I made a trip to the Hall of Records in Annapolis and to the DAR in Washington, D.C. seeking information on the families you wanted researched. Attached is the information that I found.



Did you find them on the 1850 census? (I also assume you didn't, but please let me know). I found nothing whatsoever on the Gaucker or Riffle families. There are several sources that I need to check but haven't had time to do so yet. I did get a copy of a book entitled "The History of Carroll County". It was no help whatsoever.

Please tell me why you think Catherine Althoff's parents are Joseph and Margaret Orndorff Weible? It may provide a clue we can use. Do you think it would be worthwhile checking Pennsylvania records? If so, I can do so at the DAR--they have a really good library on every state in the Union.

Please review carefully the information that I'm sending and see if any of it matches what you currently have. I hope you will find it helpful.

Also at the Hall of Records I found a book entitled "From Mill Wheel to Plowshare" by Julia Angeline Dranke and James Ridgeley Orndorff, 1938. "The Story of the contribution of the Christian Orndorff Family to the Social and Industrial History of the United States". Printed by Torch Press, Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

I scanned this book briefly looking for a reference on Margaret Orendorff who married a Wivel but nothing was mentioned. If you should find later that the Orendorffs are definitely in your line you may want to get a copy of this book. This past weekend I visited a rare book store and was greatly surprised to find a copy of this book. I don't remember the exact price but it was under \$20. If later you decide you want it, let me know and I'll pick it up for you.

This book was very confusing to read, but I did pick up a little bit of information--

Christian Orndorff I accompanied by his 15 year old son of the same name Christian II and a daughter of 13, Anna Barbara entered the port of Baltimore. Christian I died 4/16/1882 at the age of 80 in Pennsylvania. His son, Christian II was born in Prussia 11/15/1726.

Family tradition has it that Christian I married Elizabeth von Mueller who was either a countess, duchess or princess. He arrived in Philadelphia (see discrepancy from above) 9/1741 aboard the "St. Mark" from Rotterdam. He settled near Philadelphia and then moved to Lebanon County, Pennsylvania.

Christian II married Elizabeth Ann Hoffman on 4/2/1749 in Lebanon County, Pennsylvania. They moved to Frederick County, Maryland before 1762. Their children:

1. Margaret "Peggy" born 1750; married Jacob Hess about 1768.
2. Christopher, born 11/23/1752.
3. Elizabeth
4. Barbara, born 8/21/1759; baptized 9/2/1759
5. Christian III (probably the last of the children born in Lebanon Co.)

VALENTINE WEIBEL & his wife ANNA MARIA ECK

Valentine Weibel married Anna Maria Eck sometime before 1748 (will of Jacob Eck). Their children were probably born during the period 1748-1764 for which there are no baptismal records. I've been sitting here pouring over it, and thanks to you I really think that my hunch was correct about my M. Catharine being daughter of Joseph and Mgt. Weible.

Reasons: I believe John Althoff married M. Catharine Weible, then M. Catherine's brother Joseph m John's sister Christina Althoff...registered in CCR. Maryland Hall of Records, naturalization John Althoff..Frederick County, 1838, p 5..witness was Ephm. Riddlemossler...another clue to Orendorff.

All associations are buried at Taneytown..what an unusual way to pronounce that one!! I have Scarf's book and there was no mention of Joseph and Margaret O. Weibel's burial there, which gives me the impression that they all were family there. Anthony Wivell, Joseph, John Adelsperger and wife Margaret..birth date coincides with Margaret, of Joseph and Margaret Weible, John and Mary C. Althoff, the Gauckers, Paul Eck who was married to a Weibel.

The coincidences are just too great. Just a couple of notes from yours: Molly of Joseph and Margaret is probably Margaret. M. Theresa Weibel of Joseph married Peter Gaucker, they must have mixed up the marriages at Conewago, I mean the names.

