

Their Ancestors and Their Descendants



Charles Greenwood Orendorff and Lena Alice Caddell 1896

The following recipe was given to Lena Alice Caddell by Mrs. Stewart of Denton County, Texas when Lena was a bride. She passed the recipe on to her daughter-in-law, Ethel Victory Orendorff, saying that she used this recipe throughout her married life.

COCONUT CAKE 1896

egg whites Preheat oven to 350°

lc butter

2 c sugar

3 c flour

l c milk

2 tsp heaping, baking powder

Mix well and bake in thee layers for 25-30 minutes.

Meringue Icing

2 egg whites, beaten add 1/2 cup sugar gradually, continue beating; save out some coconut from box; add coconut to icing; spread between layers of cake sprinkle remaining coconut on sides.

Use same basic recipe, using egg yolks instead of just whites for gold cake.

Drain crushed pineapple, use between layers with coconut and icing. Then icing and coconut on top and sides.

ORENDORFF ANCESTRY

The name, Ohrndorf, has its origin in Ober-Dorf, which means "upper village." In the lapse of several centuries, the language has distilled the word "ober" to "ohr." (Ohr means ear, but in this case it has nothing to do with ears.) While there are persons researching the Ohrndorfs, who list Stephen in the early 1600's as the earliest ancestor and his son, Hermann (Hermanus) Ohrndorf (died 1694) and his son, Johann Henrich Ohrndorf (born 1661; died prior to 1708); we have chosen to begin our outline of ancestors with Johann Henrich, father of Christian I.

- I. JOHANN HENRICH OHRNDORF (1661-prior to 1708) was baptised April 15, 1661, in Halmenhof, and later lived at Hof Eichen. He married February 12, 1685 to Agnes Gieseler. They were members of the Evangelical-Reformed Church of Freudenberg, Germany. He died sometime prior to 1708. He had a brother, Christian, who was godfather to the one called "Christian I." Following Johann Henrich's death, his widow remarried. Agnes was the daughter of Johannes Gieseler who lived at Wahlbach, Siegerland, Germany.
- II. CHRISTIAN OHRNDORF I (1692-1772) married Agnes Wescheback of Eichen on January 29, 1717. He possibly had a second wife, Elizabeth von Mueller, perhaps of Giessen, but there is much controversy and discrepancy about Elizabeth von Mueller, reputed by stories passed along by family members that she was a countess. Christian I served in the Prussian Army before coming to America. He, as a widower from Kiselberg in Freudenberg, and four of his children, ranging in age from eight to seventeen, arrived in Philadelphia in September, 1741, aboard the ship, St. Mark. Christian I's eldest daughter, Louisa, was alread married to Philip Miess and the mother of a baby boy when they arrived in America. Christian II was a lad of 15 years. The family lived in the Philadelphia area no longer than four years; then, Christian I and family moved west about 60 miles to the Lebanon Valley, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, where they farmed and built and operated mills. In 1749, Christian I, Louisa and family, became members of the Hebron Moravian Church. Christian I's children were: Louisa, CHRISTIAN II (our line), Anna Margaretha, Magdalene, Anna Barbara, Johan Henrich (and possibly, Herman).
- III. (JOHANN) CHRISTIAN OHRNDORFF II (1726-1797)
 was born November 15, 1726 or 27 in Nassau-Siegen, Prussia, which lies
 between Alsaace and Nassau-Siegen--a part of Westphalia. He married Elizabeth
 Ann Hoffman in the United States. It is possible that she and her family came
 on the same ship, St. Mark. His wife's mother was later known as Elizabeth
 Cophaver. Sometime between 1758 and 1762, Christian II moved his family from
 the Lebanon Valley to western Maryland where he continued farming and milling. Christian II was one of the first to buy lots in the newly formed national
 Capital on the Potomac. He became a member of the Committee of Observation
 of Western Maryland for Revolutionary Affairs and served as a major during the

Revolutionary War. Christian II and Elizabeth remained members of the reformed Church. He died near Sharpsburg, Maryland in 1797--a distinguished citizen and a man of wealth and great hospitality. He and Elizabeth reared eleven children and educated them with great care. They were: Margaret (Peggy), Christopher, Elizabeth, Barbara, Christian III, HENRY (our line), Catherine, Mary Magdalene, John, Jacob, and Rose.

