Dear Mrs Berger,

First of all I have enclosed a copy of the Leister family genealogy. It is rather dissapointing in that there are no references mentioned. It does show Daniel Leister and Christina Orendorf. Daniels brother John was my gt gt gt grandfather. John's granddaughter Emily Jane Leister married my great grandfather David Reaver, who was a son of Hannah Mundshower, who I think was Nick jr's daugh.

Now on to the Mundshower live, The earliest mention I have is from the Penn Archives 3rd series, Chester Co tax list 1766; Nicholas, John, Henry, Joseph there was also a Balser Mundshower who served in the Revolution from Chester Co. The 1810 Pa census listed Nicholas sr and jr in Adams Co., which is a few miles north of Taneytown. Nicholas sr's will (Adams Co #537 dated nov 11, 1813) listed him as a resident of Germany Township., no wife mentioned, childred John, Nicholas, Jacob, Henry. Nicholas Jr left an Admin in Adams Co. #1215 dated sept 7, 1824 with no useful information.

The 1810 Pa census list both in Germany township page 119?

L'm afraid this is all I have to offer you at this time. The Reformed Congregation records are missing for that time period (Taneytown Reformed) They would probably be quite helpful to piece together the Munshowers and some of the missing Reavers, and Ordorffs.

I did not copy the will so I can not tell you about witnesses, however I will make it point to review the papers at my earliest chance.

## THE LEISTER FAMILY

EBERHARD TRULLINGER came from Germany to America in 1738. With him was a daughter Anna Maria born in 1734.

JOHN NICHOLAS LEISTER (called Nicholas) was born in 1732. When he came to America Nov. 3, 1750, he came from near Kreuznach, Palatinate, Germany. In 1754 Nicholas married ANNA MARIA TRULLINGER. They lived in Franconia Township, Montgomery County (Norristown is present county seat), Pa. until 1771. They attended Indian Field Lutheran Church. In 1770 he bought 30 acres of land on the Uniontown Road out of Westminster, Md., and in 1777 he bought 160 acres more. He lived there, and in 1805 he died and was buried on his farm. He attended Krider's Lutheran Church near Westminster, Md. Anna Maria died in 1823. Their children number 6, one of them being Jacob.

JACOB LEISTER was born about 1768. He was a dabbler in real estate in Emmistsburg, and later he and a Slingluff had a store in Westminster. He died by accidental gun-shot wound in 1810 and was buried on his father's plantation. He was a member of Krider's Church. All of his children were raised by relatives, one being David who was reared by his father's brother, David.

DAVID LEISTER was born in 1797. He was orphaned when he was 13 years of age. He was married to Hannah Schaeffer. In 1822 he bought most all his farm equipment from his brother-in-law, Daniel Haifley who migrated to Salem, Columbiana County, Ohio. In 1823 he bought a farm from the heirs of George Meyerley. This farm is on the Sullivan road, and I believe presently is owned by Herbert L. Leister of Detroit, Mich. David and his wife had 13 children, the second of which is Isaiah.

ISAIAH LEISTER was born in 1826. He married Amanda Bare. He bought his farm from Henry Leister, the son of Daniel, brother of Jacob (mentioned above). This farm was known as Spring Garden and was of 200 acres when patented to Daniel in 1812. Daniel's son, Henry, donated a piece of it for Loister's Church. It was then sold to Isaiah (aforementioned). One of Isaiah's children was John Henry.

JOHN HENRY LEISTER was born in 1863. He married Susan Rineman. They had eight children, seven living to maturity and marriage. John Henry's youngest son Arthur is the writer's father.

LEY-LOW FAMILY

JOHN GEORGE LEY (LOY) arrived in America on 27th August 1733, on the ship Eliza, of London. He was born c1705 in Germany, of Huguenot descent. With his wife, MARIA ELIZABETH Trout, b. c1715, he came to Philadelphia and remained in that vicinity, presumably, for several years, since he did not purchase land in Frederick, Maryland until 1737. On the same ship were Johann Debaldt Trout, Hans Martin Traudt and under 16, Johannes Traudt and Johan Traudt; It is not known whether one of the first two was the father of Maria Elizabeth or that they were brothers. John George Ley was a miller, when he arrived in America and also in Maryland. He was a charter member of the first Lutheran Church in Frederick County. This data is in Volume II of "Some Loy Families in America" 1732-1955, compiled by C. Loy Van Dine, of Dayton, Ohio and Jennie C. Stewart, probably from Boulder, Colo. since that is where the DAR records came from.

C. Loy Van Dyne was a wealthy man, and flew his own plane to Frederick, Maryland to do personal research; the claim is made in this genealogy that he stayed at an inn in Maryland which was the "old Loy home."

The claim is also made that his sons ADAM and GEORGE FREDERICK served in the Revolutionary War. One record of Adam's descendant's says he served under General Anthony Wayne, and that he was wounded at Paoli, when the British attacked with bayonets. This as yet has not been proven.

John George Ley purchased land in Frederick, Maryland on 11 June 1737. He died in 1765, leaving a will which names his children. No wife is mentioned, so she presumably died before he did.

ADAM LEY (LOY) was baptized in Frederick, Maryland Reformed Church 15 Dec. 1746 and died in Butler Co. O. in December, 1803. He married in Frederick Co. ANNA BARBARA, daughter of SIC PETER AND ANNA MARIA CASSEL (In Volume III this is corrected to "daughter of Christian and Christina Cassel) written in red ink. All their children were born in Maryland. In 1790 Census of Maryland, Adam and family were living in Washington Co. Maryland - ADAM and Frederick, the two youngest sons, had been left an estate "Samsheim or Lamsheim, and since Frederick stayed in Maryland, it is presumed he bought Adam's share of this land.) Before 1795 they left for southwest Ohio, but remained in Kentucky for a time, because of Indian troubles. Adam's brother, George Peter Loy, married in Lexington, Ky. in 1795, a young widow, Nancy Riddle, born in New Jersey. Her maiden name was Foster. The entire family came to Ohio with their parents. ANNA BARBARA died in Preble Co. Ohio before 13 Oct. 1828, when her heirs presented a petition to the court for the sale of the land.