Just from Goshenhoppen records I have figured out Valentine and his family. Don't know who Stephen Wible etc. and ~~W~~ that clan comes into the picture.

Am enclosing some of the notes I have made on Weible. You have most of them.

To round out some of your family group sheets. I have received so much mail regarding my ~~indexing~~ indexing of Catholic records, and received bonuses too...surnames of the area.

Incidentally, I think that the Mathias Rubichon on the same ships list is the ancestor of Milton Rubincam, who was from Katzenelbogen in what is now southern Hessen. There also were several BEVERs among the women and children. I don't know whether they were of the same family as Johannes Bewertz, who came over in 1739. Basler Gerlach, who was on the same ship, was one of the witnesses to Johannes Bewerts will in March 1748, along with Mathias Loy and Michael Smith (Schmidt).

The surname WEIBEL also appears as WEIGEL. *ever hear of that?* A chap who lives in my neighborhood, Eugene WEIGEL is from Pennsylvania, Catholic, and of Pennsylvania Deutch ancestry. I found a WEIGEL among the inhabitants of the village of Leimersheim on the left bank of the Rhein below Germersheim. He was a customs official in the village in 1652. Most of those people came originally from Switzerland.

It appears I have checked all of the early churches in Cincinnati:

St. Peter in Chains (marriage there, but no baptism)  
Holy Cross Immaculata  
Old St. Mary's  
St. Francis Xavier  
  
St. Thomas  
St. Joseph (Ezzard Charles Drive)

Unless you have any other suggestions, Patrick may not have been baptized in Cincinnati. There is one other possibility. His father had a brother over in Newport, Kentucky. Was there a Catholic Church at Newport at that time? Is this in your Archdiocese or could you give me the proper address. I believe the family lived on 9th st. in downtown Newport.

Also, one of the Cincinnati Harrigans left money in her will to a Passionist Monastery over in Kentucky. Possibly baptisms took place over there?

Another suggestion, although Patrick's baptism may not be there, this family definitely was living in the area on the enclosed map around 1860. Would appreciate having any later baptisms c. 1855-1861. There must be other children baptized in the most logical church.

