For some time now I have been wanting to write to you so that I could inform you in some changes/corrections/additions to the material I sent you previously regarding the Dayton Orendorfs.

1) Edward Uht, husband of Stella Gertrude Orendorf, died June 27, 1980 in Danville, Illinois. Burial in Calvary Cemetery, Dayton, Ohio.

2) Betty DAVIS Uht, wife of Leo Uht - name should read: ELIZABETH Davis Uht.

3) Kathy Uht - daughter of James Uht & Betty Kirkensteen (and wife of Curtis Boehm) - name should read: CATHERINE Uht Boehm.

4) On Family Record sheet CHARLES UHT:

a) wife Carol BARAUN - should read: Carol KINZEL
(same on family record sheet EDWARD UHT)

b) name of son of Charles Uht & Carol Kinzel should read: AUGUSTUS

c) name of daughter of Charles Uht and Carol Kinzel should read: ROSALIE

The above corrections were given me by the family, and though they are not major, I thought you might want them for accuracy for your records.

Other information that has come to me that you may find useful:

1) In case you do not have this: David Orendorff (Sr.) married Appolonia Topper on April 27, 1827 at Saint Joseph Church, Taneytown, Maryland. Minister: Nicholas Zocchi; Witness: William Orendorff.

(Oddly enough, in the same year, 1827, a David Orendorff married a woman named Reese at Conewago Chapel. I suspect it must have been a cousin of my David??)

2) Following Edward Uht's funeral service, I talked a long time with his family about our research. The following came to light:

b) My older cousin, Leo Uht (son of Edward Uht and Stella Orendorf) stated that following our Grandmother's death, our Grandfather Thaddeus Orendorf (being quite elderly) could not live alone, and consequently Leo Uht lived with him for about four years. Leo said Grandfather spoke a lot about his brother, James, whom he referred to as "Uncle Jimmy". Leo could never understand why he was called this?? In any case, Leo said you should feel free to request information of him; he said if you have specific questions, that might joggle his memory. His address:

Not too long ago, Mr. George Russell of Middletown, Maryland sent me some items of interest regarding the Cookerly family.



He had been looking up some information on Cookerlys for a client, and since he knew I was interested in the family, he passed it on to me for my use.

The main item of interest is, that Mr. Russell believes that a Johann Jacob Kugerle who was a Palatine on board the Robert & Alice (Philadelphia Sept. 11, 1738) was the ancestor of the Cookerlys of Frederick County, Maryland. I have just written to a researcher in the East asking if he would be willing to try to trace a possible relationship between this Kugerle and my ancestor, Lewis Casper Cookerly. If it should turn out that I get positive information in this regard, I will so inform you, as that would take Amelia Cookerly's line back that much further. Dear Mrs. Berger:

May I begin by introducing myself as Rev. Alcuin Leibold (born William Joseph Leibold), Grandson of Thaddeus T. Orendorff and Amelia Cookerly of Dayton, Ohio.

I was recently in contact with Mrs. Betty Millner of Glenview, Illinois, seeking information on the ancestors of Thaddeus T. Orendorf. She immediately gave me a great deal of information she had about the family. She mentioned that she had received most of the information from you, early in 1979, and that perhaps new information might have come to light since that time. Hence, this letter to you.

I am enclosing a copy of information on Thaddeus T. and Amelia F., and their Dayton, Ohio descendants, which might be of interest to you. Please excuse the fact that I did not use the ordinary forms for this - I can only say that I am a rank amateur in this, and hope in time to have all my information recorded on proper forms.

As far as we know, Thaddeus changed the spelling of the family name to ORENDORF when he came to Dayton - we do not know the reason for this. But all of the Dayton line have continued to use this changed spelling.

No one today seems to know why our Grandparents moved to Dayton, although we know that there was a rather sizeable community of Maryland natives in the city, and many of our Grandparents' friends were natives of Maryland.

Amelia was a Cookerly from near Middletown, Md., her father was a merchant (in 1850) and a family tradition says that he was also a slave owner of sorts during the Civil War.

Some of the relatives I have really lost contact with, but I think there are enough addresses, that these persons could either answer your questions, or could put you in contact with the relatives involved.

In a couple of cases I have indicated myself as the one to contact, and this was simply that I suppose I have about all the information available (or could get it) of certain segments - e.g., Lewis Casper Cookerly family.

I should mention that I am giving you the addresses of three persons who might be helpful to you:

1. Rev. Thomas Leibold

He is the oldest male grandchild of Thaddeus and may well remember various things that Grandpa may have told him before he died.

2. Mrs Mary Frances (Walter) Hoy

She is the oldest of the grandchildren, and also may have some recollections which I do not know of. She is the one who told me that Grandpa had told her about the change in the spelling of the name - so she may have other recollections.

