Dear Olivia,

I started an e-mail to you yesterday-the 4th-which was probably a mistake, due to multiple interruptions of people dropping in. I was almost finished, when Susie & Brian dropped in, so I "saved" what I had written & now I can't find it! So I am starting over.

Thank you for the great visit & you and Hall taking Dave and me to dinner. That was very nice of you.

It was great that you brought a list of family history questions. Hope you will do more of that or send further questions via e-mail.

One area of the family tree that was left unfinished was Dick Roche's marriage after Pauline died & the dates that Richard & Elaine, as well as Eleanor & Paul Mullinger died.

As I told you at dinner, Pauline died in 1954. Pauline & Dick's children were:

I have no knowledge or contact of any sort with Richard or Paul's children.

Several years after Pauline died, Mom & I were on our way to The City for dinner with the Judges & we stopped in to see Dick Roche on the way. We had a nice chat &, as we were leaving, he took Mom's hand and said "Frances I am considering asking Madeline O'Donnel to marry me." Then he in effect asked Mom if that was o.k. I thought it was very charming that he wanted his dead wife's sister's approval. Madeline was an "old maid" friend of the family. Everyone liked her & she was included in many of the family gatherings. So they married.

What I didn't say was that when Pauline died, there was a gravedigger's strike, which happened almost every year. Dick was terribly stressed that he couldn't get Pauline buried & "come to closure", as people these days say. Since he had been drafted in WWI, as was our father, he was a veteran. So he had Pauline buried in Golden Gate National Cemetery in San Bruno. Dick died in 1967 and was buried next to Pauline in GG Cem. Then Madeline died in 1972 & she was buried next to Pauline & Dick.

You wondered about why I was close to Claire Marie's Jennifer & not Joan. There is a major incident that might explain it. We were invited to Joan's wedding in Palo Alto in 1995. Dave & I & Ann & Tony went. We also fitted in a visit with Dave's brother Jim & family in Santa Clara & Ann & Tony went to Great America Theme Park, while we visited. We were invited to Jennifer's wedding in Glen Ellen (Sonoma) in 1999, but it was on May 30th holiday weekend. The only reservations we could get required a 3 day stay, besides the airfare (which we could afford) we would also have had to rent a car for 3 days, (which we couldn't afford.) I expressed my frustration to Claire Marie and said that we wanted to come if it was local (Bay Area), but couldn't the way it was set up & why was

it done on a 3-day weekend. She said that Jennifer & Ken had many friends all across the country & some of them could only come if they didn't have to take time off work, if they were working.

Now: rewind to May 22, 1977. It was a Sunday morning & I got a phone call from Claire Marie that said that Rory had dropped dead playing tennis and that she needed my help & was thankful that we were not at the cabin. In those days we went often & Claire had been up there once with Ann & me. Jennifer was with the Burlingame HS Choir and they were performing on the Queen Mary. She needed me to go get Jennifer and fly her home. She had never flown before & Claire didn't want her to do it alone under the circumstances. I told her I would do it, but I didn't want to be the one who told Jennifer that her father was dead. Claire said "O.K. I'll phone the choir director & tell him. You go to the Queen Mary & get Jennifer & take her to a phone booth & call me & I'll tell her."

Rory was the most lovable guy on earth & I had trouble acting efficiently. The hardest part was finding an airline out of Long Beach, as no travel agents were open & nothing was online in those days. The Yellow Pages were all I had to work out of. It was way before 9/11 of course, but the airline people looked at me strangely, as I was buying 1 round trip & 1 one way to SFO and no baggage. I phoned Claire with the arrival time in SFO & headed for the Queen Mary. I found the choir & went up to the choir director & identified myself. He called Jennifer over and, when she saw me, she said "What are you doing here?" I said "I heard the music, so came to listen." That was the best I could do. The choir director said "You need to phone home" & he & I steered her to a phone booth. He told me that he would take care of her personal effects. Claire told her on the phone that her father had died & that I was bringing her home. I got her off the Queen Mary, into my car & on to the plane. She kept asking me "What happened?" But all I knew was that he dropped dead playing tennis. A friend of Claire's met us at SFO & took us to the house that Claire and Rory had just closed escrow on. It had a pool, which was for Rory, as Claire never learned to swim. Claire's sisters Barbara & her husband Ken & Joanne were there & some friends. Auntie Claire & Uncle Paul (Claire's parents) were in WA state on one of their trailer trips. They always phoned each of their kids on Sun. night no matter where they were, as their way of staying in touch with Claire Marie, Joanne, Barbara (who died in 2000), Paul Jr. & Mary. When they phoned Claire, she had to tell them about Rory being gone. The plan was that Ken, Barb's husband, would fly to where ever they were, they would fly home & Ken would drive their car+ trailer home. One of Claire's friends took me back to SFO for my return flight.

The coroner wouldn't release Rory's body for a week, because he didn't die under an MD's care & it took a month for Clair to get his wedding ring back. I didn't go to the funeral. Auntie Claire told me not to try, as I had kids in school & I had done enough. She also insisted on paying me for the airfares, tho I protested.

It could have worked against me in my relationship with Jennifer, as I was a symbol of the day her father died, but it seems over the years to have made us extra close for which I am very thankful.

