Dear Ms. Berger:

I am working my way through requests that came in during the time I was out of the office and am able to respond to your phone call re: Rev. A. J. Si___, 242 Mon___ on a marriage record you have, and to your request for the marriage certificate for your mother-in-law's sister, Josephine Obadal to Alfred Berger, 11/4/1924.

First, I am enclosing photocopies from the Official Catholic Directories [OCD] from 1921. The priest list did not have any Rev. A. J. Si___ in the Diocese of Newark as it was then, having been elevated to an Archdiocese in 1937. So I went to the Newark section and looked through Jersey City parishes for any names that might work in combination with the address fragment. There was a Rev. Joseph A. Shovlin at All Saints, 291 Pacific Ave., so I thought I might have reversed J.A. to A.J. when speaking with you on the phone. The address fragment might relate to **St. Anthony of Padua**, Polish, corner of **Monmouth** and 6th Sts. or to St. Bridget, 372 Montgomery St.

Next I received your request for the marriage certificate from Assumption/All Saints based on the Slovak heritage of the bride. Assumption was the Slovak parish, so I tried there first – no marriage on that day, and the priest's name was Rev. John S. Szemann. I moved on to All Saints, though it was not Slovak, and found no marriage on 4 November 1924, I am sorry to say. Along with one marriage by Rev. Joseph A. Shovilin, there were other priests' names including Rev. Eugene R. Gallagher, and a couple of visiting Passionist priests, Rev. Andrew McGuire, C.P. and Rev. F. Cornelius, C.P.

I would say that if you have from civil records such as census or city directories, or from family lore, an address where Alfred or Josephine lived just prior to the marriage, or their first address afterward, that that might suffice to help us determine likely parishes, though I would think that **St. Anthony of Padua** would be a good next step. The Archdiocesan website at <http://www.rcan.org/parishes/> allows you to find contact information for extant parishes by city or township. St. Anthony's marriage records on film do not go up to 1924. And, incidentally, the form that you have sent is for contemporary searches as noted in the Obtaining a Sacramental Certificate section of our present webpage. Those who need a copy of a baptismal record from a closed parish in order to receive communion, confirmation or marriage, or those who need baptismal to prove age or marriage record to prove relationship for Social Security or Medicare may use the Application you sent in. Family history research is covered in the bottom half of the page where there is an introduction to and index of parish records on microfilm, lists of parishes without film and or cemetery records on film, and our genealogy letter which includes a form with which to order a search from us. I am enclosing a copy of the letter for your reference. With the date as you have, if one knows the parish, I do allow use of the certificate form for a genealogy request, but if you go through the Jersey City parishes one by one at \$5.00, it could add up. Further digging first might help.

Should you not find the marriage at St. Anthony of Padua, and you have an address or other information that would help me to assist you in determining other parish(es) to investigate, or we can assist in any other way, please let us know.

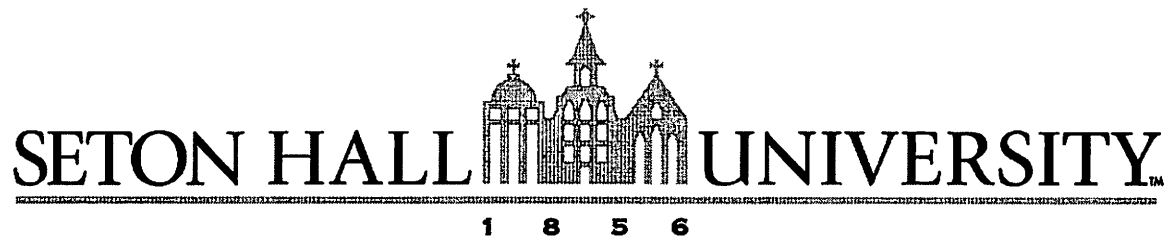

GUIDE FOR RESEARCH BY MAIL

1. Fee for a *one-hour* basic search is \$25.00, payable in advance to Seton Hall University Archives. If additional time is needed, the researcher will be notified in advance, as an additional fee or fees may be required. The first five photocopies are included in the basic fee; additional copies will be charged at the rate of \$.25 per page.
2. Researchers are requested to provide as much specific information as possible (such as names and possible variant spellings, addresses, dates, name of church, etc. The latter is imperative as all records are accessed by Parish.) This will enable research to be conducted in the most efficient manner. If it is known in advance that a research question is beyond our scope, the researcher will be so notified, and any payment returned.
3. Staffing is extremely limited. Requests are handled in the order of arrival; turn-around time will average 3 weeks to possibly longer.
4. Researchers should be aware that the collection used most frequently for research is the Archdiocese of Newark Microfilm Collection - Sacramental Records on Microfilm. Although this collection can be searched by mail request, researchers are welcome to visit the Archives in person, by appointment, to access this collection. Reservations can be made by calling (973) 761-9476. This microfilm is also available through Mormon (LDS) libraries.
5. Telephone reference is not available.

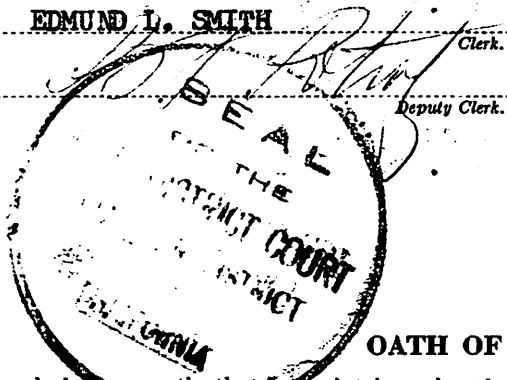

If it is not too late, here is the information on my father-in-law, Alfred Berger.

Wished I could have scanned the original but here is the info:

From his U.S. Social Security Act –Application for Account Number:

Name: Alfred Berger (I have never seen nor heard of a middle name)

Age Last birthday: 49 Born 12th May 1889 in Vienna, Austria

Father's Name: Leo Berger (death certificate says Leopold Berger)

SS: 550-12-1609

Date of signature May 18, 1938 (the last two numbers were hard to read.)

From his Alien Registration (AR-10) form for 1940

He indicates that he is not a citizen of the U.S. and he was last a citizen of Austria. **He arrived at the U.S. at New York, NY Nov. 1909 on the ship Crown Princess Cecilia as a passenger.** He had been in the U.S. for 31 years. His "usual occupation" was "waiter". His "present occupation" was none. He had not applied for first citizenship papers in the U.S.

I have not been able to definitively identify Alfred in the 1910 census, although there was another Alfred Berger, b. about 1887, who came in 1909 with apparently a brother Ernst on the Ship President Lincoln (which departed 10 Okt 1909 from Hamburg). Information on the passenger list indicates he was headed to Dodge Co., Wisconsin, and is indeed found there in the 1910 census, but then disappears. He came from Dippoldiswalde (Sachsen), occupation Steinsetzer .

I have not definitively identified him in the 1920 census either. He was probably on the east coast, since he and my mother-in-law were married in Jersey City in 1924. Although I have an exact date, I cannot find a courthouse record in all of New Jersey, and am now starting to investigate the individual churches in Jersey City. I was told by officials that often in those days, the paperwork was not returned to the courthouse and recorded.

My mother-in-law Josephine who came in 1911 with her family lived mostly in N.Y. but also worked in Bennington, VT for a well-to-do family. She was a cook, and met Alfred when she hired him to work on her staff, whether in NY or VT I don't know.

In the 1930 census Alfred and my mother-in-law Josephine were living in Los Angeles City and his year of immigration was listed as 1910 and his citizenship status as "PA."

Therefore I have been searching for 1910 as well as 1909.
