Frances Hampton and A.J. Shaw named their children:

Sons (5)

1. Baldy, evidently the oldest. It is believed that the name was really Archibald, though his large tombstone bears the name "Baldy". In all court records it is written as "Baldy". There were Archibalds in Rowan in the 1700s. There was an Archibald Henderson, Esq. there. (Note name #2 below). The late Archibald Henderson of Salisbury was the world's foremost authority on George Bernard Shaw.

2. Henderson. The Rowan Public librarian told me the Hendersons came to Rowan County from Stokes County.

3. Ephraim. Named for his grandfather Ephraim Hampton.

4. Adamson Jannehill. Named for his father.

5. Jesse H. Croom Shaw. No idea except there was a Jesse H. Croom living in the locality in Alabama where he was born.

Daughters (4)

6. Polly. Mary no doubt.

7. Rebecca. Not sure but think a Shaw name.

8. Sally. Written as Sarah in legal documents.

9. Lemender. Named for her grandmother, Lemender Hampton.

Some of the above named their children Baldy, William Henderson, Martha F., Jessie, A.J., W.W., Lemender, Robert A.J., David H. (Hampton?). I can't find a Thomas in the bunch. Still, as far as I'm concerned, Thomas is a strong "suspect" as Ephraim's father's name. David runs a close second, though the David who would fit chronologically does not name an Ephraim in his will.

Mrs. Byars of Moulton, Alabama, descendant of David (the brother of your Ephraim and my Frances) says that David named his children David, Thomas, Lemender & Wade, maybe others.

I have no idea re your Jones name. I looked through the court records I have of Hamptons & find no Jones connected with them. Names mentioned prominently are Brandon, Pool, Van Pool, Vanpool, Eccles.

I am in the process of checking out a few leads. If anything of consequence crops up, I'll let you know. Meanwhile, if you have a list of Ephraim's and Elizabeth's children, I'd like to have it.

There was a Gabriel Enochs in Rowan, so he must be your G. Enochs.

I do not know my Shaw history beyond the history you have, though I've good leads. Therefore, I don't know which names are Shaw and which Hampton. I hope you can read this. My back permits me to sit in one position which makes for poor writing.

Dear Boots,

I am enclosing the forms for Daddy's application for the SAR. You will note that the work sheet is slightly different from the application for membership, which is the part that has to be submitted. I hope this will be helpful in getting the information which we need.

I, also, enclose copies of the obituaries of Samuel Armstead Flippen, which appeared in the newspapers in Birmingham, and on the back of each is the date and newspaper from which they were obtained. Perhaps these will help to document the lineage. Also, enclosed is one for Mary Jane Flippen, his wife.

I spent a few hours in the Birmingham Public Library last week while I was in Birmingham for a medical meeting and they have a superior genealogical section. I was thrilled to find what I hope will be additional information for our Shaw ancestry. (I will be disappointed if you have already uncovered this information in the past!) In the book Abstracts of the Will and Estate Records of Granville County, North Carolina 1746 - 1801, by Zae Hargett Gwynn, on page 112 is the will of Robert Harris written June 1, 1785, and proved August, 1786. Lemender Hampton is mentioned as daughter of Robert Harris. Sons mentioned are Christopher, Sherrod, Robert, David and Samuel. Wife Lemander Harris survived him. Perhaps this will help to extend our knowledge of the Shaw family. I saw several Shaws mentioned in the census and other books, but couldn't definitely link Adamson Tannehill Shaw to them. I am still working on seeking to unravel the branches of our family tree!



Deed from Ephraim S. Hampton to
Pearson W. Johnston

This Indenture made and entered into this 12th day of March eighteen hundred and thirty two between Ephraim S. Hampton Lemender R. Hampton his wife of the one part and Pearson W. Johnston of the other part of the County of Oldham and State of Kentucky Witnesseth that the said Ephraim S. and Lemender R Hampton for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy five dollar good and lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Johnston his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Oldham and State aforesaid and bounded as follows. . . . Lot No. 1 st Beginning at double Lynn thence South 25 East 106 Poles to a stone Corner at Lot No. 2nd and thence South 64 West 124 poles to a Stone at another corner of Lot 2nd thence North 26 West 106 poles to a beech thence North 64 East 124 poles to the Beginning this land was allotted to Lemender R. Hampton Containing eighty two acres and twenty four poles be the same more or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appertinances unto the said P W Johnson his heirs and assigns to their only use and behalf forever and the said Hampton and Wife doth Covenant and agree with the said Johnson his heirs and that the premises hereby bargained and sold now are and forever hereafter shall be and remain free from and clear of the right of dower or any other in cum ber ance whatever and that We the said Hampton & Wife our heirs Executors administrators shall Warrant and forever defend the said tract of land With all the appertinances unto the said Johnson against all and every person or persons whatever lawfully claiming as to claim the same In testimony whereof the said Hampton & Wife doth hereunto set their hands and affix their seals the day and date first written

I, Isaac R Gwathoney Clerk of the Oldham County Court in the State of Kentucky do Certify that the deed from Ephraim S Hampton and wife to Pearson W Johnston was on the 18th day of September 1832 produced to me in my office and proven to be the act and deed of Ephraim S Hampton by the oath of Joseph Roney a subscribing witness thereto - and on this day the said deed was fully proven before me in my office by the oath of Ellis Oglesby Another suscribing Witness thereto to be the act and deed of Ephraim S Hampton party thereto. And said deed, and certificate thereon endorsed together With this hath been duly admitted to record in my office. Witness my hand this 5th day of June 1833.

As of the present (1970) I am inclined to think that this document involves Ephraim Hampton Jr.'s son Ephraim S. Hampton, sometimes referred to in my notes as Ephraim No. 3.

This youngest Ephraim married a girl named Lemender Hampton in October 1828 in Oldham County. I think they were first cousins, since David Hampton had a daughter named for David's mother in N.C.: Lemender Hampton. Thus younger Lemender did not change her name when she married, but still had her grandmother's name.

The only later trace of this Ephraim No. 3, is when he makes an affidavit in Shelby County, Illinois, with his brothers Rowland and Jones (my ancestor), in 1836. Thereafter I know nothing of him, and no one in my family remembers of hearing about him as we did the others. Can anyone help me?

There were several men by the name of David Hampton. They apparently were named for the first David who came to Rowan County, N.C. in the 1750s. This might be any one of the Davids named for their grandfather.
