

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SADLER FAMILY HISTORY

Jacob Sadler and his wife Magdalene(a) immigrated from Germany around 1740. An immigration list of September 5, 1738, lists a Jacob Sadler, one of 252 Palatines (from a particular region of Germany) who arrived on the ship Winter Galley, Edward Paynter, Master, from Rotterdam. They settled first in Hopewell, York County, Pennsylvania. By 1800 they had moved to Point Marion on the Cheat River in Fayette CO. He obtained large tracts of land and was considered a wealthy man at the time of his death on the 21st of December, 1817. He was buried in the Gans Cross Cemetery near Springhill PA. His wife Magadalene died 25th of April 1838. Both of their wills are recorded in Fayette CO, PA.

Jacob is said to have had a brother William who came from Germany about the same time and settled on the east side of the Allegheny Mountains.

Jacob and Magdalene had 10 children, all of whom are mentioned in Jacob's will. They were Lewis, Jacob, Jane (married a Broner), Magdalena or Mary (William Sadler, a cousin?), Rudolph, Christian (Eva), Susanna (Hinley or Hinsley), Esther (William Sechrist), Joseph, and Anna (Huhn). The sons were large and muscular men. All the children were probably born in Fayette CO, PA.

The son Jacob married Jane and had two sons. His birthdate and date of death are unknown at this time. He moved his family to Harrison CO, OH in the early 1800's. According to his father Jacob's will "he was unfit to manage his business in consequence of his mental derangement". This problem evidently contributed to his suicide when his sons were young. He died in Harrison CO, Ohio after 1820. Jacob and Jane's two sons were William and Jacob, evidently born in Fayette CO, PA. Possibly Jane and the sons returned to PA after Jacob died. Jacob was born in 1894 and William in 1898. Jane's date and place of death are unknown.

Jacob married Mary Wilkinson March 26, 1822, in Harrison CO, OH. They had seven children born in Ohio.

William married Katherine Kimbel(1) Harmon (Harmon was her stepfather's name). Katherine was born in western West Virginia, October 10, 1800. They eveidently married in Fayette CO, PA and moved to Harrison CO, OH in 1825. In a few years they moved near Dover in Tuscarawas CO, OH. They had eight children while living in Ohio. They were William (1. Elissa Aubergash, 2. Lavina Ingles), James (1.___ Nedrow[?], 2. Lavina Harris), John, Mary Ann (Frederick Farnum), Sarah (Young), Rachel (Alfred Miller), Samuel "Doc" (1. Frances Nutter, 2. Emma Colvert), and Joseph (Mariah Cheney).

In 1843 William and Jacob both moved their families to Harrisburg Township, Van Buren CO, Iowa. This is north of the present town of Bonaparte IA. William and Katherine lived there until he died of cholera September 16, 1855

and was buried near Harrisburg, IA. William was 6 feet tall, had dark complexion with dark hair and eyes. Katherine was short, quite fleshy, and had light blond hair. Katherine died February 26, 1886 and was buried near Bloomfield, IA.

From Iowa Jacob evidently moved to Kansas because he died there in 1885.

Wiliiam and Katherine's son James, my great-grandfather, married his first wife in Iowa, probably a Nedrow. They had two children, Sarah (Thomas Benton McWilliams) and John. She perhaps died, and James then married Lavinia Harris, my great-grandmother. There is not a lot of information available for James and Lavinia yet. They had six children who were mentioned in James' will. They were Ben. Franklin, William A., Arthur J., Elizabeth E., Harriet Irene (Robert Lee Coonts), Nancy J. (Matthews). The only birthplace known is Harriet's. She is my grandmother and was born July 17, 1865, in Girard KS. James and his family were living near Ft. Smith, AR. when he died of typhoid October 5, 1884. He was buried on the Doyle Farm near Massard Prairie which was near Ft. Smith, AR. Lavinia left quite a few letters and papers which indicated she had a legal struggle to keep their land after James died, and eventually lost it. She died at Poteau, Indian Territory, August 24, 1904 and was buried at Oakland Cemetery. The grave is unmarked.

Harriet Irene Sadler, my grand-mother, married Robert Lee Coonts the 28th of March, 1885. They had eight children who were James N., Bertha Mae (Moody M. Ryan), Eula Irene (Milburn Babb), Willie G., Charles F. Coonts (Ruth), Earl Otto Coonts, Arthur L. Coonts, and Helen Oklahoma (Lake Grove). They moved from Ft. Smith to Oklahoma about 1892. Harriet died at Poteau, OK, March 5, 1939, and was buried in Oakland Cemetary. A son of Charles Coonts says that he remembers his father talking about visiting cousins named McWilliams in Missouri. So the families must have tried to stay in touch with each other for a while.

