OBITUARY : HELEN M. ORNDORFF

Helen Marie Orndorff passed away March 3, 2006 in Anaheim, California. She was born in Butte, Montana on Feb. 14, 1915, the daughter of Joseph Edward Harrigan and Helena Cecelia Dennison. In 1919 she moved with her parents and younger sister, Harriet, from Montana to Los Angeles, California, where the family eventually settled in the Wilshire District for many years.

Her father owned the Hotel Astoria on Bunker Hill in Los Angeles and she could remember many interesting things about the earlier days of the city. Helen attended St. Brendan's Grammar School in Los Angeles, and St. Brendan's Catholic Church, even before the present beautiful Gothic church was built. She attended Immaculate Heart High School for two years, but graduated from Fairfax High School in 1931. Although an excellent student, the depression years set back her plans to attend college. However, she did graduate from a fashion design school in 1932. She was very artistic and also sewed beautifully.

Helen married Edward Jesse Orndorff on Sept. 12, 1936. They had five children: Camilla Berger, Christopher, Carlton who died in 1980, Charles and Joseph. She is also survived by five grandchildren: Lisa Marasco, Larry and David Berger, Karen Farley and Sarah Orndorff. Great-grandchildren are: Christopher, Ryan, Stephanie and Eric Marasco, Lindsay, Matthew, Kelsie and Emily Berger, Felicia, Mitchell, Nathan and Rosalind Berger, and two more great-grandchildren expected in June by her granddaughter Karen Farley. A great-great-grandchild, Alexis Marasco, was born last year.

In 1956, the family moved to Burbank, California, where Helen and Ed finished raising their family. Helen was a "caretaker" all of her life. When she was young, her mother was often ill, and she looked after her younger sister, and later nursed her ailing mother, as well as raising her own brood. She also assisted other family and friends who needed help throughout her life. She was a faithful letter writer and corresponded with many friends for years.


In Burbank, she attended St. Finbar's Catholic Church. Helen was took part in many activities, especially, the Burbank Republican Women's Club and. Air Force Mother's Club. Later on in life, she went to work part-time at May Co. Department Stores in the credit and furniture departments.

When her husband went into a nursing home in 2000, (dying in 2002) , Helen moved to Yorba Linda, CA to be nearer to her family there, but she never forgot her beloved Burbank where she loved her home and her many friends and neighbors.




