Hair Book

Elizabeth Eleanor Dunnuck (Mrs. Mitchel King No. 1)

While still a girl in Ohio, before she came to Illinois in 1851 as the bride of Mitchel King, Elizabeth (called Lizzie by some) made this keepsake as a sort of memory book. It is a small, hardcover account book, measuring about 6½ inches by 7 inches and has sixty leaves, more or less. Long swatches of hair, cut from the heads of her relatives and friends are mounted with some sort of glue, possibly egg-white, after they were braided into a small fancy wreath-type garland. These wreaths were trimmed with bits of braid or lace or ribbon or pretty fabric. Then they were mounted in the book, one wreath to a page and the owner's name written by the hair.

Some items found in this book are:

- page 1. Few hairs labeled Mr. Abram Cross and braided wreath with artificial flowers, labeled Mrs. Ruth Cross. (This was Elizabeth's older sister and her husband. They raised Elizabeth's daughter after Elizabeth died.)
- page 2. Mr. Joshua Dunnuck's straight hair with a flower and a bit of rosy silk.
3. Mrs. Margaret Dunnuck's fancy braid of reddish-blond hair, trimmed with little flowers and rosettes. Margaret was the wife of Joshua who was her second husband. She was born Margaret Griffith, lived in Dorchester County, Maryland with her first husband a Samuel Dunnuck. After they were divorced, she married Joshua Dunnuck.
4. Mr. Emanuel Dunnuck, a tiny bit of straight dark brown hair, fixed like the hair of #2 above.
5. Mrs. Sarah Dunnuck's hair, very long and fancily braided, a warm light brown color, with three little cloth blossoms. She was Sarah Landis before her marriage to Emanuel, an older brother, along with Joshua of Elizabeth Eleanor Dunnuck.
6. Hair of David G<sup>Dunnuck</sup> (for Gorsuch, ... his maternal grandfather was David Gorsuch of Gorsuch Mills, Baltimore County, Maryland.) This gentleman had more hair to spare than those before him in this book. The page across from his is blank, although he had married Letty McDill in 1837.
7. Mr. Thomas Nolan's hair is in a thick swatch, although not very long.
8. Thomas's wife's hair is fine and silken and reddish, made into a dainty wreath and trimmed like the others with little muslin pink flowers. Her name was Mrs. Mary Nolan in this book, but she had been Mary Dun-



nuck before her 1842 marriage to Thomas Nolan.

9. A sister of Mitchel King, Mary King, married the youngest child in Elizabeth E. Dunnuck's family, Elisha Dunnuck, on 30 October 1850. She is listed in this hair book as Mrs. Mary Dunnuck, so this page along with others were obviously made after her marriage date 1850. Her hair and Elisha's are both on the same page.
10. Mr. Nicholas Dunnuck's hair is next. It is medium brown and straight.
11. Mrs. Margaret Dunnuck (born Margaret Mantle) was of light complexion from the appearance of her hair on the page across from her husband's.
12. Mr. Mitchel (still spelled with one l) King's hair is the only one in the book which is not in a circular form. His is straight, a light, light brown for an adult, and it is pulled almost taut across the page from a bow to another bit of ribbon.
13. Mrs. Elizabeth King's name put in as Mrs. and across from Mitchel's makes one wonder if this book really was made in Ohio... or if it was made in Illinois after the marriage of Mitchel and Elizabeth. Maybe both. A very pretty piece of white (now it is cream-colored) satin damask ribbon  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide is used to decorate this, the hair of the lady who made this book. Part of her wedding dress?

Here two pages are <sup>left empty</sup>skipped. The next names are of friends and cousins, etc., as opposed to Elizabeth's brothers and sisters and their spouses.

