



I am sorry it has taken so long to answer your letter, but I have been very busy and have not had the time to research the records. In answer to your question if I can locate other family members with different surnames, I cannot do this as all the records are only listed alphabetically. They did not list a whole lot of information back in the 1800's and early 1900's. I have researched all the Harrigan's buried in this cemetery and have found that only the three you asked about are buried on the same lot.

3/31/1976 Mary Harrigan; Section 2; S ½ Lot 13' Range 4; born in Cincinnati; residence was 51 Mitchell Avenue; parents were Thomas & Fannie; died of consumption; age 16 years, 8 months.

5/20/1877 Fannie Harrigan; same lot; born in Kings; residence was 51 Mithcell; parents were Patrick & Rebecca Doyle; died of consumption; age 51 years.

10/16/1876 Thomas Harrigan; removed from the Old Cemetery to this lot. Age 42 years.

There are probably three other people on this lot, but I am unable to research without some idea of a last name. If I can be of any further assistance, please let me know.


