


John Willbanks, son of **Richard and Priscilla (Hewett) Willbanks**, was born between 1774 and 1784 in Wilkes County, North Carolina.

John Woolbanks appears in Pendleton District, South Carolina in the 1800 census on page 48 next to Henry and Berrymon Woolbanks. In his household are 2 males under 10 years of age, 1 male between 16 and 26 years, 3 females under 10 years of age, and 1 female between 26 and 45 years of age.

John appears on a tax list in Warren County, Kentucky as early as July 14, 1803 on page 32. He continues to appear there for the next ten years: August 3, 1804 on Dry Creek--page 28; 1807 with 100 acres--page 28; 1811--page 66; 1812 with Berryman and Reuben Wilbanks on page 79; 1813 again with Berryman and Reuben Wilbanks on page 70.

John appears in the Warren County, Kentucky 1810 census with 1 male under 10 years of age, 1 male between 10 and 16 years, 1 male between 26 and 45 years, 1 female under 10 years, 1 female between 10 and 16 years, and 1 female between 16 and 26 years of age.

John's first wife is unknown, though it is apparent that he was married before he married Priscilla Wadkins on September 5/8/25, 1811 in Warren County, Kentucky. She was born circa 1790 in North Carolina.

John died before 1820 either in Warren County, Kentucky or in Tennessee. A Priscilla, Henry and Owen Woolbanks appear in Franklin County, Tennessee in the 1820 census together on page 33 and 34. As John's brother, Berryman, went to and died in Tennessee, I presume that these three could be John's wife and two sons. In this 1820 Franklin County, Tennessee Census, Priscilla is listed as having the following in her household: 2 males under 10, 2 females under 10, and one female between 26 and 45.

Priscilla Woolbanks next appears in Franklin County, Tennessee on page 105 in the 1830 census. In her household are 2 males between 10 and 15 years of age, 1 female between 10 and 15, 1 female between 15 and 20, and 1 female between 40 and 50.

The 1840 Tennessee census does not locate Priscilla Wilbanks. She may have been living in the household of one of her children.

The 1850 Tennessee census, dated November 27th, lists Prissilla Willbanks in the household of her son, William, in Wayne County, 12th Civil District, page 209, dwelling number 429, family number 434.

CHILDREN OF JOHN WILLBANKS

Henry Willbanks, son of John Willbanks and his first wife, was born in 1793 in Pendleton District, South Carolina.

Henry married Ann --?-- circa 1820 in Tennessee. Ann was born circa 1802 in Tennessee. Henry Woolbanks appears in Franklin County, Tennessee in the 1820 census on page 33 and 34.

A Henry Willbanks is found in Limestone County, Alabama in the 1830 census, page 26A. In his household are 1 male between 30 and 40 years of age, 2 females under 5, 2 females between 5 and 10, and 1 female between 20 and 30.

The Alabama 1840 census lists Henry Woolbanks in Limestone County, page 131A. In his household are 1 male under 5 years of age, 1 male between 5 and 10, 1 male between 40 and 50, 1 female between 5 and 10, 2 females between 10 and 15, 2 females between 15 and 20, and 1 female between 30 and 40.

The Alabama 1850 census, dated November 11th, lists Henry Wilbanks in Limestone County, District # 4, page 16, dwelling and family number 223.

The Alabama 1870 census, dated July 19, lists Henry Wilbanks in Lauderdale County, Township 2 Range 7, Rogersville post office, page 493. He is listed as a farmer with real estate valued at \$200 and personal property valued at \$300.

Owen Wilbanks, son of John Willbanks and his first wife, was born in 1797 in Pendleton District, South Carolina.

Owen appears to have volunteered as a soldier during the War of 1812, serving as a private in Captain William Berryman's Company, 3rd Regiment, commanded by Colonel Nicholas Miller, of the Kentucky Militia. Owen enlisted August 24, 1812 in Bowling Green, Kentucky and was discharged on December 25, 1812 in Hardinsburgh, Kentucky. Owen married **Sarah "Sally" Poe** in December 1816 in Franklin County, Tennessee. Sarah was born in 1795 in North Carolina.