My mother, Eula Irene, was born in Tuskahoma, Indian Territory, June 11, 1894. The family were living in Poteau, OK in 1896. She married Milburn Babb May 14, 1922 in McAlester, OK. DATA ON ISAAC, JACOB, AND WILLIAM SADLER, AS FOUND IN THE LIBRARY OF THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF YORK COUNTY, YORK, PENNSYLVANIA, 3 September 1970

I. ISAAC SADLER:

- a. Richard SADLER of Huntington Township, York (now Adams) County, died (16?) December 1764. He had made his will on 13 June 1763 and it was probated in York County court on 26 March 1765 (see will book B, page 35). In it are mentioned his wife Mary, and his children are named as ISAAC; Mary who married John Brandon; and Richard, junior.
- b. ISAAC SADLER died intestate and his estate was settled in 1793 (see York County Orphans Court docket H, page 523, dated 19 November 1793). This document mentions his wife or widow Mary, and names one child Richard. Another orphans court docket (G, page 208, dated 26 March 1796) mentions a son John, aged 18 years; a son ISAAC, aged 16 years; and a son Robert, aged 13 years.
- c. William SADLER died, apparently intestate, by 1770 (see orphans court docket B, page 249, dated 30 lay 1770) as this document mentions his widow Mary, and names children as ISAAC, aged "8 years this month"; Jane, "aged 6 years last October"; and Letitia, aged "4 years last October". ((a will for a William SADLER book B, page 43, dated or probated 7 October 1765) names John Hunt and Charles Coulson as administrators of the estate of a William Sadler, but it is not known whether this is the same individual.)
- d. Isaac SADLER was taxed in Huntington Township, York (now Adams) County in 1762, 1772, 1775, and 1783, according to tax lists on hand. In 1783 he owned 150 acres land and had 10 inhabitants in his household.
 - e. According to the 1790 (First) Census of the United States for Pennsylvania. Isaac SADLER was residing in Marrington Township, York County.
 - f. According to the third series of the published Pennsylvania Archives, volume XXI, pages 133, 266, 479, 508, and 747, Isaac SADLER was taxed in Huntington Township, York (now Adams) County in 1779, 1780, 1781, 1782, and 1783. He was shown to have had 150 acres of land each year except for 1780 when his land was listed as 140 acres. In 1779 he was found in a list of men named as "taxables not sworn".
 - g. According to an entry on page 543 of volume XXIII of the third series of the published Pennsylvania Archives. Isaac SADLER, aged 74 years, was a Revolutionary War pensioner in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, per P.L. (public law?) of 20 December 1823.
 - h. According to records of the Christ Episcopal Church, York Springs, huntington Township, York (now Adams) County, Pennsylvania, Isaac, a son of William and Mary SADLER, was baptized 12 June 1762. No date of birth was given.

- i. According to the National Genealogical Society's publication, Index of the Revolutionary War Pension Applications, Washington, DC, 1966, Isaac SADLER served from Pennsylvania and his records for pension are to be found in pension file S-22487.
- j. According to a scrutiny of the above pension application file S-22407. Isaac SADLER was born on 14 or 23 May 1760 in York County, Pennsylvania. He enlisted in York County, Pennsylvania on 1 September 1775, or thereabouts, and served for one year as a private in Captain Stephen Stephenson's company, Colonel Magaw's Pennsylvania Regiment. On 13 September 1777 he enlisted as a private in Captain Stephenson's company, under Major Mull and served until 2 October 1777 when he was elected major in place of Major Mull who had resigned. He served in Colonel Stephenson's Pennsylvania Regiment until 11 or 12 October 1777. On 23 May 1833 he applied for a federal pension in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and received certific te 25717, dated 20 December 1833 which entitled him to a pension of \$43.33 per annum from 4 March 1831. In his application, the soldier had noted that he lived in York County until 1794 when he removed to Mestmoreland County. He did not mention his family in this application.
- k. According to the DAR Mational Headquarters book <u>DAM Patriot Index</u>. Washington, DC, 1966. Isaac SADLER was born 14 May 1760 and died 20 June 1843; he served as a major from Pennsylvania during the Revolution, and was married to Jennie Hunt.
- 1. According to records of the Christ Episcopal Church, York Springs, in Euntington Township, York (new Adams) County, Isaac SADLER was elected warden of that church on 23 May 1763, and had been elected to duties as vestryman of that church on 25 May 1760, 4 June 1761, 27 June 1762, 23 April 1764, 27 May 1765, 31 March 1766, 15 June 1767, 4 April 1768, and 16 April 1770.
- m. According to an unpublished compilation of official records made in the 1930s by a former staff member of ours, henry James Young, and such compilation titled York County in the American Revolution A Source Book, in "red" and "black" series, we find the following conferning Isaac SADLFR:
- l. page 504 "black" series: Isaac SADLER was a member of the third class in the seventh (William Dodd's) company, first battalion of York County militia as of 11 April 1778.
- 2. page 154 "black" series: Isaac SADLER was a member of the eighth class of muntington Township, York (now Adams) County militia as of 30 January 1781. He was assessed 11 pounds sterling for monies to be paid for recruits for the Continental Army and his assessed amount on this was 19 shillings, ten pence.
- 3. page 252 "red" series: Isaac SADLER was a member of the fourth (Captain John Ziegler's) company, 9th battalion of York County militia as of 25 November 1783. He was named as not having had any training days or muster days or field training days.
- 4. page 573 "red" series: Isaac SADLER was fined 3 pounds 10 shillings in 1778 as per a list made up 10 May 1777 concerning non-associators of York County.

