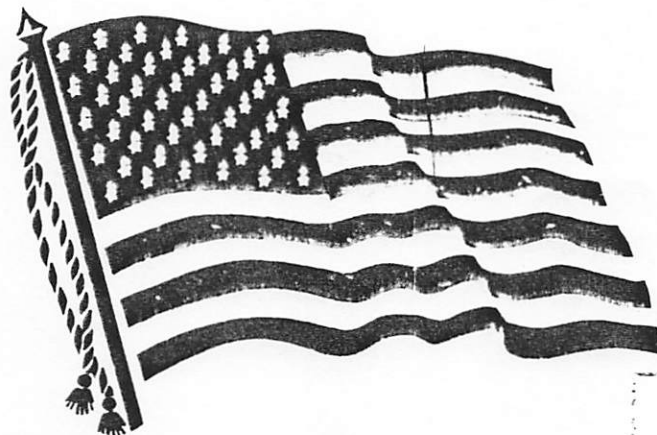