Owen Woolbanks appears in Franklin County, Tennessee in the 1820 census on page 33 and 34.

In a deed dated August 25, 1828, Owen Wilbanks sold 50 acres to Allen Bagget in Franklin County, Tennessee; Deed Book L, page 218.

The Alabama 1830 census lists Owen Wilbank in Jackson County, East of the 4th Range, page 118A. Listed in his household are 2 males between 5 and 10 years of age, 2 males between 10 and 15, 1 male between 30 and 40, 2 females under 5, and 1 female between 30 and 40.

On October 5, 1843 Owen filed for bankruptcy in Jackson County, Alabama.

The Tennessee 1850 census, dated January 25, lists Owen Wilbanks in Hardin County, 5th Civil District, dwelling and family number 61, page 289. He is listed as a farmer.

On August 4, 1852, Owen Wilbanks, a resident of Hardin County, Tennessee, applied for Bounty Land as a veteran of the War of 1812.

On May 5, 1855, Owen Wilbanks, a resident of Lawrence County, Arkansas, again applied for Bounty Land as a veteran of the War of 1812.

Owen died on March 20, 1856 in Lawrence County, Arkansas. An inventory of his estate was made on August 8, 1856 and is found in the loose probate papers in Lawrence County, Arkansas.

Owen was granted his Bounty Land of 120 acres on March 28, 1856.

On February 26, 1858, Sarah Wilbanks, resident of Lawrence County, Arkansas made oath that she was the widow of Owen Wilbanks.

The Arkansas 1870 census, dated August 13, lists Sarah Willbanks in Lawrence County, Marion Township, Clover Bend post office, dwelling and family number 61, page 280. She is listed with real estate valued at \$160, and personal property valued at \$500.

The 1850 Tennessee census, dated November 27th, lists William Willbanks, in Wayne County, 12th Civil District, page 209, dwelling number 429, family number 434. Prissilla Willbanks, aged 60, is listed in William's household.

The 1860 Tennessee census, dated July 21, lists William Wilbanks in Wayne County, District Number 12, Factors Fork post office, dwelling and family number 760, page 285. He is listed as a farmer with personal property valued at \$100.

William died January 1873 in Wayne County, Tennessee. Susannah died February 15, 1875 in Wayne County, Tennessee.

John Willbanks, son of John and Priscilla (Wadkins) Willbanks, was born between 1815 and 1820 in Tennessee.

It has been determined that this John was the son of John and Priscilla for at least two significant reasons. First, another John Willbanks who is about the same age as this John Willbanks, and who married Susan Shelton, has been determined to have been the son of Reuben Willbanks, the brother of John who married Priscilla. Therefore, this John could only be placed as the son of John who married Priscilla. Additionally, the fact that this John married and lived in Wayne County, Tennessee, along with a William Willbanks who has a Priscilla living in his household in the 1850 census, more substantially links this John to John and Priscilla.

John married **Susannah Morrison** on March 28, 1838 in Wayne County, Tennessee. Susannah was the daughter of Edward Morrison. She was born March 27, 1822 in Tennessee. Her parents were Edward and Lucy (Brady) Morrison.

The 1840 Tennessee census lists John Willbanks in Wayne County. In his household are 1 male under 5 years of age, 1 male between 20 and 30, and 1 female between 15 and 20. They lived next door, or with, Susannah's father.

John died by 1850.

The 1850 Tennessee census lists Susannah Wilbanks in Wayne County, 5th Civil District, dwelling number 573, family number 577, page 308.

Susannah married secondly to **George William Rinks** between 1850 and 1852 probably in Wayne County, Tennessee.

Susannah and George Rinks migrated to Missouri in about 1857 along with several other families. They traveled in covered wagons drawn by oxen, crossing the Mississippi River on Green's Ferry Boat, just north of Cape Girardeaux, Missouri. They settled in Webster County. Susannah and George Rinks had five children. George served in the Civil War and died on April 10, 1863 at a hospital in Helena, Arkansas.