n. According to a letter in our files, written by the DAR in Omaha, Nebraska on 16 July 1928, there was a DAR Chapter in Nebraska named the "Major Isaac Sadler Chapter", and it was stated that this man was a major during the Revolution, one of the youngest majors in fact, and that his father's name was Isaac Sadler.

II. JACOB SADLER:

The only information we have on Jacob SADLER is that a man or person by that name was born 12 September 1799 to Wilhelm SADLER and was baptized in Saddler's Church, Ropewell Township, York County on 17 November 1799, the sponsor at baptism being the father.

III. WILLIAM SADLER:

- a. According to the History of Adams County, Pennsylvania, 1886, William SADLER was a hatter and in 1811 was taxed in Hamilton Township, Adams County.
- b. According to an entry on page 959 of the third volume, sixth series of the published <u>Pennsylvania Archives</u>, a William SADLER was a private in the fifth (John McCartney's) company, first battalion of Philadelphia City militia in 1785.
- c. According to a tombstone record of the Rock Chapel cemetery, Huntington Township, Adams County, William SADLER was born 1 October 1771 and died 8 July 1848, aged 70 years, 8 months and 7 days. Beside him lies his wife, Lydia, who was shown to have died 9 July 1864, but no age was shown.

NOTE: In the data above conferring Isaac SADLER, you will note that such information concerns at least two different men of the same name, and possibly three such men. We do not unravel the mystery but submit the information for your use and final decision.

Dear Mrs. Berger:

Thank you for your letter; it's the first response I've gotten to that query, and it could not have been better timed. I've just concluded that my Sadler line is German and is not connected to the Sadler lines of Adams County! This will cause much disappointment in my family, if anyone accepts my opinion. My father, who was christened Sadler Alton, has English coins from the 1740's that were alledged to have been brought by his ancestors. The Sadler connection was so cherished by the family that Sadler became a given name; my grandfather Shopp was nicknamed "Sad", and my 6-yr. old son is Jesse Sadler Rehr.

I've enclosed a copy of the biography that sent me on the wild goose chase for a son of William Sadler named Jacob (History of Cumberland & Adams Cos., PA, p.474). It's apparent that the phrases about the connection of Jacob Sadler to the Adams Co. families was stuck in as an afterthought, perhaps by the editor, who had a sudden inspiration. However, since the English Sadlers were wealthy and influential, I'm sure that my forebears were happy to accept the idea. Recently I was sent a tombstone inscription for a Jacob Sadler b. ca. 1742; d. 21 Dec 1817, Springhill Twp., Fayette Co., PA; bur. Gans Cross Cem. His will mentions a son Joseph and is signed in Cerman handwriting, "Jacob Satler". I can now better understand why his sons and grandsons married German-speaking women. Having grown up in Mt. Holly Springs, PA, I can grasp why a location on the Maryland border was described as "near Pittsburgh"!

I'm sending you copies of some materials on the Adams County Sadlers that may be of interest. The report on the Sadlers came from the Sadler file at the York County Historical Soc. Maida Johnston is a friend of my mother-in-law and lives in Carlisle, PA (I think); I can find her address, if you wish to contact her. I apologize for the quality of the photocopying on those biographies, but I can't do better, since my mother copied them at the Cumberland Co. Historical Soc. and the library here doesn't have that book. The biography of William Sadler looks as if it should be of interest to you. If Lydia's maiden name turns out to have been Lease, I can make some suggestions on sources to check, since my husband has Leas/Lease ancestors from Adams Co.!

Did you actually see Richard Sadler's tombstone at Old White Church Cemetery? I visited there last year and searched in vain for a Sadler stone; it's a very isolated spot, quite overgrown and very romantic. It's a challenge to locate but a worthwhile pilgrimage, if you have Sadler ancestors.

I just discovered that I put my carbon paper in upside down, so I'll send you a photocopy of this letter (I have a 3-yr. old at my feet).
