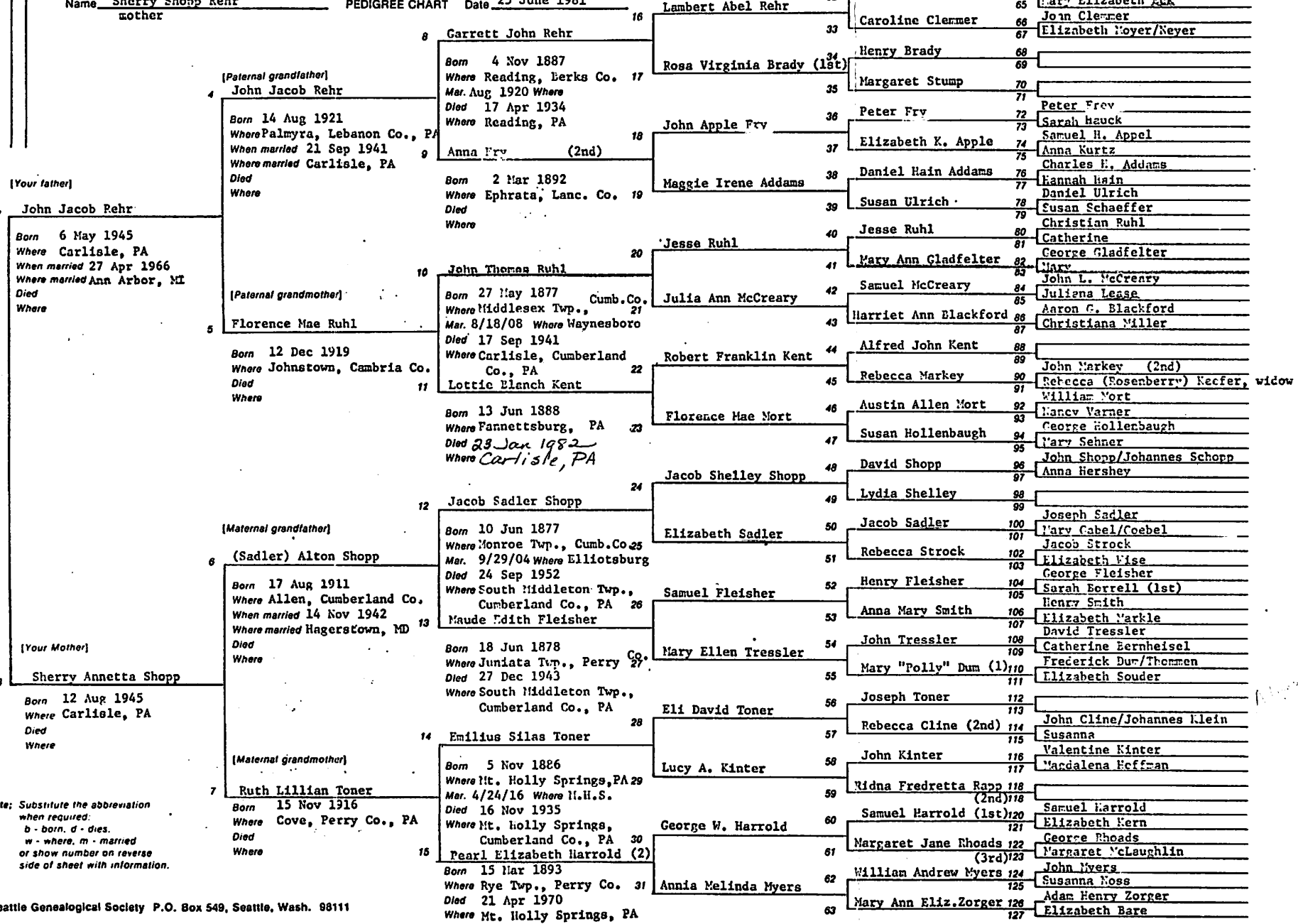

THE ADAMS FAMILY OF CONEWAGO AN AMERICAN CATHOLIC PIONEER FAMILY OF PENNSYLVANIA

Thomas Adams was born in the British Isles, probably Ireland, on July 5, 1735. Tradition has it that he came to America in the 1750s. In 1756 he acquired 118 acres in York Co, present day Adams Co., Pa., near a Jesuit Mission called Conewago Chapel, not far from Hanover. Thomas is said to have served both as a Provincial and Revolutionary War soldier.

Thomas married Magdalena, and they had nine children between 1755 and 1776

Joseph, born 1755-1758, married Elizabeth
Jacob, born July 10, 1761, married Mary
Thomas, born 1762-1764, married Maria
John, born 1764-1765, married Elizabeth
William, born 1765-1766, married Eve Sanker(Zanker)
Ignatius, born 1767, married Maria
Elizabeth, date unknown, married Peter Kaylor(Kehler)
Mary, born 1772-1773, married John Elder
Richard, born Sept. 6, 1776, married Margaret Marchal
(Marshall)

Thomas died prematurely, at the age of 41, on Dec. 5, 1776. He is buried immediately behind Conewago Chapel, now a Minor Basilica as an American Catholic Shrine. The reverse side of his slate tombstone bears this whimsical inscription in German:

Now has my struggle come to an end.
my run is complete. I go to my Jesus
and say to you all Good Night.

Jacob, Thomas, Ignatius and Richard, stayed behind in the Conewago area and had large families that produced hundreds of modern day descendants in South Central Pa. Joseph, William and Elizabeth Kaylor moved west to the Alleghenies in the mid-1790s or early 1800s, and were among the founding families of Prince Gallitzins pioneer Catholic parish at Loretto, Pa., founded in 1799.

Thomas widow, Magdalena, survived her husband by a full 50 years. She raised the children and managed the farms. She died Jan. 2, 1826, just over the border from Conewago at Taneytown, Maryland. Her tombstone at St. Josephs Catholic Church says she died "loaded with years and virtuous deeds"