Susannah married thirdly to **Andrew J. Peebles** on March 8, 1866 in Texas County, Missouri and resided in Phelps County, Missouri. In 1867, Andrew Peebles was appointed guardian of Susannah's five minor children of George Rinks. Susannah and Andrew Peebles had no known children. Andrew Peebles died before the end of 1869. Susannah died by December 27, 1871 in Phelps County, Missouri. Her oldest son, Thomas Brown Willbanks, became the guardian of Susannah's youngest children, James and Martha Rinck. Her estate wasn't settled until 1877.

Bert M Wilbanks, bn 18 April 1896, Searcy Cy, AR. Died June 1979, Shawnee, Pottawatomie Cy, OK. Married Mary Elizabeth Renfro, who died before 1962. There are funeral home records for one of their sons, Vernon Bert Wilbanks, bn 23 Jan 1916, Snowball, AR. Vernon had 3 brothers and 2 sisters living at the time of his death.

Parents of Bert M Wilbanks: Edgar Wilbanks and Nancy Jane White. Edgar, bn April 1847, is in the 1850 census, Union Cy, SC, and he is a widower in the 1900 census, Sulphur Springs, Searcy Cy, AR.
Edgar and Nancy had children: Joan, Margaret, James M, Reuben J, and Bert M.

Father of Edgar Wilbanks: John Wilbanks, bn 1788, SC. He is in the 1850 and 1870 censuses for Union Cy, SC. In 1850 he is a widower with ten kids: Phoebe, Susan, Bird, John, Elizabeth, Mary, Sarah, Thomas, Martha, Edgar.

I know nothing more about this Wilbanks line; they are not related to my Wilbanks in the Saline Cy area, Arkansas. I keep track of the "other" Wilbanks lines in AR in order to see if any of them encroach on Saline Cy. So far they haven't. The Saline Cy Wilbanks descend from the infamous Reuben Wilbanks that no one (including Robert Wilbanks) has been able to place.

Willbanks - Rev. Richard Willbanks, who died at his home near Trion Factory, Chattooga county, Ga, January 9, 1884, of paralysis, was born in Anderson district, South Carolina, about the year 1805. Made a profession of religion and joined the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, when about fourteen years of age.

He moved to Jackson county, Ga, about the year 1822. On the 30th of December, 1824, he was happily married to Miss Nancy Saunders, of Jackson county, Ga., who survives him. He moved to Chattooga county and settled in Dry Valley in 1846. In 1850 he moved to the present family residence, near Trion Factory, where he resided up to the time of his death. He was a class-leader at Hopewell Church, Dry Pond camp ground, Jackson county, in 1839 and 1841, was set apart to the office of deacon December 16, 1855, at LaGrange; was elected an elder December 2, 1870, at Augusta. His membership was at Penn's Chapel for more than thirty years. There were born to him five children, one of whom was drowned in the Chattooga river while in bathing in 1847. The other four are still living. He had been afflicted for several years with asthma, or hay fever. His love for God and His works was more than a principle--it was a holy passion. He loved the Church and the brethren with a pure heart, fervently; delighted himself in their convocations, and enjoyed the communion of saints. The field of his ministerial labor was chiefly in Chattooga county. He spent the last few years of his life in the quiet of home, having had some light strokes of paralysis, which kept him closely confined at home. A few months before his death he had a stroke from which he never recovered.

Though he reaped not the full harvest of joy at the sundown of life on earth, we can only believe in full assurance that he fell asleep in Jesus. A good man has departed. To his stricken family, relatives and friends, we would commend his many virtues, that they, like him, may be ready when the summons comes.

In addition to what Fred has provided below, I have in my notes that **Owen Woolbanks** was the son of **John Woolbanks** and an unknown wife. The 1800 Federal Census for South Carolina shows John Woolbanks with two males under 10 in his household. I have these boys listed as Owen and Henry. I believe that John Woolbanks was a son of Richard Woolbanks and Priscilla Hewitt.

