

I Paul Kase of the City of Westminster Canoll County Maryland, do make publish & declare this instrument of writing to be my last will and testament:

After the payment of my debts and funeral charges I devise as follows, To Wit:

The balance of my goods and chattels together with all my lands and real estate, I devise, authorize and empower my Executors herein after appointed to sell at public or private sale and on such terms as they may see fit, and the proceeds from the sales thereof, together with the cash money I may have at my death, and the collections from choses in actions due and owing and to become due to me, including bonds, stocks and any other private securities I devise and bequeath as follows.

To my Wife Helen Kase I give and bequeath the sum of one thousand dollars.

To my daughter Mary A. I give and bequeath the sum of two hundred dollars.

To my daughter Julia A. I give and bequeath the sum of two hundred dollars.

To my daughter Helen I give and bequeath the sum of two hundred dollars.

To my daughter Josephine I give and bequeath the sum of two hundred dollars.

To my daughter Henrietta I give and bequeath the sum

two hundred dollars, And the balance then
left, I give and bequeath to my following
children and the children of my deceased Son
Samuel viz: The seventh part thereof to my son
William Kase: The seventh part thereof to my
son Henry Kase: The seventh part thereof to
my son James Kase: The seventh part thereof
to my son Francis Kase: The seventh part
thereof to my daughter Louisa the wife of John
Price: The seventh part thereof to my daughter Sarah
the wife of Francis Conway And the remaining
seventh part thereof to the children of my
deceased son Samuel Kase in equal shares

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint
Henry Kase & Francis Kase two of my sons, the
to be executors of this my last will & testament, revoking
and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made
ratifying and confirming this and none other to
be my last will and testament
