

DEAR Mrs. Berger,

Your name was secured from "The Amazing Story of the Henneberrys in America" published by Sharon Taylor. The enclosed chart shows our lineage for the past four generations. Our David and Jane (QUISHING/CUSHING) HENNEBERRY embarked from Cork, Ireland on the ship "Argyle" and arrived in New York on 17 June 1848. With them were their 12 children, several children-in-law and grand children. We have been able to identify about 35 passengers named on the manifest as being HENNEBERRY and/or CUSHING relatives.

The first David on our chart was a first cousin of Daniel O'CONNELL, the Irish Patriot. Family tradition has it O'CONNELL was responsible for having David appointed as Tax Collector in County Tipperary. It is said that David also owned Hotels in "the old sod".