14. Miss Ellē J. (?) King....the youngest child in the family of Mitchel King and his siblings. Her real name was Eleanor but she was always "Ellē". In 1857 Elle married William Benton and in what appears to be the pencilled writing of Elizabeth's daughter is "Benton" below Elizabeth's writing.
15. Miss Matt J. (? is this J?) King...she was really Martha. In 1855 she married Mr. Newton Dunnuck, believed to be a cousin of Elizabeth Dunnuck. Pencilled notation is "Dunnuck."
16. Here four pages are skipped.

16. On the same page appears the hair of Mr. Joseph Strawbridge and Mrs. Rebecca Strawbridge. I believe that this Rebecca was a younger sister of Elizabeth's mother, the former Eleanor Gorsuch. Rebecca's and Eleanor's mother was Rebecca Gorsuch who married her uncle David Gorsuch. Rebecca the daughter married first Levi Curtis and after his death she became Mrs. Joseph Strawbridge.

17. The next two facing pages have the hair, straight and smooth and medium brown, of Mr. Samuel Ingham and Mrs. Nancy C. Ingham. She was born Nancy Chatman King and was the great-grandmother of Helen Ingham Brown, born 1904. (Mrs. Horace Brown, Wagoner, Okla. 1911)
18. The next page has two hair samples on it, a fancy, feminine braided wreath named Mrs. Hesterann McMahan, and a short straight piece labelled Mrs. (should be Mr.?) John McMahan.
19. Mrs. Sally Ward and Master M. Strayer together on the next page are unknowns to me at present. The child's hair is bright and blond as this is being written in 1967, 112 years after the maker of the book died.

Several skipped pages are here, one of the <sup>m</sup>being but the lower half as if the top had been torn out for use when paper was in short supply.

20. Mr. Benjamin Dunnuck's fairly coarse light brown hair is next. From Frances Dunnuck of Greenwood, Indiana, a correspondent of mine but no close relative, it was learned that this man married Miss Minerva Ashbrook of Ashville, Ohio, in Pickaway County in 1855. He was a son of Joshua Dunnuck and Dianah Tallman Dunnuck and he was born 2 March 1819. (See family group Dk44-45/1w.)
21. Mrs. Minerwa Dunnuck and in pencil below "Ashville Ohio" in Elizabeth's handwriting, apparently, but this is strange for they supposedly were married November 1855... and Elizabeth died in August 1855. It might be Mitchel's handwriting in the pencil. A scrap of rosy silk and a tiny pink satin ribbon trim Minerva's wreath.

Four pages are skipped here, maybe saving space for others, .. space never used.

22. The two on the facing pages which come next are a real mystery to me. Mr. John Baldwin has light brown straight hair and his wife's wreath is made of darker hair. Her name is given as Mrs. Hester Baldwin and scrap of yellow "stare-embroidered" ribbon decorate the page. Who were they?

Here some pages are left blank, and Elizabeth's writing at the top of the first page used for records says "Births".

This is <sup>nearly</sup> the end of the records and hair wreaths. Two clippings of poems which Elizabeth must have liked are pinned in and one is even started to be copied in her hand. One is entitled My Home and is credited to W. Polyblank Parker, which sounds suspiciously like a nom de plume. The other poem, the one which was copied for three lines is called There Is A Hope and at the top is called "original" and, instead of a name at the end, there appears the words Tiffin, Ohio. They are very flowery and almost lugubrious in spots. Because they show the type of things printed in periodicals in the 1800s, the poems follow, thus giving an insight to the struggle of the spirit in those times when it often was too much for one to simply survive physically.

Originally, they came from Alton, Illinois and I feel they are relatives of mine. This adoption data has just this week come to me and it is hoped that adoption papers will show information helpful to me in my search.

Is there a historical society in Flagstaff or Coconino County? This family lived in Oak Creek Canyon part of their lives, if not all of their residence in Coconino County. If I could get in touch with someone there who could give me help I should be grateful. Perhaps the county librarian would be of assistance.

