My dear Canice,

As I told Bill in my birthday letter to him, it was a delight seeing him on August 3, but that I really "hit the jackpot" on August 12 with you, Alicia and Mx3. I told him that I wished he had been here on the 3rd as we had such a delightful, as well as frank, visit and those are the best kind! I still can't get over what Alicia was subjected to because of your father's ignorance. I sent her a copy of our father's death certificate, even though it is "too little-too late" for her, but I told her to wave it at your father, if he gets out of line again, which I'm sure he will. As promised, I am enclosing one for you. I talked to your father since I saw you and when I brought up the subject of the "cause of death" he rattled off the phrases that were on the death the certificate, but his source was "Notes on William Hall Evans" that I sent him which is a part of my genealogy program.(see enclosed). He didn't seem to understand that cancer of the adrenal glands is NOT colon cancer and he was oblivious to the impact of the difference on Alicia.

I also brought up the idea of his sending you the "Family History" file, knowing full well you won't have time to do anything with it now, but at least could collect the information for future reference. His response was, "Well at least SHE'LL be able to find it." I also took another shot at trying to get him to send the St. Ignatius pictures to USF. He said he would and that he would photocopy them for me before he sent them. I said that would be great as I have barely even seen them.

He didn't say a word about Olivia Joyce and I didn't let on that I knew about her. Is she related to James? His major female character in "Finnegans Wake" is Anna LIVIA Purabelle who symbolizes the mother of all men. I can understand his loneliness; I do not understand his obsession with things Irish; if this is going where it looks like it's going, I hope you kids can get him to do a prenuptial agreement to protect your selves and your children. You said she was from County Galway; maybe I'll get some Irish genealogy out of it! Let's see how long it takes him before he tells me. He's had plenty of chances.

As to your questions about your Mother, I'll do the best I can to answer, but it will still only be my opinion. Perhaps you should ask your father and Freddie the same questions you asked me.

What motivated her? You said in your eulogy "she believed that education and religion were the most important things in life." I think she had very high standards, perhaps unrealistically high, both spiritually and socially. She was active in a large number of religious groups according to your eulogy and must have been very involved in Ss Perpetua & Felicity to warrant the turn out at her funeral Mass. She was also very active

among other things. (Editor's note: I didn't want the silver. I wanted and took such things as pictures of our Mother and Father in their wedding clothes, the pictures I showed you when you were here, the Seth Thomas mantle clock that was a wedding present to our parents in 1923 and a Boston terrier door stop that was from my Grandmother's house where my Father died.)

Why did she want you to read instead of watch TV? That goes back to your eulogy about how important education was to her, but I think her view of education was very strict and was limited to formal education. I remember asking her to suggest an appropriate gift for Bill and she mentioned a book on Greek and Roman mythology. I love to give people books, so I was delighted, but Bill wasn't. As we unwrapped our Christmas gifts together, when he saw the book, he threw it across the room. She apologized for his behavior and sent him to his room. I felt sorry for him as she had so misjudged what he would have liked, or rather what she wanted him to like. I probably should have given him a book about cowboys and Indians. Another Christmas at a time when he was into building models and liking trains, I gave him a great steam locomotive model that was so grand it had a dome to put over it, when it was finished. One year later, when I inquired about his progress in building it, he said he couldn't build it because his mother kept forgetting to buy him glue. He wasn't old enough to buy it for himself. When I got home, I mailed him 2 tubes of glue. I don't know if he ever built the model or not, but I think she she didn't consider model building educational.

Did she think "family" was important? I don't know if you mean nuclear family, if so, then "yes". However Claire Marie commented to me after being in your home that night after Thanksgiving, how much more relaxed in rearing your children you are than the way you were raised. Maybe your mother just tried too hard. Or if you mean extended family, I am less sure. Dave and I and your parents tried to keep the extended family together by



alternating Christmas and/or Thanksgiving at each other's homes for a number of years, most especially when Mom was alive. This became less and less successful as the years went by, but I am not sure why. I do think Mom felt looked down upon. One time when she went department store shopping with your mother and looked at a price tag on a dress she admired, your mother told her it was rude to look at the price. This was long before "if you have to ask, you can't afford it." Of course our buying a 20 year old house (which is now 50 years old) in a beach town did<sup>nt</sup> do much for our image, but it suited us. As dear Auntie Claire said, your family was living a champagne life and we were living a beer life, but we didn't care because we were doing what suited us. Your father rather referred to this when he was here with Bill, as I was telling Bill about our trip up Hiway 49 through the gold country and about camping (how plebeian!) all over the western states and Canada. He commented on how much more you see when your on the ground! He finally figured it out! He also commented at another time, when we were discussing our genealogy, that the Jankes and the Dolans came from common origins, too, but if some ancestor or event didn't suit them, they would change it! There is that status again.

Do I remember her feeling happy? If "happy" means having or showing great pleasure or joy and that's what Webster says it means, then I can only remember one time seeing your mother look like she was having a really good time. Isn't that a shame! It was at the cabin and Ann was little. We bought the cabin in '71 and she was 1 1/2 years at the time. I have a picture of your family and you are holding Ann. We had (still have) a game Dave built from some plans in a craft book that we call table soccer even though we usually play it down on the floor. There are sticks with paddles on them and 2 ~~3~~ 4 can play. The object is to drive a ping pong ball thru the opponent's goal, which is an opening at the end of the box. You kids were playing it and the next thing I knew you mother was down on floor playing with you. She kept it up for quite awhile and seemed as though she was having a really good time.
