Greetings to all visitors to the "Harrigan That's Me!" web site, especially those who are visiting for the first time. I am working to update the site and adding to the index. Keep checking back. The site is still attracting considerable attention, and I have enjoyed corresponding with a lot of Harrigans and other searchers since the last update. I am going to include a Harrigan coat of arms which I am wondering if anyone can verify. I'll include as well the bit of information I have about it.

The Harrigan Coat of Arms

The Harrigan Coat of Arms hereby illustrated is officially documented in Burke's *General Armory*. The original description of the arms (shield) is as follows:

"Vert Three lions ramp.or"

when translated the blazon also describes the original colours of the Harrigan arms as

"Green; three gold lions attacking"


Above the shield and helmet is the crest which is described as"

"A gold half lion attacking"

I have not actually seen this coat of arms in Burke's *General Armory*, but I have seen it described in several public papers, so assume it is okay to forward this to you for your consideration.



Has anyone seen this crest before? We are looking for information or background.




A number of people have asked about the Joe King books. I have posted more complete information on the [Harrigan GenForum](#), but I'll repeat it here. I have recently heard from Barbara and Jack O'Connell of Schull Books in Ballydehob, Co. Cork, Ireland. They have copies of the book "Ireland to North America".



This book deals specifically with emigration from the Schull area of SW Cork. The families mentioned include the Harrigans, and indeed the front cover shows a photograph of Harrigan's Rocks, situated just off the coast. There is a photograph of Bing Crosby's mother, Catherine Harrigan Crosby, cutting the cake on her 90th birthday at Bing's house. The book sells at \$10 plus postage, either by surface or airmail to anywhere worldwide. If you are interested in Irish military history, this is also a source to investigate. 

My Insurance policies and stock certificates are in Lock Box in my name at Newport National Bank, Monmouth Street, Newport, Ky. If due to sickness expenses there is not enough money to pay all bequests mentioned, just pay Mass stipends and to my cousin Sallie Havens.

The attached lists will tell you what household items belonged to me to be disposed of and which ones were owned by my friend Leona (Kohsin) White, who formerly lived with me and passed away, June 1962.

This being my Last Will and Testament and I am of sound mind.

My husband Joe's great-great grandfather was Rhodes Harrigan. Rhody's daughter Mary Elizabeth his great grandmother. How is your grandfather related to Rhody?

Most of my genealogical information is still on my Family Tree program. Though, as I come across records, I have been adding them to Ancestry. I teach 4th and 5th graders, so during the school year most of my computer time is spent writing lesson plans and entering grades. Genealogy happens more consistently in the summer.