2. Mrs. Ann (Raymond) Weitzel

She is my oldest sister, and from time to time has come up with interesting things about the family, which I had never heard. If you had specific questions to pose to her, it's possible she may remember things that she simply has never mentioned.

Yes, I regret that we were not in contact before my mother's death. She died at 87 and was bright and alert to the end. She retained a lot of information from her earlier life and was always a good "story teller".

As to what material I might be interested in, I can only say that I would prefer to leave that up to you. I would be interested in perhaps some further information about your ancestor Jacob, since it would be nice to know something about your family, now that I have discovered an Orendorf relative! Also, I would appreciate the names and addresses of the other relatives of David that you are in touch with, as this would give me a good contact point with the Maryland clan, which I am lacking at this

time. I myself am hoping that within the next year or so I am able to arrange to take my vacation in the Maryland area, and fill in some of the gaps that I am missing, as well as visiting some of the areas where the ancestors lived, etc.

I am so pleased to hear that you and another lady are possibly planning a book on the Orendorf Family. I do hope that if it reaches the publication stage, you would let me know, as I would most certainly want to purchase a copy of it. Of course it is also possible that some of the other Dayton Orendorfs might also be interested in making a purchase. Do keep us in mind.

I appreciated very much the information (and I intend to save it) that you gave on the historical background of the Orendorfs in regard to their religious persuasion. It certainly is complicated, isn't it? I find the idea that they were connected with the Dunker group especially interesting.

I had attempted to obtain information about David and Apalonia from St. Anthony parish (near Emmittsburg) where they are buried. But to no avail. You know some pastors are unwilling to cooperate. I would hope to visit that parish sometime and check the marriage records etc. I just strongly suspect that perhaps David may have joined the Church when he married Apalonia. It is quite possible that Grandpa just always considered his father a Catholic, and never even mentioned to his children that there was a conversion. I never heard Mother or any of the aunts and uncles speak of this.

As to myself, I am the youngest of Thaddeus' grandchildren (and that is probably why I do not know much about the history of the family as he died when I was quite young). I grew up in Dayton, came to Indiana for College and Theology studies, and made profession as a Benedictine here at Saint Meinrad about 30 years ago. This monastery was founded in 1854 by monks from Switzerland, and we now have about the largest seminary in the U.S. (We train priests for Dioceses all over the U.S.) There are about 200 priests and Brothers living here permanently. Of course we have various enterprises etc, and we do work in parishes on weekends. It is quite a beautiful place and I hope to live out my life here! I have my B.A. in History, but for about the past seven years I have been serving as private secretary to the Archabbot, the head of this community.

I do want you to know that I appreciate so very much the time and trouble you went to to answer my inquiry. Be assured that if I can help you in any way in the future, do not hesitate to ask. As I mentioned earlier, I am a rank amateur in this whole thing, but there just might be some bits of additional information, or leads, which I could assist you with, and perhaps save you a bit of work.

Again, sincere thanks, and all good luck on your project and I do hope you will be able to complete it!

Although you will not be returning from the East until June, I am writing this now - while I have the time - and will mail it at a later date.

First of all, thank you so very much for your very kind and comprehensive letter. The historical facts you included were very great, and add much to my knowledge of my forebears.

With this letter, I am enclosing the following items:

- 1) A xerox copy of Mrs. Millner's materials. I think it's easier to send you this, than to try to explain to you just how much she provided me with. Do not return this, as I have her original.
- 2) Xerox copies of the various families of Thaddeus T. Orendorf who are of the Dayton branch. I hope you don't mind the format. Just after I wrote to you the first time, I looked through several types of record sheets, and decided to make up my own format for my own purposes. I think it contains all the basic information that would be asked for on the type of sheet you use.
- 3) A list of "contact persons" of the Dayton Orendorf's should you wish to obtain more detailed information from any of them. You will note that on the younger generations I am lacking a lot of details, but at the time I was more interested in getting down names and relationships, and figured that I could gather the more detailed information at my leisure.

Thaddeus did make two or three return trips to Maryland to visit his family. My own family made a number of visits, but on only one of these (when I was quite young) did we visit Orndorff relatives. Strangely enough, though the family kept in contact with the Cookerlys over all these years (and I still do), there was only that one contact with Orndorffs. Frankly, that is why I found it so difficult to get any information - I really have no contact point with that side of the family. As we look back at it now, we all wonder if perhaps there some animosity between the two families!

Thaddeus was employed in Dayton at the Barney Car Works and in his later years he was employed by the City Park Commission. I recall that Amelia was a dainty little lady with long skirts, mob cap and apron! Thaddeus was a well built man, gray hair, and a handsome handelbar moustache!

