The Beginning of the Ohrendorff Family in the United States

Hermanus Ohrendorff and Anna Margaretha Ohrendorff came on the ship Charming Nancy, Charles Stedman Master, from Rotterdam but last from Plymouth, England. He took the Oath of Allegiance 8 October 1737, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He settled in Lebanon township, Lancaster county, Pa., where he was taxed fifteen shillings for 50 acres of land. He died in 1777, and his widow Catharine Orendorff was appointed sole administratrix by the Register's Office of Lancaster county, Pa., 2 April 1778, when the appraiser's report was filed for 181 pounds, two shillings and four pence. No heirs are named. Dated 2-27-1777 and filed 4-2-1778, at the Lancaster county, Courthouse at Lancaster, Pa.

Christian Ohrendorff and Johann Christian Ohrendorff, came off the ship ~~Christian Ohrendorff~~ St. Mark, Captain William Wilson Master, from Rotterdam and last from Cowes, England, 26 September 1741, when they took the Oath of Allegiance, at Philadelphia, Pa. He settled in Heidelberg twp., now Jackson twp., Lebanon county, Pa., near Myerstown, Pa., on fifty acres of land for which he paid eight shillings tax in 1758. He died 16 April 1772; aged eighty years of age; buried at the Moravian Church cemetery of Bethel, now Hanover twp., Lebanon county, Pa.

Thomas Koppenhöffer, Sr., deceased December 1760; had minor daughter Catharina aged 14 years; Christian Orendorff, Jr., appointed her guardian., rest of his children satisfactory to the estate.

Intestate record of Thomas Koppenheffer, Sr., dated 31 December 1760., Elizabeth Koppenheffer, his widow was appointed administratrix. Her name was spelled by the clerk, Elizabeth (X) Copenhaver, with that of John Barr and Christian Orendorff, her son-in-law. There were seven children to first wife, Anna Maria (in English Mary Ann): 1) Henry, 2) Simon, 3) Michael, 4) Thomas, Jr., 5) Regina, w/o John Tice, 6) Eva, w/o Christian Lehman and 7) Catharine Koppenhöffer.

Hermanus Orndorff, of Lebanon, and wife Catharine, had eight children: 1) Lorentz, 2) Christian, 3) John, 4) Margaret, 5) Maria Elisabeth, 6) Anna Maria, 7) Maria, and 8) Teresia, w/o John Eckworth.

Eisenhower family, and settled at Abilene, Kansas. A son William Henry
Eisenhower (4-9-1856/1-16-1926), married Amanda Alice Hoover (10-10-1864/
11-12-1940), who lived and died at Abilene, Kansas, parents of ten children.

