Admiral Johnston was transferred to Washington, D.C. on Sept. 1917. Admiral Valentine Nelson took Command of U.S. Naval Station Algiers New Orleans, Louisiana, and served on him till May 1918.

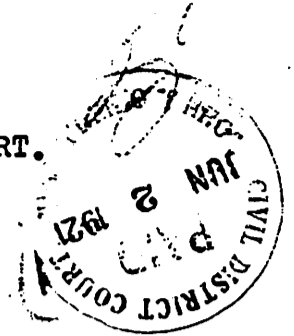