By 1810 John Woolbanks appears to have moved to Warren County, Kentucky with his brother, Berriman, (probable nephew), Reuben Woolbanks and other families close to the Wilbanks. The 1810 Census for Warren County, KY shows John with 2 males under 10, 1 male 10-16 (Owen?), 1 male 26-45 (John), 1 female under 10, 1 female 10-16, and one female 16-26. The names of the daughters are unknown to me, but it is presumed that John's first wife was deceased by 1810 as she does not appear in the 1810 census and on Sept., 1811, John marries his second wife, **Priscilla Wadkins**, in Warren County, KY. I have Henry's birthdate listed as ca. 1793, and if this is correct, then he would be about 17 years old in 1810. It might be possible that his mother's death prompted him to move out on his own more quickly or that he was boarding with another family at the time. I simply can not locate him in 1810. I would guess that the male in the 10-16 age category is Owen.

As Fred has noted, **Priscilla Wadkins** is found in Franklin County, TN by 1820. John has died (I do not have his date of death) and Priscilla apparently moves with her stepsons, **Owen** and **Henry**, to Tennessee. The 1820 Census shows Priscilla, Henry and Owen in separate households, but living near to one another. Priscilla also appears to have other children in her household, likely her own children by John. By 1830 both **Henry and Owen** have moved on to Alabama--Henry to Limestone County and Owen to Jackson County.

I have tracked the John Woolbanks family and its migrations because John's wife and descendants lived in counties contiguous to Lincoln County, TN where my ever-elusive Ruben Woolbanks (b. ca. 1803, SC) resided and also nearby to Wiley Wilbanks in Madison County, AL (possible brother to Reuben). Unfortunately, I have found nothing to link the families.

I know he was living in Jackson County Alabama in 1830-1843 (maybe longer), but there was a bankruptcy filed on 10-5-1843, later found in Tenn 1850 and died in 1856 in Lawrence County Arkansas.

I have quite a bit of info, but my questions:

His son, Mathew Willbanks was born abt 1822 (Tenn) and married Luccinda A. in about 1844 in Alabama. I cannot find a record of the marriage or have no idea of her last name. Hi Betty,

I am responding to your letter of March 14th. Thank you for your payment to help with the cost of the materials I sent you regarding Wiley Wilbanks of Madison County, Alabama.

In regard to the discovery of the William Wilbanks, age 96, who appears in the 1860 Alabama Mortality Schedule, yes we probably do need to confirm this. You say that you live in Huntsville, in Madison County, and you cannot locate the existence of such a record? I haven't seen it myself as well, however, I feel pretty certain that it does exist as the Mortality Schedules were standard in the 1850, 1860, 1870 and 1880 census. It is just a matter of locating the 1860 Mortality Schedule for Madison County. I'm sure that there is a book transcription of this record, or the original can be viewed on microfilm. I don't think it requires any extensive searching in the Alabama State Archives in Montgomery. I would be very surprised that they wouldn't have it in the genealogy collection at the Huntsville Library, or any other significant genealogy libraries in Alabama.

I was informed of the discovery of this record in an e-mail dated November 30, 2002 from Necya Hanks Lawnsby of Round Rock, Texas. She says she found the record on page 80, but I don't know if it was a book or microfilm record, etc. The information was as follows:

William Wilbanks, age 96, male, married, born North Carolina, died December,
Farmer, died of Dropsy, ill for 16 days

Perhaps Mrs. Lawnsby is on this mailing list and can tell us where she discovered the record and provide more citation information so that others can locate it. Otherwise, perhaps others on this list can locate the record and provide it to all of us on this mailing list. Perhaps you can post a general query on the Madison County, Alabama mailing list in an effort to confirm the existence and location of a copy of the Madison County 1860 Mortality Schedule.

The discovery of this 96 year old William Wilbanks who died in Madison County, Alabama in 1860 is a significant discovery and needs to be followed up on. I'm sure that is one of the early William's that we find in much earlier records in North and South Carolina and elsewhere. We need to determine who this William is.

Good luck on your continuing research. I hope others can respond to this query.

I would very much like to encourage you to review the archives of the old postings to the Wilbanks Mailing List. There are many, many postings that I am sure would be very helpful to your research. You may find your answers, or at least clues in this old discussions.

