Sorry to be so long replying to your letter of Feb 16 1981. I cannot identify your Maryarentz - I'm sure the name is also spelled Arndt, Arendt, etc.

My Jacob arndt came from Northampton Co Pa Ca 1780 to York (later Adams Co) Co Pa. He had sons Peter 1756-1836 + John 1769-1826, both of who remained in Adams Co. ~~I do not know their issue but~~ John had no children. Peter had issue because I have a reference to "Daniel arndt, a great nephew of John" (1850 ca.) and by 1900 ca. "Daniel's son Keller arndt" apparently some of them remained in Adams Co. and would be in ct. hs. records. The Adams Co. Hist. Society in Gettysburg has some good records.

My lack of knowledge is due to my ancestor being a dau. of Jacob + the m. an Oyer and moved 1<sup>st</sup> to Frederick Co Md then Franklin Co. Va. So I have not researched her siblings - however, your Mary b. 1812 would fall into the next generation.

Stricker + Hinkle's Germ. immigrants book has several Arndts on shipping lists. There is a big book The story of the Arndts by John Stover Arndt with many descendants listed, but not mine.
