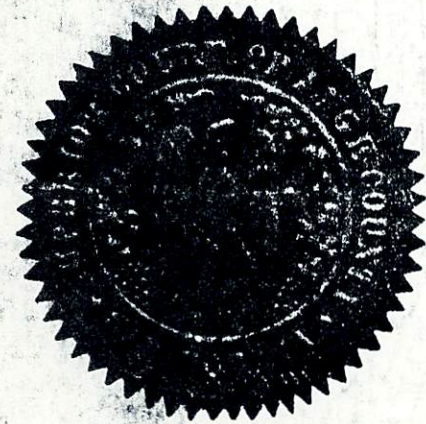

When writing for any of the above documents you can normally expect four to six weeks for delivery (additional time in foreign countries). Send as much information on the event you desire to document to the address noted. Include a check for the cost of the certificate and a self-addressed stamped envelope for best results. Some events (births, marriages, and deaths) were not registered even though occurring after the advent of civil registration. Many other records are available to fill the gap. Always request a "full copy" of the needed document. If the state does not have what you need, write to the county clerk of the county in which the event took place.

Enclosed you will find the chart you sent me to be filled out. As you can see I have a great deal of info on my family which is really complete to my Great Grandparents. It is after that point I begin to have problems with my Great Grandparents.

I shall go down the line of my G.G. Grandparents & tell you what I do have or do not have so you will not duplicate what I may already have. Starting with #16. I have Frederick Blauer & his family traced back in a direct line to 1632 thanks to a lady in Logan Utah who had a genealogist compile a book of over 500 Blauer names.

#17 Anna Rubi - I know nothing of her parentage would like to get it as far back as possible.

#18⁺¹⁹ - all I know from a death notice in a newspaper is that John Brownmawell & his wife Elizabeth were Juliana Eliz. Parents. according to the June 23, 1860 Census of Sweetland Center in Muscatine, Iowa. Eliz was head of the house - no mention of John & there were 8 children John 2 yrs, Wm 19, Dakota, 16, Peter 14, Mary M. 12 Eliz (Juliana was not used by her) 10, Catherine 7, & Sarah A 5 yrs. All except the last two were born in Penn. (Harrisburg is where they came from). The other two were born in Iowa. So between 1850 & 1853 they came

To Iowa from Penn. as you can see. I don't even have Eliz (the mother's) maiden name. Eliz (mother) was ⁴³ at time of Census so would have been born in 1816 or 1817.

#20 + 21 - Their son J. P. was born somewhere in the Rheinland of Germany, but the place is not known. It is known he had a sister Marie as I have a photo of her.

J. P. came to the U.S. at about age 17 or c. 1880. But little of anything on Parents Joseph + Rosa.

#22. Though the Ames family to which Deane is supposed to be a part has been traced back to Bruton, England, I have been unable to find proof that she is the daughter of Bezar Ames + Lucy Goodnough.

Bezar was born in 1792 in Bridgewater, Mass., but died in New Haven, Conn.

Deane, m.d. Ephriam in April 1846, but like her birth + death - we don't know where.

#23. Ephriam Brock as you can see I have dates + places on him, but nothing on who his parents were. The state of N. H. where he was born didn't list parents on Birth Cert. info ~~to~~ they sent to me.

#24. Karl Kalbus' Parentage is unknown to me at this time. When he married Wilhelmine they lived in Posen, Poland + Frederick their 6th child was born in Grenz Walden Bush.

#25 Wilhelmine Mueller's parents are Christian Mueller and Louise Bauman. That is all I have on her parents no

doing any kind. Well-known like her in
Germany - today a princess in Poland.
#36 From a death cert. of Pauline Perle
I found out her father was Ferdinand
But that is not Pauline was born, though,
in state of New York, located in the
Principality of Baden, Poland, at that time
of the Emperor. I have no info on her
mother at all.

#38. I have nothing on the parentage of Christian
Xillick (Gulick in Germany)
#39 I have no maiden name, place of birth
or parentage of Henriette - wife of Christian G.

#30. I have no parentage on mother married
(Spelled by descendants as Muschick). His daughter
Mary's marriage cert. Spells it Muschel. Mary
was a young girl when they came to the U.S. about
1900.

#31. I have no maiden name, parentage or
sister. With a great record.

I do know they are buried in Elmwood, Iowa.
and that they had six children: Mary, Louise,
Clara, Caroline, Mary, Joseph & Ann.
I sit so at all possible I would like to
extend and my ancestor families as far
back as what has possible.
I hope I haven't over done this, but I have
great experience I know that records like
helped in the past a thing cannot into
no possible is needed to try & locate
other links in ones trees & books

James Kirkwood, winner of Pulitzer, Tony for co-writing 'A Chorus Line'

NEW YORK — James Kirkwood, a novelist, actor and playwright who co-wrote the book for the record-breaking Broadway musical "A Chorus Line," has died.

Mr. Kirkwood, a resident of Key West, Fla., died of cancer Friday in New York, where he was hospitalized recently, said a friend, Arthur Beckenstein.

Although Mr. Kirkwood's age was given as 58, he recently said he was actually 64. "As an actor, I got in the habit of lying about my age," he said.

In 1976, Mr. Kirkwood won a Tony Award and a Pulitzer Prize

for "A Chorus Line." He wrote the book with Nicholas Dante.

The show, which also won a Drama Critics Circle Award, opened in 1975, had a record 3,389th performance in 1983 and continues as the longest-running musical in Broadway history.

Mr. Kirkwood followed his actor parents, Lila Lee and James Kirkwood Sr., into show business at 14. He appeared in shows including "Wonderful Town" and "Welcome Darlings" and films including "Mommie Dearest" and "The Supernaturals."

He also served in the US Coast Guard for three years.

He wrote plays including "Un-

healthy to Be Unpleasant," produced on Broadway in 1966, and "Legends," which toured the country in 1986 and 1987 with Mary Martin and Carol Channing.

His books included "P.S. Your Cat Is Dead!" which he adapted for the stage, and "American Grotesque," a non-fiction work about a conspiracy in the aftermath of the assassination of President Kennedy.

Shortly before he died, Mr. Kirkwood finished a book about his experiences called "Diary of a Mad Playwright."

He is survived by a half-brother and a half-sister. A memorial service is planned.