- W. HENRY OHRNDORFF (1762-1821)
 was the third son of Christian II. He served as a captain in Col. Peter Adam's regiment in the American Revolutionary War. Henry married Maria Elizabeth Alberts on December 28, 1784, according to marriage records in Christ Lutheran Church, Stouchberg, Berks County, Pennsylvania. In 1791, Christian II sold the plantation, Mt. Pleasant, to Christopher and Henry, giving each a part of the large tract. The deed to Henry was made on August 20, 1891. Henry sold back his share and moved to (West) Virginia. When his father died, Henry was one of the executors of the will. Toward the end of the eighteenth century, the three brothers, Christopher, Christian III, and Henry, moved across the state line of Maryland into what is now West Virginia and keeping close to the Potomac River, bought plantations near Shepherdstown. Shepherdstown is close to the spot so fascinating to artists, engineers, and military strategists, Harper's Ferry. Henry's children were: Jonathan, Mary, Macy, Samuel, William A., JACOB (our line), Elizabeth, John, and James. All remained single except William and Jacob. When Henry died, some were still minors.
- V. JACOB ORNDORFF (1798-1852)
 married Sarah A. Greenwood in Shepherdstown on September 21, 1842. He would have been about 44 years of age. Jacob inherited his father's heritage located about three miles west of Shepherdstown. Following his death, Sally married Martin Billmeyer and they had one son, Willie. Children of Jacob: Thomas Henry, died age 7; Sallie, died at birth; and DAVID SHEPHERD (our line).
- VI. DAVID SHEPHERD ORNDORFF (1850-1908)

 was the first of this line to put "e" in the Orendorff name. He was persuaded through correspondence by relatives in Illinois that this Americanized the name. David Shepherd, called "Shep", married Katie McPherson Keplinger in Shepherdstown June 15, 1869. After the birth of their first four children, they moved to Georgia--Cave Springs and Rome, where their other two children were born. They next moved to Denison, Grayson County, Texas where they continued to be engaged in farming. It was here that David Shepherd died. The children of David and Katie were: Harry Shepherd, Katie Hamme, CHARLIE GREENWOOD, Sallie (died as an infant), Percy Lee, and John Keplinger.
- VII. CHARLIE GREENWOOD ORENDORFF (1873-1935) worked on the farm with his father in West Virginia and moved with his parents to Georgia and later to Texas where he married Lena Alice Caddell on November 18, 1896, Aubry, Denton County, Texas. They lived in Denison, Texas, next, at Old Kemp, Oklahoma; Hugo, Oklahoma, then, farmed at Pine Lake, OK and vicinity about 1918 and 1919. The family of Charlie and Lena next moved to Hampden, north of Hugo, about 1920. Their youngest child, Donald Wayne, was born here on the Burton Place in 1921. They next moved to Rock Hill on the farm of Mr. Laird.

The summer of 1925, Charlie took a vacation to Arizona and Southern California to look over farming and he was so favorably impressed with the fertile farmland

irrigated by the Colorado River, that he returned home, telling about the crops of cotton, alfalfa, citrus, and dates. The family then moved to Bard, Imperial County, California--just across the River from Yuma, Arizona, in December of 1925. They farmed the Merring and York places from 1926 to 1929. They moved to Portales, New Mexico in Roosevelt County, and it was here that Charlie died in 1935. His widow, Lena, and 14-year old son, Wayne, continued to reside there until Lena died in 1976, age 97 years. The children of Charlie and Lena were: Fred Shepherd, CHARLES BOYD (our line), Ralph, Ray Cooper, Ruth, Collie George (Pete), Cletus Clyde, and Donald Wayne.

