However, they had arranged their book according to generations--placing all the first generation together, then all the second, third, fourth, etc. in the following pages. To make the tree, I had to re-arrange all this information according to the respective families, using the trunk of the tree for the great-great grand parents, and the big branches for their children. You will readily see that BRIDGET BUCKLEY married MICHAEL HENNEBERRY, my great-grand parents. To this union were born five children, MICHAEL, (my grandfather), Mary, Jeremiah, James (who did not marry) and John .

Enclosed with this letter, you will find all the members of the Henneberry family beginning with MICHAEL HENNEBERRY AND BRIDGET BUCKLEY, down to the last member today.

As you say, the Henneberry name is an uncommon one , and for this reason they may all be related, however, from you information on the Henneberry's, we probably are not too closely related.

I have no information about my great -grand father Michael Henneberry, except that he and his wife settled in Jackson County, Iowa and is buried in the North Garry Owen Iowa cemetery. When he came to Jackson county, or where from, I do not know. There even be a question as to whether the name Henneberry is Irish or Scottish, I did find the name Henbury, meaning a "high fort" listed with Irish names. My grandfather Michael Henneberry moved to Humboldt county and settled on a farm. Later he married Mary Ann Calligan and to this union, ten children were born. My mother Bridget was the oldest, married Patrick Henry Ford and I am the oldest of this union. We have always claimed to be Irish-Americans.

John Henneberry who married Catherine Flanigan remained in Jackson county, and most of his children still live there.

I do know that none of the names listed in Chicago directory are not of our branch of the Henneberrys, as I do know where they all live. William Henneberry who married Stella Spring, moved to Pennsylvania and settled there. They adopted two children. I kept track of Alice who married Dr. Arthur Tiemeyer, but of John and his family I could find no trace. As we had very little correspondence with William and his family after he moved to Pennsylvania, none of us remember even where they lived. Hence, it is possible that some of the Henneberrys in Pennsylvania might be related to us.

I do know from my research that unless one knows when and what parish they were baptized in Ireland, there is no chance of getting any information from this source. My grand father Patrick Ford came from Galway county, Ireland, but when I tried to get information on him, I was told that Galway county, which is comparable to our states, has over hundred churches or parishes. Where does one start with so many churches? I also know that unless one knows when they left Ireland, on what ship, and where they landed in America, it is next to impossible to secure any information from the civil or immigration records in Ireland.

I am enclosing a list of sources you might refer to if you interested in further research. Since most of them involve some expense, I didn't contact them.

As to any publications, Mrs. Berger, I did nothing more than the family tree. At my age and as a Sister, I did not have the time, energy or money to carry on much research.

I do wish you every success in your research, and if you do secure any information on my great-great grand father as to any brothers or sisters from your branch of the Henneberrys, I should be very interested in knowing. I could pass it on to some of my nieces or nephews or cousins.

May God continue to bless you and all your dear ones, and be assured that all the Henneberrys will be remembered me in my daily prayers.

The chief source of information for this history was from the fourth generation of descendants. However, there are many other sources that could be used. Here are a few: In IOWA, three libraries are most often used by genealogists: 1) The Department of History and Archives and the Iowa Census Bureau (part of the State Capitol complex, Des Moines); 2) the library of the Iowa Genealogical Society, 6000 Douglas Avenue, Des Moines; and 3) the library of the Iowa State Historical Society, Iowa City.

Elsewhere in the United States are several outstanding libraries for genealogists: 1) The National Archives, Washington, DC; 2) The Library of Congress, Washington, DC. Perhaps the largest genealogical collection is the Genealogical Society of the Latter Day Saints (LDS) Library, Salt Lake City, Utah 84150.

In Ireland there are two Genealogical Offices: 1) The Register General, Custom House, Dublin, has records of all births, marriages, and deaths since 1800. Send as much precise information as you have and specify exactly what you would like to know; and 2) The Genealogical Office, Dublin Castle, Dublin 2, has records of heraldic information.

Local sources of information that could be used are: State vital statistics, state and county histories, family Bibles, Church records, newspaper clippings of marriages, births, obituaries, etc.; school, cemetery, probate court, immigration and naturalization records, and abstracts of land. Practically all these sources require a fee depending on the extent of the research.

