

Request to Review & Correct Error in Issue of Pension Certificate.

**GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.**

In the matter of claim No. 829262, for Ong. Pension, Act of June 24<sup>th</sup> 1890, of Jeremiah Ornduff, late Privt. Co. D, 1<sup>st</sup> Regt. of C. H. B. Maryland, Corp. Rools. Personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace, within and for the county and state

aforesaid, Jeremiah Ornduff, aged 61 years; a resident of vicinity of Red Cloud, County of Webster, and State of Nebraska, well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and

who being duly sworn according to law, states in relation to the above named claim as follows:

That he is the claimant in the above case, and further states in relation thereto, that his declaration in said case was filed, as he now best remembers, in the month of December, 1890, but respectfully request that reference be made in the records in Pension Office for correct date of filing. That he furnished, and through his attorney, J. Porter Jr. of Red Cloud, Nebraska, filed ample testimony to favorably have had his claim allowed, but that in the month of June, 1891, he received notice of his claim being rejected, on the ground that he was not disabled in a considerable degree for manual labor. That his claimant believes that his claim was rejected upon the Medical Report of Board of Examiners, at Red Cloud, who gave his case little or no attention & that the principal Surgeon on said Board or reports, has been very unfriendly toward claimant and was so at the time of said examination. That at the time, a long prior to said examination, claimant was & now is a continuous sufferer from one or the other of the disabilities alleged in his declaration, and all being chronic & permanent, viz: Herniation of his whole muscular system, Heart, Stomach & Kidney disease, Piles, Partial paralysis of arms & legs, & nervous debility, which disabilities combined, totally disable him from manual labor whereby he can earn a support. That claimant believing that great injustice had been done him by said rejection, he, by his said Attorney, on or about the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 1891, filed with Comr. of Pensions, a motion, supported by the affidavit of Dr. Robt. Donnell, M.D., to Reinstate & Reconsider said claim. That from time to time, viz: Oct. 15, 1891. March 26, 92. June 15, 92. & Jan'y 2, 93. claimant, by his said attorney, requested of Comr. of Pensions, to issue an order for further examination of claimant by another Board of examining surgeons, but could not prevail in obtaining such order. That notwithstanding such request, without having any medical examination by a Board of Surgeons, subsequent to said rejection, claimant received a "Notice of Issue of Pension" dated March 13, 1893, Cert. No. 849907, Rate \$1 per Month from Oct. 12, 1892. Days per year & disease of Rectum, only two of his alleged disabilities, the other being of a very severe nature. claimant believes that there was manifest error & oversight in the adjudication of his case, by not allowing him full pension from the date of the filing of his declaration for pension, as the law directs. That there is no date for his pension to commence in Oct. 12, 1892.

He therefore respectfully requests that a review and further consideration of his case be had, & that he be allowed an order for an examination by another Board of Surgeons, at Red Cloud, & that upon the further consideration he may receive a proper rating from the date of the filing of his said declaration, & he will hereby do & affiant further states that he has no interest in said case, and is not concerned in its prosecution.