VIII. CHARLES BOYD ORENDORFF (1899-1972)

married Sarah Ethel Victory in Cody, Oklahoma near Hugo in 1918 in a double wedding ceremony with her sister Willie Edna and Erie Poteet. Boyd continued to farm with his father for the first two years of their marriage. In 1920, they left the farm and moved to Dillard, Oklahoma to work in the oilfields. It was here their daughter, Charlotte Madeline, was born. He worked for Wolverine Oil Co. and Carter Oil Co. They next moved to Stroud, Oklahoma and worked for the Roxanna Gasoline Plant, Ralph Risser, superintendent. Boyd worked as a truck driver and oiler at the plant under O. D. Cooke. Upon the urging of Boyd's father, he and Ethel left Oklahoma for Arizona, arriving in Yuma, January 8, 1926. They farmed one year on Avenue G and 11th Street for E. F. Sanguinetti Co. Boyd then worked for the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation from 1927 until 1963. During his long service with the USBR, Boyd worked as an electrician on telephone and powerlines under E. W. Danforth; was part-time dragline and Ruth dredge operator; then, at the Siphon Drop powerplant, northeast of Winterhaven, Imperial County, California (on Quechan Indian Reservation), he eventually became chief operator of the powerplant. In 1963, the Yuma County Board of Water Users became owners of the powerplant and as Boyd retired from the government, he was hired by the Water Users and for the next three years continued to operate the powerplant for them. Upon his final retirement in 1965, he and Ethel moved to Yuma, buying a house at 1341 Las Lomas. Boyd died November 28, 1972. Ethel continued to live there until 1980 when poor health caused her to sell the house and she moved to Glendale, Arizona with her daughter, Madeline and husband. In 1982, she moved to a retirement care center. Boyd and Ethel had two daughters: Charlotte Madeline, born 1922, Dillard, Oklahoma, and Ethelynn Jean, born 1932, Siphon Drop Powerplant location, near Winterhave, California.

IX. CHARLOTTE MADELINE ORENDORFF (1922-) married Norman Warren Glassel while he was home from the U. S. Air Force on Christmas leave on December 25, 1942. He is the son of Curtis Smith Glassel and Lola Dale Royer. After World War II, Norman (called "Kansas") and Madeline returned to Yuma where he resumed his work as ticket agent for the Southern Pacifc Railroad. He later resigned to work as sales manager for numerous automobile agencies, including Garrett Motors, Bruder Chevrolet, Varner Motors, Dana Pontiac (also Donkersley), and later acquired the Ugly Duckling Auto Leasing franchise and operated a used car lot. He and Madeline divorced in 1967. She worked as executive secretary for the president of Arizona Western College, Yuma, from 1966 to 1972 (Dr. John Barnes and Dr. George L. Hall, presidents). She moved to Phoenix in 1972 as administrative secretary to Dr. Hall who then was executive director for the State Board for Community Colleges. In 1975, she resigned to marry Joseph Ralph Cullison whose career in education included eight years as professor of agriculture at The University of Arizona and 25 years as director of vocational education in Arizona. Three years prior to retirement, he accepted a position as executive administrator for

vocational education for State Community College Board. Joseph Ralph Cullison is the son of Joseph Frederick Cullison and Minta Olive Waggoner. J. R. has only one child, a son, Jerry Wheeler Cullison who lives in Wellton, Yuma County, Arizona with his wife, Lynn Rae Smith and their six children. The children of Madeline and Norman are: Curtis Keith, born May 17, 1950, Phoenix, Arizona (he prefers to spell his name Kurt Glassell); and Nancy Gae, born January 30, 1955, Phoenix. She married Curtis Ray Davis, Jr. in 1976 and they have one child, a son, Aaron Keith, born February 21, 1982, Good Samaritan Hospital, Phoenix, Arizona.





Agnes Gieseler, mother of Christian I, was the daughter of Johannes Gieseler who lived in Wahlback, Siegerland. After the death of her husband, Johann Henrich Ohrndorf, Agnes later remarried.

Christian I, a widower, arrived on the ship, St. Mark, in Philadelphia from Rotterdam on September, 1741, with members of his family, including his 15-year old son, Johann Chritian Ohrndorf II. He was naturalized Sept. 26, 1758. When in Prussia, Christian I served in the Prussian Army. He married Agnes, daughter of Roerich Waschebach of Hof Eichen on January 20, 1715. According to elder family members who passed the story on, Christian I was married to a countess, Elizabeth von Mueller who was mother of Christian II; however, documents do not substantiate this second wife, Elizabeth von Mueller except that an American family bible belonging to James V. Orndorff, Adairville, Kentucky, says: "Elizabeth von Mueller" is wife of Christian Orndorff, so it 8s assumer that Agnes died and Chritian I married again. (Page 33, The Christian Ohrndorf Family in German by Julia A. Drake.)