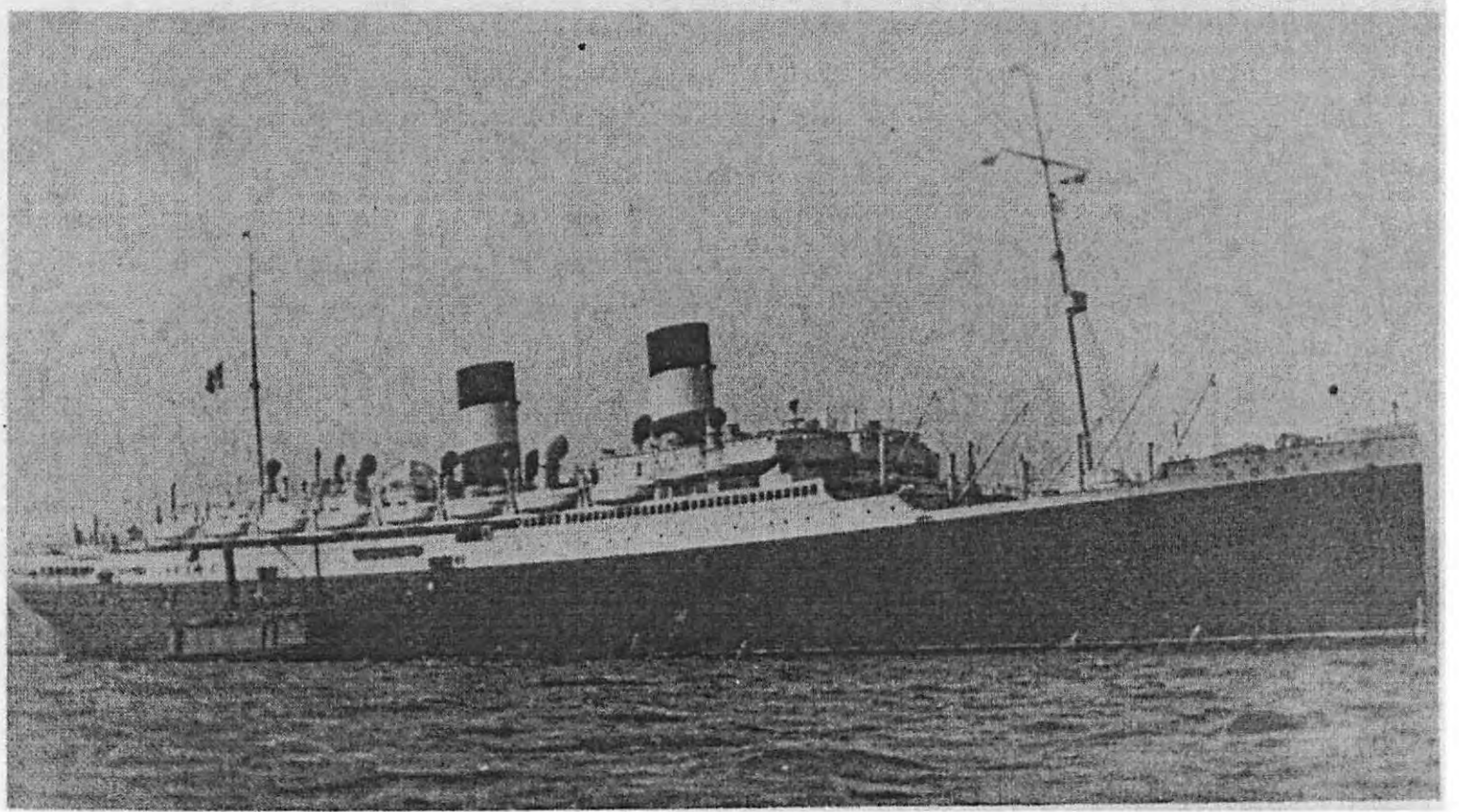


My husband, James J. Henneberry, is now deceased but I thought it only proper to answer your letter of July 15th, regarding any information of a Thomas J. Henneberry family.

I have found in my experience with newspaper and census records that names were often spelled phonetically.



The Henneberry family that I belong to and Mike is not related to anyone other than our own immediate circle for this reason. My grandfather Henneberry (James - married to Margaret O'Connell) migrated to Canada due to famine, persecution or what have you and according to my aunt Ella Henneberry Cole, now deceased, his name was Henebry, but he met a priest named Henneberry so what was good enough for the priest was good enough for him. So if that is true and appears it is, we are not related to anyone named Henneberry except our own progeny.

Grandfather was from Clonmel which is in Tipperary County which is just above Waterford County in Ireland - I don't know the date, but he went to Perth Amboy in Canada which I think is just the name of a locality rather than a town as there is no Perth Amboy on the map and I have made inquiries with no results except there is a Perth I believe and I think that is in Ontario.

At any rate he is supposed to have grain mills or wheat mills which some enemy burned (the Irish always seem to have enemies when something happens) so he migrated to the U. S. A. to Webster City, Iowa. He had ten children - Mike (Mike's great grand-father), Jim, Pat, Walter, Joe, Dave, Ella, Margaret, Mary and John. I think Mike was the oldest and possibly my father, Jim was next - at any rate my father was born in Canada and I don't know how many of the rest of them were - Pat, Dave, Walter & John died in childhood, supposedly from consumption which would be TB in our day.

It seems strange that from ten children they only had eleven grandchildren. Joe had no children, Jim, (my father) had three, Ella married Horace Cole and had one son George Cole; Mary married a Murphy and had one child, Marge Murphy Boylan; Mike had one child, Rex (Mike's grandfather); Margaret married Harry Pray and had five children. I am going into this detail as I am sending a copy of this to Mike so he will be a little more up to date.