Not only discussions regarding various branches, but extracts and abstracts of many, many Wil(l)banks records. For example, back in 1998 and 1999 I posted every census extract/abstract that I did of the Wil(l)banks name from the 1790 census through the 1850 census. Many others posted a wealth of other such data.

To get to these archives, you can go to the Rootsweb.com homepage, and there is a bar at the top of the page that includes a handful of selections, including Mailing Lists. You can click on "Mailing Lists", then on the "W" Surnames, and scroll down until you find Wilbanks. Click on Wilbanks and near the bottom you will find a Search mode and a Browse mode. The Browse mode allows you to see every single posting in chronological or discussion order, by month, starting with December 1997 to the current September 2003. In Search mode, you can do a search for each year. For example, check-mark 1998 and then type "Oconee" and hit search. Every discussion in that year which included the word "Oconee" anywhere in the text of the message will be displayed.

I assure you it is very much well worth the effort to search and browse.

We've already communicated in regard to this branch of Wilbanks. I do believe that your Samuel and my John are related. I have tried to find a death certificate for Samuel without any luck. I requested one in the name of Samuel Sanford Wil(l)banks, Major Samuel, and several other combinations using Samuel, Sanford, and Major. I noted that you listed him as Samuel W. Wilbanks.

Samuel and Rebecca (wife of John) homesteaded property next to one another in Jackson County in the 1880s. Until recently I could only find John Wilbanks on the 1880 census. With luck and persistence I found John, Rebecca, John, MaryA., and Miles on the 1870 census with the last name spelt as BANKS. I'm going to finish with the 1870 Jackson County Census and move on to the 1860 Census to see if maybe I've overlooked some small thing.

I believe that R. W. Wilbanks (Richard Webster) is buried in the same cemetery as Walter B. Wilbanks and Zenas Wilbanks (he's son of Houston who is the son of John). I believe that he is also related to our Wilbanks.

Could you tell me who the parents of Laura Cabiness were and if they at any time lived in Madison County, AL.

My husband recalls his grandfather Phillip Millard Wilbanks b. 1888 (son of John & Rebecca Wilbanks) talking about his relatives in Dekalb County, AL. I'll keep you updated on any new info and if you heard anything let me know.

Waiting For The Mail Train With Murder In The Air

When Dr. W. P. Cooke, cashier of the Bank of Odenville, shot Dr. J. G. Wilbanks, physician, on Sunday, July 25, 1920, the harmony and prosperity that Odenville, Alabama, had experienced since the turn of the century began to come to an end.

Oral accounts of this tragedy generally agree that another man was also involved, although it was Dr. Cooke who pulled the triggers of a double-barreled shotgun. Oral tradition also states that on the Saturday night prior to the shooting, the two men, knowing Dr. Wilbanks was out on a call, drove the roads hoping to shoot him then. They failed.

Why this attempted murder? Newspaper reports of the incident state only that the shooting was a result of a grudge between Dr. Cooke and Dr. Wilbanks.

This horrifying event shattered the town, for many folk took sides with Wilbanks or Cooke. A year later an unsuccessful attempt was made to dissolve the incorporation of the town, and a reading of the petitions for and against this move shows who sided with whom.

As on every other morning, the Sunday train delivered mail. The men of the town gathered at the post office Sunday mornings to visit, catch up on the news of the area, and wait for the postmaster to sort the mail. Sunday, July 25, 1920, was no different in that respect; however, death brooded over the town, and it appears the town suspected there might be trouble that morning.

When interviewed in 1990, a man who as a boy was eye-witness to the shooting remembered it this way: "This morning we went up there, and we always stopped the old horse at the same place. There were always two or three cars. Doc Cooke had one and Dr. Wilbanks had one, and they always parked in a certain place every Sunday morning. There were two or three buggies other than ours, and we had our place that we stopped. I'd always just sit in the buggy and look after the horse, and Daddy'd get out and get the Sunday morning gossip from the rest of the men while they put up the mail.