Christian II arrived Philadelphia from Rotterdam, Sept. 1741; Pennsylvania records, 1759; Frederick Co MD, 1762; commissioned 2nd Major in Maryland Militia on Saturday, April 20, 1776; commissioned Major on June 22, 1778. His will was signed December 28, 1795 in Maryland before his death December 10, 1797 near Sharpsburg, MD. He and his wife remained in German Reformed Church. They had seven sons and four daughters.

Christopher's wife, Mary Thomas, was born 1755 and died October 4, 1823, age 68. Their children were: Christian who married Mary wineman; John, Aaron, Elizabeth and Enoch.

Christian III and Ana Maria Stille had five children: Christian V, William, Perry, Elizabeth, and a daughter--name unknown.

HENRY was commissioned a captain in the American Revolutionary War on Jan. 12, 1781. He and Maria Elizabeth had five children (see family sheet for details); William, Mary, Samuel, JACOB, and James. These children were minors when Henry died according to the book Millwheels to Plowshares..." page 230.

Catherine and Rose married brothers -- Rohrer. John Rohrer born 1764, died 1855.

When Jacob died, age 33 (brother of Henry), he left four children: a son, Thomas Henry; a son, John, who married Arietta A. E. Ridgley and they had a daughter, Irene, and a son, William Wllmore. Their other two are unknown.

Mary Magdalene's only child was Elizabeth who married Upton S. Lawrence, an attorney; and their children were: Mary Ann Hoffman Lawrence, Elizabeth Ann, and Martha West.

John's wife, Susan Wohlgemuth, was born 1771 and died April 18, 1810 at the home of Col. David Schnebley.

Henry was a captain in the American Revolutionary War in the Regiment of Col. Peter Adams according to the Archives of Maryland, XLV, 272 as stated in From Millwheels to Plowshares, page 55.

Christian IIs plantation, Mt. Pleasant, was divided between Christopher and Henry August 20, 1891, but Henry sold back his share and moved from Maryland to (W) Virginia, bought and improved a plantation three miles west of Shepherdstown. His children all lived to be grown--some of them quite aged and all died single except William and Jacob. All of his family is buried on the home place. Although he was appointed one of the executors of his father's will, he submitted his resignation December 28, 1797.

When Henry died, about 1821, some of his younger children were still minors according to . . . Plowshares book.


Jacob inherited his father's heritage three miles west of Shepherdstown where Henry's family died except William A and Perry (Christian's son). It is not known at this time the provisions of Jacob's will; however, a sale notice in Shepherdstown Register, December 20, 1928 referred to it as the 'Billmeyer farm,' suggesting that Sarah A. Greenwood, Jacob's widow had inherited it and when she married Billmeyer, it perhaps passed to Martin Billmeyer and his son, Willie. Research is continuing on this point of Jacob's will concerning his farm inherited from his father, Henry.

NOTE:

David Shepherd Orendorff and family left Shepherdstown, W. Va for Georgia, living at Rome and Cave Springs. Before leaving Georgia for Texas where they settled in Denison, they left an old family heirloom rosewood desk or server with a local jeweler who was a friend of the family. Their intention was to send for the old desk; however, they did not and its whereabouts are unknown. It was told to family members that the furniture came from Germany.

Notice the appearance of "e" in the spelling of "Orendorff." Through correspondence with the Illinois Orendorffs, David Shepherd was persuaded by them to change the spelling of the German name as "Orendorff" made it more Americanized.



Dr. Harold Shepherd Orendorff was 55 years when he unexpectedly passed away on Monday evening. April 29, 1974 at his home (1 College Lodge Road, Indiana, Pennsylvania 15702). He held the position of Dean of Fine Arts in the Music Dept. at Indiana University of Pennsylvania until he resigned this past year due to illness. He came here after serving as charman of fine arts at the Glenvill State College, Glenville, W. Va., a post he assumed in 1948.

He received his A. B. Degree in education from the Central Washington State College in 1939; his M. A. Degree in Education from the Teachers College from Columbia University in 1947. He obtained his doctorate in 1954.

He was a member of the Phi Mu Alpha and Phi Delta Kappa franternities. He was past president of Pennsylvania Music Educators while also a member in National and State Educational associations, the Music Educators National Conference and the Pennsylvania Music Education Asso.

Survivors were his widow and twelve children; and fourteen grandchildren.
