

ROMER FAMILY HISTORY

Anton Romer, the son of Anton and Grace Miller Romer was born December 19th, 1835 in Westhausen, Wurtemberg, Germany. He was one of a family of six boys and two girls namely, Joseph, George, Anton, John, Sebastian, Xavier, Victoria and Grace. At the age of eighteen he came to America to join his brother, Joseph, who had previously come to America and by hard work had earned enough money to pay for Anton's trip across the sea.

He landed in New York but did not have money sufficient to pay the drayage on his trunk so it was taken from him until he had earned enough to pay for it. Thus he was left without anything, a stranger in a strange land but a man who had never seen him before gave him enough money so that he might join his brother, Joseph, who had chosen the State of Delaware as his future home.

Here he worked for three years receiving \$12 a month, also his board and laundry. After he became acquainted with the methods of American agriculture he came to Illinois making Jacksonville his destination.

After the death of the Mother which took place in Germany, the father and another son, George, decided to come to America, thus leaving Xavier, John, Sebastian, Victoria and Grace in the fatherland where they remained until their death.

Shortly after the father and son George arrived in America the Civil War broke out and both enlisted for three years.

On their return from the South the Father was employed as a carpenter but was instantly killed by falling from a six story building.

Following is the history of the five brothers and two sisters of Anton Romer. Sebastian and John both died when quite young. George lived to be quite old but died as a bachelor in a soldier's home in Delaware.

Xavier was married. Five children compose his family, 3 girls and 2 boys. All are married and live in Stuttgart. Victoria married and was the mother of six children. All but one are married and he has attained the age of sixty eight years. Grace was the mother of one daughter, Barbara. She married and her name became Moibour. She was the mother of three children, two girls and one boy, the latter was killed in World War I. One daughter Emma was married. Her name became Bolstler. She has a family of six children, four boys and two girls.

Joseph of Delaware was married and was the father of seven children, namely, Sallie, Maggie, Lucy, Anne, Odell, George and Joe.

George is married. He has one son, William who has also been married but he and his wife are divorced.

Joe Romer is married and has three sons, namely, Joe, Frank and Leon. None are married.

Sallie Romer married John Heldmyer. They have three boys namely, John, George and Joe. George Heldmyer is married but has no family. John Heldmyer is married and has one son Junior. Joe Heldmyer now deceased was married and has two sons, Roland and Marion.

Maggie Romer married Frank Gallagher. They have three daughters and one son, namely Jennie, Clara, Odell and William. Jennie, the eldest daughter is not married. Clara married Edward Enos. They have one son. Odell married but has no family. William is located in Wilmington, Delaware.

Annie Romer married Frank McClean. They have had one daughter, Sarah, but she and the father are both deceased. Annie lives alone in Odessa.

Lucy Romer, who died many years ago was married to Sam Fortner. They have one daughter Louise who is married and has one small child.

Odell Romer who also died many years ago was married to Joseph Douglas. They have two boys and two girls, namely, George, Joseph, Clara and Maude. George is married, has three boys and one girl. Joseph is married and has no family. Clara is married and has one small son. Maude is married and has no family.

* Mary Ursula Bollin, daughter of John and Agnes Schoendienst Bollin was born in Reideschingen, Baden, Germany October 18th, 1847. When a maiden of five summers she with her parents and two brothers, Ben and Jake came to America.

* After being tossed over the stormy sea for six weeks the family finally landed at Toledo, Ohio. It was in this State the mother was taken ill with the Cholera and the family endured many hardships. It was also a task for the three children to attend school.

* The family lived in Ohio for five years when they decided to come to Illinois landing at New Berlin, Illinois.

* A year after their arrival in Illinois a son Herman was added to the family circle and later another son, Joseph. The family now was composed of four boys and one girl namely, Ben, Jake, Herman, Mary and Joseph.

Ben Bollin family

After Mary had reached the age where she could assume the responsibilities of household duties she was employed in the private home of John Smith, where she worked for twenty five cents a week. It was in this community that she spent most of her happy girlhood days and also where she met her future husband, Anton Romer.

The history of the four sons and one daughter of John and Agnes ^{for convenience} Bollin is as follows.

Ben Bollin married Caroline Seyfer. They were the parents of eight children, namely, Emma, Clara, Kate, Alma, Anna, Lorene, Herman and Frank. Emma Bollin married Will Pfau. They have two children, Irene and Lucien. Irene married Dennis Hickey of Lincoln and Lucien is at home. Clara married Fred Hickman. They have one daughter, Freda, who married Ernest Reeder. They have two children, Annette ^{age 16} and James.

