 Trying to find info on George Bates, born 1828-29. Family tradition has it that he served in the Civil War and that when his troop was told to surrender he hiked his gun and left. Benjamin Eldridge, born ca 1829, married Mary Bates, born ca 1832 in TN. They were probably married in TN. They moved to Polk Co., MO about 1860 and then moved to Benton Co., AR about 1869. Mary Bates was supposed to have had a brother named Henderson Bates. Does anyone have information on this Bates family?????

TARLETON F. BATES

From Flora Bates Rose, Rt. 7 Box 3720, Lufkin, TX 75901:

The 1830 census of Bedford Co., TN lists the names of three brothers, Randolph born 1786 VA; John B. born 1794 VA; and Tarleton F. Bates born between 1790-1800. There was also a William Bates and a Mathew Bates who could be their brothers but I have no proof.

Tarleton F. Bates married, according to tradition, a Sarah Smithwick. In the 1830 census there were two sons: one under five and one between 5-10. Tarleton Bates and family came to Texas in 1834. He received a land grant in Feb 1838, #559 certificate #15. They settled in San Augustine Co. Mr. Bates died from an accident on 17 Apr 1838. There was a file in the courthouse in San Augustine, Texas on Mr. Bates but it did not list his children. We do not know the name of the older child since he was not listed on the 1850 census. The family recalls that sometime after the death of Mr. Bates his brothers, John and Randolph, came on horseback from TN and took the older boy home with them because his mother could not control him. This was around 1841.

The younger son, Marion Newton Bates, married #1 Jane Ellen Farris. To this union was born Tarleton Francis 28 Jun 1857 in Angelina Co., TX, married Caroline Sloan; William born 1859, died young; and my father, John Samuel, born 23 Nov 1861 in Angelina Co., married Josephine Holly born 5 Aug 1869 in TN. Children: Earnest Quinton Bates; Ethel Cornelius Bates; and twins, Flora Helen and Florence May Bates.

I believe that the parents of the three brothers to be a son or grandson of John Bates Jr. and Susanna Fleming. I hope someone is working on this Bates line. I have much information on the background history as well as family history and I will be glad to share.
