

I am also enclosing a copy of the deed to the Evans-Freese in the name of Capt. Freese and his wife, Catherine M., his bother in law, who is my grandfather, Wm. James Evans and my grandfather's sisters, Annie Turner and Sarah Cluin. Attached are the copies of the file cards from Holy Cross Cemetery of every one buried in the plot.

Also included are copies of a court case called "The McEnerney Actions", where property owners could lay claim to their property in light of the fact that the Hall of Records, burned for four days.

As a person of San Francisco ancestry, you might find the enclosed websites of interest. Tim and Pam Wolfe are a very well-informed and helpful couple.

Although the last book devotes a chapter to tugboats, there is no mention of the Freese family or the tugboat "Transit."

On a personal note, my grandparents house was among those dynamited by the U.S. Army Engineers to create a fire break, which did in fact stop the fire. Like many other families, they camped out in Golden Gate Park, due to lack of shelter. My Grandmother was bitter to her dying day in 1942 about losing their home that way.

I have no knowledge of any difficulties within the branches of the Freese family. The Captain's daughters Gertrude and Ruth were the only ones I knew personally. Gertrude was a playground director, as was my Father's sister Claire Evans. Ruth made it possible for my Mother, Frances Murray Evans, to be buried with my Father, <sup>William Hall Evans</sup> in the family plot by so directing the undertakers, Carew and English, who had the deed to the plot in their files. After my Mother's death in 1966 I wrote Ruth and thanked her for do<sup>ing</sup> that. She responded with a gracious letter and also gave me the information, that I didn't have at the time, that Sarah Cluin and Annie Turner were her mother's sisters. Ruth Freese Conway died in 1975. She married Jack Conway and had one son, John Conway, who had 12 children. I know nothing of any of them.

Hi! Jack,

I was delighted to get your reply to my posting of Andrew Christian Freese on the Surname Message Board. I am enclosing everything I have on the Freeses. My connection with Capt. Freese is his marriage to my grandfather, William James Evans's, sister Catherine Evans. It wasn't until I sent for Joseph's death certificate that I realized that the Capt. had a prior marriage. I have spent many hours at our local library reading microfilm of the San Francisco Call from 1875-1883 on inter-library loan from the Sutro Library in San Francisco. In the enclosed notes on Annie Keene, the discrepancy between the marriage and death dates are as printed in the S.F. Call. The Call also shows the following, which I wonder about:

1879-Dec. 7-birth of a daughter to wife of F.A. Freese

1881-April 10, death of Christian Freese, eldest son of Christian and Catherine Freese, age 9 yrs. and 7 mos.

1884-death of A.C. Freese, 1 month

1885-birth of a son of A.C. Freese, Jr.

1887-death of Capt. A.C., Jr., age 17.

My 2nd cousin, Helen Brennan Heuer, a retired teacher and inveterate traveler, died in SF about 1996 and then lived across the street from the California Historical Society. After some brow-beating, she did a little research on the Brennans but not on the Freeses.

Joe's wife (Helen Brennan Freese) was a very cultured person, never remarried, and had close ties to family and friends. She was related somehow to Carrie Fields, the mother of novelist Rachel Fields [*"A Tree Grows in Brooklyn"*]. Carrie Fields, in NYC, used to do the most magnificent pastel drawings and send them to us.

Thank you for your gracious offer to forward research materials to me covering Andrew Christian Freese. My residence address is 3411 E. 62nd St, Tulsa 74136, my office fax is 918/ 749-9336 and E-mail is jackfreese@AO L.com. For what it's worth, I was born in Tulsa and am a senior lawyer with two sons: John Markham Freese, Jr. and Brian Lloyd Freese.

Although I have very little data on him other than the family lore that he operated whaling ships and tug boats in San Francisco and that the Freese name could still occasionally be seen on boats when my father was a small boy in San Francisco and continuing past WW I, we do have three scrap books with an amazing collection of photographs of the City immediately following the San Francisco earthquake and fire. I have talked to the curator of the California Historical Society about lending or gifting them to the Society but have made no decision.

My father and his mother and her family then were forced to live for an extended time on a houseboat in the harbor ( their refuge from summer heat ordinarily) because there was no other housing to be had.

We have a few letters from Joseph Christian Freese written shortly after WW I to my father. JCF was apparently then in Philadelphia. At that time my grandmother (either his ex-wife or estranged wife) was then living in Washington, DC. She owned and operated The Washington Gallery, an antique gallery specializing in importing fine European antiques for Washingtonians. By legend she even placed antiques in Flo Ziegfield's stage settings. Some dispute developed among the Freeses in California and the various ACF descendants reputedly stopped speaking. I was told that either a Phil or Louis Freese was believed to then be still alive when I was a small boy - (of the estranged side) and I was cautioned not to seek