"There were more than the usual number of men there that morning. Dr. Wilbanks drove up and got out of his car. I didn't pay as much attention to him as I would if I'd had any idea what was gonna happen, but I do remember seeing him getting out-a his car; and just as he straightened up to close the door of his car, I heard a gunshot. BOOM!! Course I looked back at him, and when I looked back...he had turned around and raised his hands and said, 'Shoot, I don't have a thing.' Doc Cooke shot him right in the back."

The old gentleman continued, his voice full of emotion from the memory of that long-ago childhood morning. "When Doc Cooke shot him in the back, I could see the blood coming out—I was just a little boy; it ran down his

shirt and got on his pants' leg on the outside. Doc Cooke ran back to his car and got a pistol—a big ol' pistol—and when he came out—a that car with that pistol, old man Thay Byers just reached around him with both arms and squeezed 'im and said, 'Drop it. You're not gonna shoot 'im again.' Nobody bothered Thay; they just let him alone. A lot-a people scooted, but there was enough left there till they cared for Dr. Wilbanks and flagged the 9:15 train from Ragland and got him on the train to go to Birmingham to the hospital."

Several newspapers reported the attempted murder, but the scandal that would be talked of for decades was mentioned in the briefest terms in the county paper, the Southern Aegis. Although it did give the particulars of who, where, when, and how, it reported that Dr. Wilbanks was "resting well" when in reality he was gravely ill from his wounds.

The Birmingham News of July 26 reported that Dr. Wilbanks had been "shot through the back and side with both barrels of a shotgun by Dr. W. P. Cooke." The Birmingham Age-Herald reported, "Dr. Cooke used a double-barreled shotgun loaded with large shot. One load penetrated Dr. Wilbanks' right lung, and it is feared that complications will set up. He weighs over 200 pounds. ...A sensation was created in Odenville by the shooting, as both men are among the best-known in the county. ...Dr. Cooke is being held by the authorities pending the outcome of Dr. Wilbanks' condition." The same paper of July 27 issue reported that Dr. Wilbanks was "...still in an unconscious condition at the Birmingham Infirmary. ...It is feared that complication will set up. He is very fleshy, and it is thought that this fact will work against him."

Dr. Wilbanks recovered. When he returned from the hospital by train to Odenville, it is said that well-wishers from miles around were at the Odenville Depot to greet him and welcome him home.

On August 6, 1920, Dr. Wilbanks' attorneys, C. R. Robinson and W. J. Whittaker, filed a \$50,000.00 suit against Dr. Cooke for attempted murder and demanded a jury trial.

The case came to trial in November, 1921. According to the Pell City News, the jury awarded Dr. Wilbanks \$6,500.00. However, a page-by-page search of the book where the minutes of the trial should have been recorded finds no mention of the proceedings.

Dr. Wilbanks stayed in Odenville and practiced medicine for some years after this.

Dr. Cooke, in addition to the fine, was sentenced to from 4 to 5 years for assault with intent to murder; but in 1922, a year after the sentencing, he was paroled by Gov. W. W. Brandon. Later that year, the parole was revoked because Mrs. Cooke was fearful of bodily harm. Dr. Cooke fled to South America.

In the early 1930s, Dr. Cooke returned to the United States and lived in California. Increasingly fearful of arrest, on January 4, 1933, he wrote Alabama Governor B. M. Miller and began arrangements to turn himself in. The February 5, 1933, issue of the Southern Aegis reported that he returned to Alabama and was incarcerated in Kilby Prison.

He was not in prison long, for on June 10, 1934, Dr. Cooke died in a Pell City hospital, as a result of an automobile accident near Pell City on U. S. Highway 78—a deadly road which locals came to call Devil's Highway. He was buried in Odenville on June 12.

Of those who remember the shooting, nearly all agree that the feud was over a woman, although one thought it was over politics.

There is no doubt that Odenville went into a decline after the feuding, and for many years old timers blamed it on the shooting. The hardware store burned, the Bank of Odenville failed, some merchants filed for bankruptcy, and other businesses dwindled away; however, any direct connection between most of these events and the Sunday morning tragedy is unproved.

Today, on a quiet July Sunday morning when the train whistle cries across the valley, one wonders what restless spirits stir in the old churchyard and what they would tell us from their graves about life and forgiveness.