I would say that their four children married rather well, raised pretty fine sons and daughters, etc. For the most part the descendants pretty much remained in the Dayton area. L. Edgar had no sons, Charles had one son, who has married and has one son, so it appears that the name in Dayton will probably continue through him.

Let me say here that my interest in the ancestors on both sides, is simply an amateur one. I have no intention of publishing, etc. I began this work shortly before the death of my elderly Mother, as she was one of the last of her generation, and I felt that this information should be passed on. I do share it with my family and cousins, and the younger generations especially have become very interested and thrilled with each new development. So I feel my small efforts have been worthwhile.

I suppose my main reason for writing to you, is to ask if any new information has come to light since you wrote to Mrs. Millner in early 1979 - information which you might be willing to share with me.

Also, If possible, I would appreciate having a list of the sons and daughters of Jacob (your ancestor) and the brother of David Sr., my great-grandfather. I realize that to go beyond that point would be very involved. Also, do you happen to know if Jacob was German Reformed (as Mrs. Millner indicates Peter Sr. was)? I ask this because Thaddeus was Catholic (as we are) and David his father, Apalonia his mother, are buried in a Catholic Cemetery in Emmittsburg. Our family is curious to know where the Catholicism came into the line!

Finally, may I ask if any new information has come to light regarding the sons and daughters of David Sr.? Mrs. Millner gave me a complete list of their names, and the married names of the girls, and also where they were living at the time of the 1888-89 Orendorff Family Directory.

I am most grateful to you for taking the time to read this letter, and I hope that my enclosed sheets will add just a bit more information to what you have already gathered. If I can supply any further - or more detailed - information about any of the individuals on the enclosed sheets, please do not hesitate to let me know.

DEATH OF A. F. ORNDORFF

Aloysius F. Orndorff well known in Carroll and Frederick counties, died at his home in Thurmont, on Wednesday, aged 79 years. Death was due to results of a fall. Funeral services were held in Taneytown, on Friday morning from St. Joseph's Catholic church.

Mr. Orndorff resided in Taneytown for many years. A portion of the time he engaged in merchansiding, and was Justice of the Peace for an extended period. He had also, at various times, been in business at other places, and on his removal from Taneytown kept store at Roddy, Frederick county, for several years before removing to Thurmont.

He was twice married, his first wife, Miss Julia Riddlemoser, a sister of the late Mrs. Louis Elliot, and his second wife, who survives him, a daughter of Mr. George C. Crass, of Westminster. By the first marriage the following children are living: Mrs. V. J. Eckenrode, Joseph, of Detroit, Mich.; Mrs. W. H. Adelesperger, Oseloa Mills, Pa.; Edward, of St. Paul, Minn; Sister Bernard, St. Joseph's Academy, Emmitsburg, Md.; Mrs. Jacob Buffington, Taneytown, Md.; Wm. R., Spokane, Wash.; Mrs. Kenneth Pontius, N. Yakima, Wash.; and Mrs. J. M. Roddy, Four Points, Md.

I have never gotten around to putting this information from my group sheets onto a family history program yet. I don't have a lot of information on this particular family group. It is mostly from a family record compiled by my grandfather's sister, Guilletta Barrett Orndorff Coffin in the 1880s after or before or during attendance at an Orndorff Family Reunion with Orndorffs from many branches and parts of the country. Also I have some census information, and P. 868 of the book Names in Stone, Frederick County Maryland.

Here goes:

Aphalona Topper (Appalonia) b. c. 1808, died 22 Dec 1882. Buried St. Anthony Catholic Cemetery nr. Emiitsburg, MD

She married b. 182? David Orndorff, b. 1 June, 18803, d. 3 Mr 1891 buried St. Anthony Cath., Emiitsburg. Here was the son of Peter Orndorff, Jr. and Rosina Pfeiffer of Taneytown, Carroll Co., MD. Also the grandson of the Oct 2, 1753 Ship Edinburg, Johannes Peter Orndorff who settled along with his brother Johannes Conrad in Carroll Co., MD in the 1770s. Although the Orndorffs were Protestant, some of them married Catholics. This family was Catholic. The children were:

I don't know where you live, but I left a copy of many of my group sheets years ago at Carroll Co. Historical Society. The information also turned up on the Internet a while back at another website out of Adams or York Co., PA. I don't know who did that, but its ok.

I don't know exactly who her parents were, but I believe that there were Toppers in the Catholic records in Adams/York Co., PA. Watch the various spellings of the name: Tapper, Tappert, etc. I have a little more information on some of the descendants, but it is sketchy and not well documented. If you learn who she is, please let me know. Perhaps an obituary would shed some light. There should be one somewhere. This family should be found in the Catholic records in Carroll and/or Frederick Co. also. Do you live anywhere back in the Maryland area ?