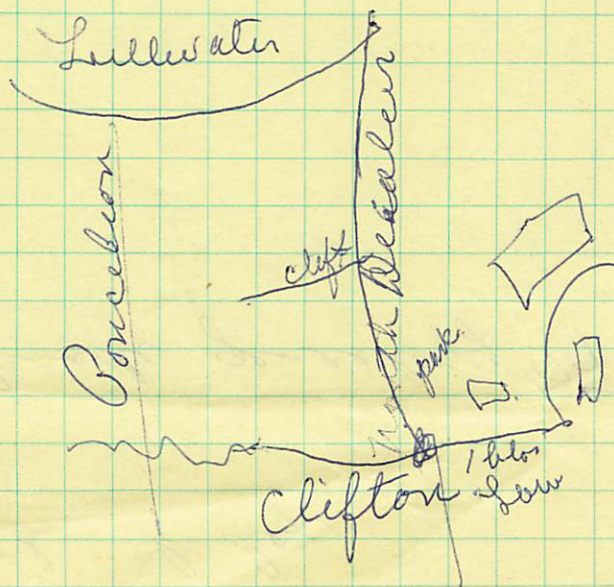

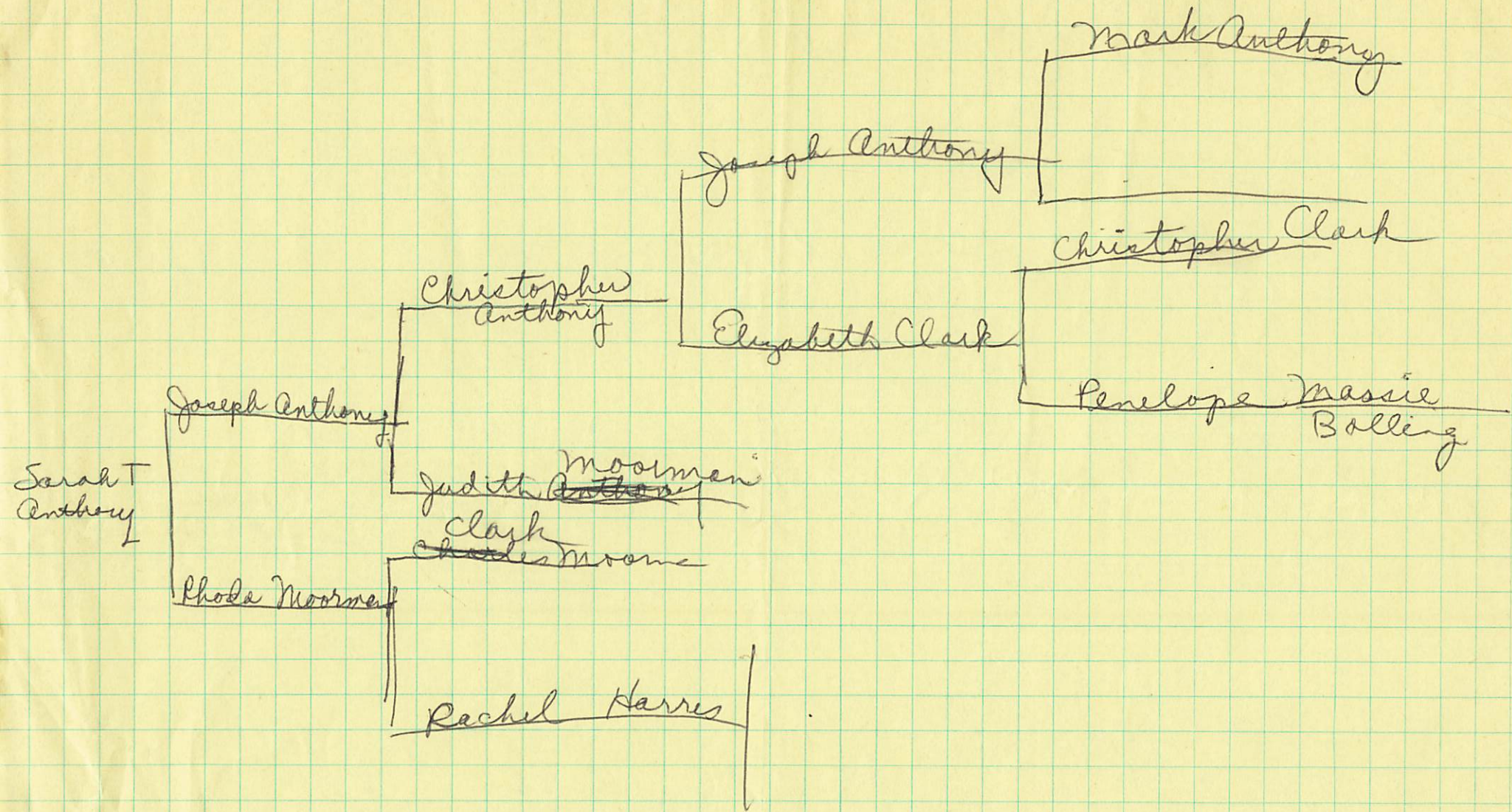
