

## THE KALBUS FAMILY TREE

KARL KALBUS was born in Germany on December 9, 1805 and died in Oshkosh, Wisconsin on February 8, 1875.

WILHELMINA MUELLER, who became Mrs. Karl Kalbus, was the daughter of Louisa Bauman and Christian Mueller, was born on October 13, 1819 in the Province of Pomerania, Germany and died on February 10, 1899 in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

When Karl and Wilhelmina were married they lived in Posen, in the Kingdom of Prussia. To them were born ten children, five boys and five girls. The boys when they reached the proper age would be inducted into the military service of the King. This though did not happen to the Kalbus boys as in 1864 the family embarked on a sailing vessel and came to the United States.

The voyage took from three to seven weeks and they finally landed in Baltimore, Maryland. From Baltimore they traveled to Oshkosh, Wisconsin and settled on a little farm on the shores of Lake Winnebago in Winnebago County.

After Charles, one of the five boys, died his son Lawrence continued to run the place. He has cottages to rent, which are rented year round to the fisherman. He also sells gas for the boats and has a place to launch the boats. There is a great deal of activity around there on weekends and during the summer.

There is a cemetery located about five miles south of Oshkosh where many members of the family are buried. It is the Wilhelmina Cemetery. It was not named after Wilhelmina Kalbus, but after a young girl named Wilhelmina who was the first buried there.

Bertha was the only one of the ten children that was born in the United States in Wisconsin.

Frederick was born in the little village of "GRUN WALDER BUSH" which means "GREEN FOREST" on May 11, 1853. He was only eleven years old when he came to America. While he was still a young man he traveled westward to a lumber camp in Northern Minnesota. A little later he went to Fargo, North Dakota and worked on the Railroad westward out of Fargo, Dakota Territory. Abraham Lincoln had passed the Homestead Law that allowed a young man to take up a preemption on a quarter section (160 acres of land) which really was a challenge to stay on and improve it and with a small payment was his. This he did, though it was hard work plowing with oxen and one plow share and putting in the crop.

Frederick's wife, PAULINE BINKE, was born in the little village of "GUTE HOFFNUNG" meaning "GOOD HOPE" also located in the Province of POSEN. POSEN was a part of PRUSSIA, but is now a part of POLAND under the rule of the communists. At the age of twenty-two Pauline came to the U.S. and went to St. Paul Minnesota to live with her half brother, Fred Reiman, who had a book bindery business. While in St. Paul, Pauline worked in a restaurant as a cook. It was here that FREDERICK KALBUS and PAULINE BINKE met. Fred had bought a farm in Ellendale, North Dakota and asked Pauline to come and see it.

She liked it there, decided to stay and on May 23, 1886, Frederick Kalbus and Pauline Binke were married. To this union was born eight children; Carl Daniel, Julius, Alma, Emma, Martha, Frederick, Alfred and Elsie.

Frederick died on his farm in 1929 and Pauline died at Groton South Dakota while she was visiting her daughter Emma in 1940.
