Dear Mr. Stratton:

Some news of sorts. We found the Estate settlement of COTTON FLETCHER at Rutland, Vt. He had no Will but a panel of three citizens essayed his be his belongings and divided them; one-third to the wife, the remaining two-thirds equally among the children. This all took place in 1784. (COTTON FLETCHER died in 1777.)

Most interesting is the fact COTTON FLETCHER's Wife was called none other than THANKFUL PRESTON!! She had re-married sometime between 1777 and 1784 either in Poultney, Vt. or Salisbury, Conn. I say this because there was a note in the records written by SAMUEL FLETCHER (COTTON's 2nd. Child), that he, SAMUEL, had moved the family from Salisbury to Poultney apparently after COTTON's death. They may have moved back to Salisbury when COTTON was taken ill or perhaps to avoid the war. COTTON's last legal "move" that I could find was in Jany. 1777 at which time he sold land in Salisbury, Conn ~~REXXXXXXXX~~ to his brother. He was present in Salisbury at that time. SAMUEL FLETCHER names a couple of doctors who attended COTTON FLETCHER. The task now is to find out whether they lived in Salisbury or Poultney. Second - was THANKFUL married in the former or the latter.

BILL NAGLE visited a few weeks ago (I'd never met him) and told of his stay on the Island. He, too, was very happy to explore his family roots (NOTE NAGLE stopped hr. at S.A. to see me)(ALS)

I'll keep you notified if news develops. Let me know if I can provide you with any info.

Dear Mrs. Berger:

You may recall we met at the San Diego Library not long ago, and I mentioned I was going to Ohio.


I went to the Fairview Cemetary on State Road 303, a mile or so west of Hinckley town center, and almost immediately found your Fletcher stones.

Many years ago, a small maple sapling was planted on Amos' grave--it is now a huge tree, his stone facing the trunk only two or three feet away. Eunice's stone is several feet to the right.

Both markers appear to be of sandstone, which unfortunately was much used in this part of Ohio, as sandstone crumbles badly, becoming almost illegible in 100 years or so. Both Fletcher stones are now a bit hard to read in some areas--I had to do rubbings to make sure of the inscriptions. The Oct date on Eunice's is not missing, it is just blank as if it had never been cut.

I took photos, which I will have developed when I return to California in about 10 days. Hope this helps.
