15 Plaintiff alleges:

- 16 1. Plaintiff and defendant intermarried on October 14, 1951
17 at Las Vegas, Nevada, and separated on April 26, 1952.
- 18 2. Defendant at the time of said marriage represented to
19 plaintiff that he was a widower. Said representations were untrue
20 and in fact defendant was divorced from his wife who was still li-
21 ving and defendant at the time of said marriage knew that said rep-
22 resentations were untrue. Defendant made said representations with
23 the intent to induce plaintiff to consent to said marriage. Plain-
24 tiff at the time of said marriage believed said representations to
25 be true and in reliance thereon consented to the marriage.
- 26 3. Plaintiff on or about April 26, 1952 discovered defendant's
27 fraud and since said time has not cohabited with defendant as husband
28 and wife.
- 29 4. Prior to the filing of the complaint, plaintiff and defen-
30 dant entered into a fully and complete property settlement, a copy of
31 which is attached marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
- 32 5. Plaintiff's name under which she was married was Evangelina
B. Bowers.

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SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

1. Plaintiff and defendant intermarried on October 14, 1951, and are now husband and wife.

2. Plaintiff has been a resident of the State of California for more than one year, and of Orange County for more than three months next preceding the commencement of this action.

3. Statistical facts required by section 426a of the Code of Civil Procedure are:

(1) Place of Marriage: Las Vegas, Nevada.

(2) Date of marriage: October 14, 1951.

(3) Date of separation: April 26, 1952

(4) Time elapsing between date of marriage and date of separation: Six months and twelve days.

(5) There are no children of said marriage.

4. Prior to the filing of this complaint, plaintiff and defendant entered into a full and complete property settlement, a copy of which is attached marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

5. That since the marriage of the parties, defendant has treated plaintiff with extreme cruelty and has wrongfully inflicted upon her grievous mental suffering.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays as follows:

1. For her first cause of action that said marriage be declared null and void; that the property settlement agreement of the parties be approved and made a part of the decree of annulment and each party be ordered to perform all conditions and covenants on his or her part agreed to be performed; and for restoration to plaintiff of the name of Evangeline B. Bowers.

2. For her second cause of action that the bonds of matrimony heretofore and now existing between the parties be dissolved; that the property settlement agreement of the parties be approved and made a part of the interlocutory decree of divorce and each party be ordered to perform all conditions and covenants on his or her part

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agreed to be performed; and for restoration to plaintiff of the name of Evangeline B. Bowers.

3. For such further relief as the court deems just.

CERTIFICATE OF OWNERSHIP

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WESTMINSTER MEMORIAL PARK, the Grantor, a Corporation, organized under the laws of the State of California, in consideration of Eighty Dollars, to it in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby convey to MRS. ROY F. BOWERS as Grantee, for interment purposes only, subject to the conditions, reservations, restrictions, and rules and regulations set forth herein, the use of Interment Space 4 Section 510, Block 34 in Westminster Memorial Park, according to a map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Orange County, State of California.

That this is to further certify that there has been deposited with said Westminster Memorial Park the sum of Twenty Dollars, in trust, to be invested, as authorized by law, with other funds of like character, and the proportionate net income therefrom to be used in the "Perpetual Care" and protection of the herein described interment property, the investment of such funds and the expenditure of the income therefrom shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations governing said Westminster Memorial Park.

That this conveyance, and all right, title and interest hereby conveyed in the property above-described, is subject to all laws and ordinances, and to the following conditions, reservations, restrictions and rules and regulations, and the Grantee covenants and agrees that:

(a) No transfer, conveyance or assignment of any interest or rights acquired by Grantee shall be valid without the written consent of Grantor and being thereafter recorded on its books.

(b) No monument or other memorial, tree, plant, object, or embellishment of any kind shall be placed upon, altered or removed from the above-described property by the Grantee without the written consent of the Grantor. All grading, landscape work and improvements of any kind, and all care on the above-described property, shall be done, and all trees and plants of any kind shall be planted, trimmed or removed, and all interments, disinterments and removals, including all openings and closings of graves, shall be made only by Grantor with its equipment. All interments shall be made subject to the use of the type of an outer container as shall be designated by Grantor in its rules and regulations.

(c) Grantor, at the expense of Grantee and as a charge against the above-described property, may repair or remove any memorial which is improper or offensive or which has become dangerous or dilapidated; and may remove any tree, flower or plant, or other object or embellishment that become unsightly or dangerous.

(d) Grantor shall not be liable for loss or damage caused by an act of God, common enemy, thieves, vandals, strikers, malicious mischief makers, unavoidable accidents, riot or order of any military or civil authority.

(e) The enumeration herein of certain conditions, reservations, restrictions and rules and regulations shall not be considered as the only limitations, but the Grantee shall always hold all his interest and rights limited by and subject to the rules and regulations and by-laws of Grantor now existing or which may be by it hereafter adopted either as amendment, alteration or the adoption of new ones. These rules and regulations are on file for inspection in Grantor's office and are specifically referred to and herein inserted as if set forth in full.

(f) No monument, memorial, or other structure extending above the surface of the ground shall ever be erected on the property in which the interment rights are hereby conveyed, and no memorial tablet constructed or composed of material other than bronze or granite, or of a size or design not in conformity with the rules and regulations governing said Westminster Memorial Park, shall ever be placed on the property.

All the above conditions, reservations, restrictions and rules and regulations are binding upon Grantee, his heirs, devisees, executors, administrators and assigns, and are enforceable only by Grantor or its successors in interest. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to restrict the use of any other portion of the cemetery than that herein conveyed to Grantee.

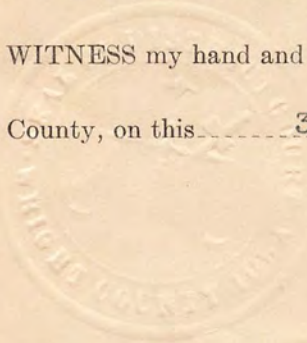