How's that for family history.

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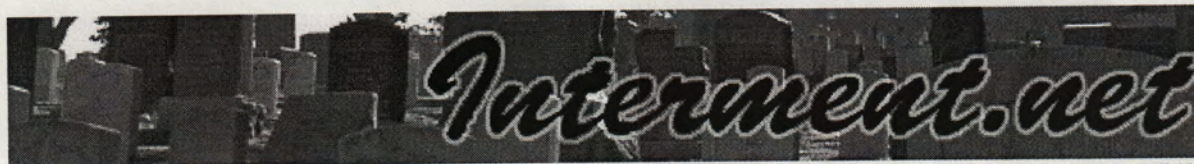

I have no knowledge or contact of any sort with Richard or Paul's children.

Several years after Pauline did, Mom & I were on our way to The City for dinner with the Judges & we stopped in to see Dick Roche on the way. We had a nice chat &, as we were leaving, he took Mom's hand and said "Frances I am considering asking Madeline O'Donnel to marry me." Then he in effect asked Mom if that was o.k. I thought it was very charming that he wanted his dead wife's sister's approval. Madeline was an "old maid" friend of the family. Everyone liked her & she was included in many of the family gatherings. So they married.

What I didn't say was that when Pauline died, there was a gravedigger's strike, which happened almost every year. Dick was terribly stressed that he couldn't get Pauline buried & "come to closure", as people these days say. Since he had been drafted in WWI, as was our father, he was a veteran. So he had Pauline buried in Golden Gate National Cemetery in San Bruno. Dick died in 1967 and was buried next to Pauline in GG Cem. Then Madeline died in 1972 & she was buried next to Pauline & Dick.

You wondered about why I was close to Claire Marie's Jennifer & not Joan. There is a major incident that might explain it. We were invited to Joan's wedding in Palo Alto in 1995. Dave & I & Ann & Tony went. We also fitted in a visit with Dave's brother Jim & family in Santa Clara & Ann & Tony went to Great America Theme Park, while we visited. We were invited to Jennifer's wedding in Glen Ellen (Sonoma) in 1999, but it was on May 30th holiday weekend. The only reservations we could get required a 3 day stay, besides the airfare (which we could afford) we would also have had to rent a car for 3 days, (which we couldn't afford.) I expressed my frustration to Claire Marie and said that we wanted to come if it was local (Bay Area), but couldn't the way it was set up & why was it done on a 3-day weekend. She said that Jennifer & Ken had many friends all across the country & some of them could only come if they didn't have to take time off work, if they were working.

Now: rewind to May 22, 1977. It was a Sunday morning & I got a phone call from Claire Marie that said that Rory had dropped dead playing tennis and that she needed my help & was thankful that we were not at the cabin. In those days we went often & Claire had been up there once with Ann & me. Jennifer was with the Burlingame HS Choir and they were performing on the Queen Mary. She needed me to go get Jennifer and fly her home. She had never flown before & Claire didn't want her to do it alone under the circumstances. I told her I would do it, but I didn't want to be the one who told Jennifer that her father was dead. Claire said "O.K. I'll phone the choir director & tell him. You go to the Queen Mary & get Jennifer & take her to a phone booth & call me & I'll tell her."

Rory was the most lovable guy on earth & I had trouble acting efficiently. The hardest part was finding an airline out of Long Beach, as no travel agents were open & nothing was online in those days. The Yellow Pages were all I had to work out of. It was way before 9/11 of course, but the airline people looked at me strangely, as I was buying 1 round trip & 1 one way to SFO and no baggage. I phoned Claire with the arrival time in SFO & headed for the Queen Mary. I found the choir & went up to the choir director & identified myself. He called Jennifer over and, when she saw me, she said "What are you doing here?" I said "I heard the music, so came to listen." That was the best I could do. The choir director said "You need to phone home" & he & I steered her to a phone booth. He told me that he would take care of her personal effects. Claire told her on the phone that her father had died & that I was bringing her home. I got her off the Queen Mary, into my car & on to the plane. She kept asking me "What happened?" But all I knew was that he dropped dead playing tennis. A friend of Claire's met us at SFO & took us to the house that Claire and Rory had just closed escrow on. It had a pool, which was for Rory, as Claire never learned to swim. Claire's sisters Barbara & her husband Ken & Joanne were there & some friends. Auntie Claire & Uncle Paul (Claire's parents) were in WA state on one of their trailer trips. They always phoned each of their kids on Sun. night no matter where they were, as their way of staying in touch with Claire Marie, Joanne, Barbara (who died in 2000), Paul Jr. & Mary. When they phoned Claire, she had to tell them about Rory being gone. The plan was that Ken, Barb's husband, would fly to where ever they were, they would fly home & Ken would drive their car+ trailer home. One of Claire's friends took me back to SFO for my return flight.

The coroner wouldn't release Rory's body for a week, because he didn't die under an MD's care & it took a month for Clair to get his wedding ring back. I didn't go to the funeral. Auntie Claire told me not to try, as I had kids in school & I had done enough. She also insisted on paying me for the airfares, tho I protested.

It could have worked against me in my relationship with Jennifer, as I was a symbol of the day her father died,

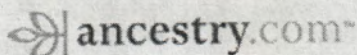