Kate Bollin married Pete Murphy. They have two daughters, Esther and Ruth. Esther married Tom Huff of Chicago. They have two sons, David and Bobby. Ruth married M. C. Brennan. They have two sons, Cyril and Robert.

Alma Bollin married Ed Hampton. They have had three children. Dorothy, Robert and Donald. Dorothy married Elmer Riggles and has no family. Robert married and has one son, Billy. ^{later Betty Ann Hampton born} Donald was killed in a car accident October 8, 1925. The father is also deceased. ^{E.K.H. d. 1932}

Lorene Bollin married H. W. Alberts of Emden. They have had three children. Caroline died at the age of two years and the other two are boys. Henry; and Jerry. ^{"Busty" d. age 12}

Anna Bollin is not married.

Frank Bollin married Mary Wynn. He died in 1932. Had no family.

Herman Bollin married Lula Rupp. She also being deceased. They had no family.

Jacob Bollin married Elizabeth Bernritter. They were the parents of five children, namely, Minnie, Dora, Amelia, Will and Carrie. Minnie Bollin married Fred Becker, the latter dieing several years ago. They have three children, Dr. Carl Becker, Irma and Norma. Dr. Becker is married and has one daughter, Sandra. Irma married William Wilde of Springfield and has no family. Norma married T. F. Thompson of Chicago and she also has no family. ^{Rockers (caned seat + back) was owned by "Elizabeth" godmother of Alma Bollin (m. Hampton)?}

Dora Bollin married Frank Voepel. They have one son, Harold, now of California. He married Virginia Gordon and has no family.

Will Bollin married Mabel Corwin. They have one daughter Virginia who married Vincent Jones. They have two daughters, Cecelia Belle and Charlotte Elizabeth.

Carrie Bollin married Ruby Coon of Mason City and has no family.

Amelia Bollin is not married.

Herman Bollin, Sr., married Lena Lauer. They were the parents of three children, two of which died in infancy. Flora the only child living is married to Charles Zumbrook of Springfield, and have no family.

Joseph Bollin died in infancy.

On September 12, 1864, Anton Romer and Mary Bollin were united in marriage, the ceremony being performed at Jacksonville, Illinois.

They began their married life on a farm located three miles southeast of Lincoln which at the present time is occupied by T. E. Duff and family. Leaving this place they moved to Bell Station and from there to the farm now occupied by Ed Gimble near Narita, Illinois.

Later they purchased a 297 acre farm located one half mile north of Narita where they lived until 1900.

Ten children were born to Mary and Anton Romer, namely, Joseph, William, John, George, Jake, Herman, Tony, Agnes, Grace and Lena.

Five of the family circle have passed away. Joseph died March 2, 1909, age 44 years. John died at the age of 3 years. William 3 weeks. George died January 31, 1932, age 60 years and Tony died on his 52nd birthday, October 28, 1929.

Joseph the oldest son was married to Elizabeth Weckel and to them five children were born, namely, Tony, Pearl, Florence, Mabel and Roman. The oldest son Tony died June 26, 1894 at the age of 3½ years.

Pearl married Eugene Connolley. They have three sons, Franklin, Richard and Kenneth.

Florence married Albert Schroth. They have two sons, Joseph and Norman.

Mabel married William Miller. They have one son, Billy Joe.

Roman married Dorothy Davis of Lincoln. They have three children, Joan, Tommy and Jimmy.

The fourth oldest brother George married Emma Horn. To them five children were born, namely, Amelia, Hilma, Norma, Clarence and Lorine. Hilma died at the age of 4 years. Amelia married Alfred Olsen of Chicago. They have no family. Norma married Willard Kautz, they have one daughter Doris. Clarence married Dorothy Shoup and they have one daughter. Marilyn Louse. Lorine is not married.

Jacob Romer married Anna Jenner. She died August 15, 1929. They had no family. ^{12-13.3}

Herman Romer married Effie Jane Courtney. She died April 12, 1922. No family.

Tony Romer married Margaret Houlihan. He died five years ago. They had one daughter who died at birth.

Agnes Romer married A. F. Dillsaver. They have one son, John.

Grace Romer married Fred Roth. They have no family.

Lena Romer married T. Edward Duff. They have one daughter, Virginia.

In 1900 Mary and Anton Romer retired from their country home to Mt. Pulaski. Here they purchased a comfortable home which both greatly enjoyed and appreciated until April 6, 1914 Anton passed away at the age of 78 years and Mary died six years later February 8, 1920 at the age of 72 years.

At the present time five children of the late Anton and Mary Romer survive, also ten grand children and eleven great grand children.