Our great-grandfather John O' Dunnick migrated to Ohio from Maryland some time previous to the War of 1812 in which he served for a short time as a member of Capt. Nye's Lighthouse Company. After several years he married Miss Diana Fallman by whom he had 4 children: Phebe m. Richard Hooker, (for whom Hooker Station in Fairfield County was named), other records say she married Absolom Ashbrook and raised a large family; John m. Henrietta Scott, Fayette County, Ohio; Elizabeth m. Wm. Peters; Benjamin (our grandfather) m. Minerva Ashbrook.

Our grandfather died in Walnut Twp. Pickaway County, Ohio, of typhoid fever on 9-12-1859, age 40 yrs. 9 mos., 9 days from drinking water from a creek nearby the Primitive (sp.?) Baptist Church in Fairfield County, Ohio while repairing the lane back to the church. The whole family had the typhoid fever, he was the only one who died.

Did you know Pickaway County was made from a part of Franklin County to the North, Ross County from the South and Fairfield from the East? (yes. dhr) That's why very early records are found in these counties.

However, I did find in Recorder office this:

1. Joshua Dunnick bought 160 Acres on or near Turkey Run, west end and southeast corner (of 2nd grade valuation) Walnut Township, Pickaway County, Ohio. His taxes for 1820 were \$280.  
1/2 in land
2. They in 1821 on 80 Acres. This time he had \$ State tax, 30c road tax, Total of \$1.20.  
His land was \$2.95 (imagine)

Perhaps later the other Dunnicks bought land but I did not check the grantees or grantors. I will if you wish. Your hairbook information is just wonderful. Slowly all this is sinking in - after many readings and re-readings. This page of "Others Not Dunnicks by name"... do you have any dates? This will require a great many hours in our Court House unless all my books locatethose names.

self, his time for study being nights. A part of the years 1879 and 1880 he was employed as bookkeeper by the Lincoln Coal Mining Company. June 11, 1881, he was admitted to the bar by the Supreme Court at Springfield and began his practice at Lincoln. In November of the same year he became associated with his former preceptor, David H. Harts, forming the present law firm of Harts & Cochran. Politically, Mr. Cochran is a Democrat. He was married June 20, 1883, to Mattie E. Arnold, of Eminence, Henry County, Kentucky. They have two children—Laura Edwina and Lulu Arnold. Mr. Cochran is a member of the Cumberland Presbyterian church.

CHARLES H. CURTIS, attorney at law, was born March 15, 1862, in Laenna Township, Logan County, Ill., and was educated in the high school at Mount Pulaski. At the age of seventeen he began reading law with Beach & Hodnett, Lincoln, Ill. In 1882 he graduated from the law department of the State University of Iowa, and has since practiced law in Mount Pulaski. He is a Democrat in politics, and is town clerk. He was married in Mount Pulaski to Ora L., daughter of Dr. M. P. Phinney. She was born April 11, 1862, in Mason City, Ill. Mr. and Mrs. Curtis have had two children. Their first-born, a son, Major L., died at the age of six months. They have one daughter, Ruby May, born in Mount Pulaski. Mr. Curtis is a son of Enoch Curtis, a native of Virginia. He removed to Pickaway County, Ohio, where he lived sixteen years and married Polly Dunnuck. They came to Logan County in 1850. Four of their five children were born in Pickaway County, Ohio—Rebecca, the widow of J. P. Evans, residing in Dakota; William L., a Kansas farmer; Samuel T. and Hiram W. both farming in Logan County.

HON. STEPHEN ANDREW FOLEY, County Judge, and one of the prominent business men of Lincoln, Illinois, is a native of Logan County, born Aug. 27, 1840. His father, William Foley, was a native of Clarke County, Ohio, moved to Logan County in 1834, where he died in 1848. His mother, Sarah J. (Downey) Foley, was also a native of Ohio, and came with her father, James Downey, to Illinois in 1828, locating in what was then McLean County. She died at Atlanta in 1857. Our subject has spent his entire life in Logan County. He lived on a farm till fourteen years of age, receiving a common-school education. When seventeen years of age he began life for himself and for four years was employed in the postoffice at Atlanta. In 1861 he came to Lincoln