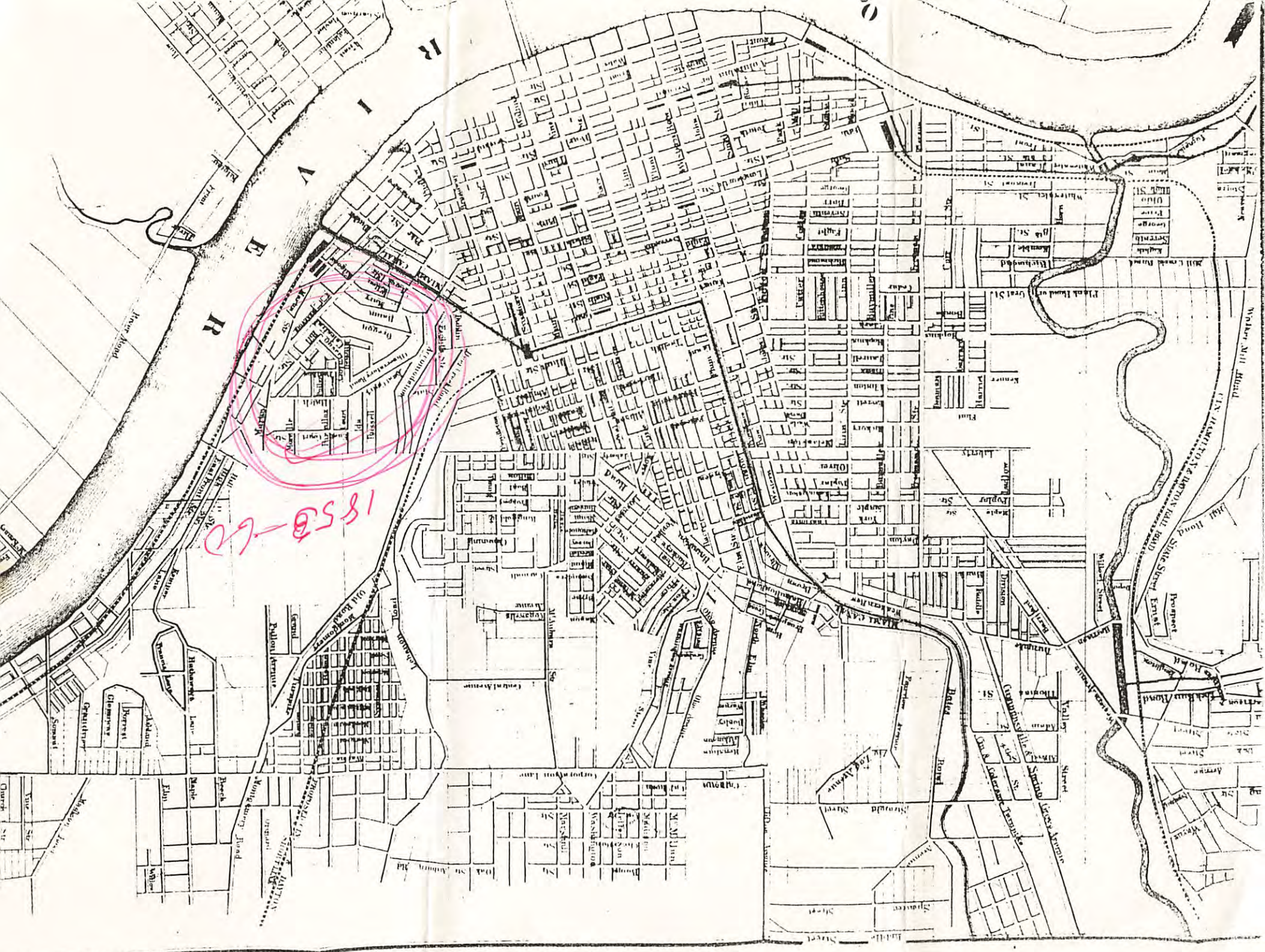
I have only approximate dates for some children, but do have a Peter A. Harrigan born 27 Mr 1858

Dear Dr. Eakle:

Please forgive me for not writing sooner. I saw your query in "Our Keystone Families" but have been unable to write sooner since I work full time and have been out of town part of the time.

For about ten years I have researched the various Orndorff families which were known to have emigrated in the 18th century to Pennsylvania. I am descended from three different Orndorff emigrants. There were several emigrations in the 18th century:

1709-10 Henry Ohrendorff to New York (researched by Hank Jones)  
1737 Herman Orndorff to Lebanon Co., PA  
1741 Christian Orndorff to Lebanon Co., PA  
1753 Johan Conrad Ohrendorff to PA & MD  
Johannes Peter Ohrendorff to PA & MD  
Philip Henrich Arndorff (Ohrendorff) to PA  
1765 Joes. Ohrendorff to PA  
Henrich Ohrendorff

Most, if not all, of these Ohrendorffs came from the old territory of Nassau-Siegen or nearby, now approximately Kreis Siegen, Lower Northrhine Westfalia.

Herman Orndorff, 1737, was the nephew of Christian Orndorff of the 1741 emigration. Herman is my ancestor.

The 1753 emigrants came from a parish about 12 miles from Herman and Christian's area. Conrad and Peter were brothers, but apparently not related to Philip Henrich, although all emigrated from the same parish of Burbach. Peter and Conrad stayed a while in then Lebanon Twp., Lancaster Co., Pa., but both bought land and finally settled in Carroll Co., MD in the 1770's. Peter is my ancestor.

Philip Henrich settled in Chester Co., PA, with descendants moving into the Shenandoah Valley in the last quarter of the 18th century. No connections to the Lebanon Co. Orndorffs that I have detected.
