



FOREWORD

When I decided to write this Hiltz history, my goal was to research the descendants of my great-grandparents, James Edmund and Sarah (Barkhouse) Hiltz. In doing this, I have carried our branch back to when they first arrived in Nova Scotia, in 1751, and forward to the present day.

In recent months, so much information has come to light on the brothers and sisters of James, that I have decided to include a short genealogical sketch of each brother and sister, their spouses and children. I have not attempted to carry these lines further.

Our family have not been good record keepers. In several cases I found conflicting information recorded for the same event. For other events, nothing had been recorded. Nor are all these family lines complete. I found it impossible to locate some of our family scattered all over North America. Others did not reply to my letters. To those who did reply, my grateful thanks. Very special thanks to Mrs. Neapean Eisner, John DeCoste, Garnet Meisner, Mr. and Mrs. Russell Hiltz, Mr. and Mrs. Laurie Hiltz who shared their research and "cousin" Blanche (Hiltz) Fitzgerald who did the final typing for the book.

THE STORY OF THE FOREIGN PROTESTANTS

In July, 1749, Colonel Cornwallis, Governor of Nova Scotia, wrote the Lords Commissioners for Trade and Plantations in London urging that an effort be made to recruit and send over Swiss and German Protestants to settle Nova Scotia. The Foreign Protestants, if they were to arrive in Nova Scotia had to be recruited, shipped and settled by some agency. Accordingly the Board of Trade contracted with John Dick, their agent at Rotterdam, for the recruiting of Foreign Protestants from the European continent, and their shipping to Nova Scotia. The settlement of Nova Scotia between 1749-52 was the only instance in which the colonization was undertaken under the direct authority and immediate auspices of the British Government itself.

John Dick was authorized to recruit emigrants by offering the following "Encouragements": "Foreign Protestants willing to become loyal subjects of His Britannic Majesty would receive in Nova Scotia each a grant of fifty acres of land free of quit-rents and taxes for ten years, and thereafter not more than one shilling per annum for any fifty acres as granted. For every dependent woman or child there would be given an additional ten acres, and further grants would be made 'on the like conditions as their families shall increase or in proportion to their abilities to cultivate the same'. Immigrants should receive free subsistence for twelve months from the date of their arrival in Nova Scotia. They shall be furnished with arms and ammunition as far as will be judged necessary, with a proper quality of materials and utensils for husbandry, clearing and cultivating their lands, erecting habitations, carrying on the fishery, and such other

purposes as shall be necessary for their support."

The Board of Trade wanted young unmarried men mostly, or young married men with small families. A few older people were allowed to emigrate if they were part of a family unit that would not be broken up. For the most part the emigrants were farmers or small artisans.

The European port of departure was Rotterdam, Holland, with the ships having to call at an English port such as Gosport or Cowes for customs clearance. Emigrants were required to transport themselves, their families, belongings, etc., to Rotterdam and pay their passage from there to Nova Scotia. Fares at that time were - adult six pounds, eight shillings, ten pence, plus one guinea per head paid by the British treasury on their behalf. If a passenger was unable to pay his fare, the Government would pay it on his behalf with the understanding that he would work off his passage after he arrived in Nova Scotia.

The immigrants came from the Palatinate section of Germany, Wurttemberg, other German states, French speaking Mentholiard, Switzerland and a few from the Netherlands. Between 1749 and the end of 1752 over 2700 immigrants came to Nova Scotia from these areas of Europe. The forefathers of the Hiltz family in Nova Scotia came here at that time. There were two brothers - Johann Heinrick, age 24 years and Johann Daniel, age 21 years. On the ship's list the name was given as Hilst, but it became Hiltz in Nova Scotia. It was said that both men wrote a fair hand and their trade was given as bakers. Several descendants from other Foreign Protestant families have married into the Hiltz family. For example, we find the name of Lantz. They came from the free city of Frankfort, Germany. The Barkhouse family, then spelt Berghous came from Hesse-Darmatalt, while the Rafuse family, then spelt Rehfuss, came from Wurttemberg.

The Hiltz brothers sailed to Nova Scotia aboard

the boat the Murdoch. The voyage from Holland to Halifax was something like 12½ to 13½ weeks, while her passengers were aboard for something over 14 weeks. They landed in Halifax about September 20, 1751. One of the most persistent and uniform complaints throughout the period of emigrant sailing ships was of the scantiness and poor quality of food served on the voyages. Details of conditions often have to do with the putrid and wormy food and incredibly foul water.

Since only a small portion of the Murdoch passengers were able to pay their fares, (13½%), we can probably presume our forefathers worked off their debt to the government on the public works at Halifax at wages ranging from two shillings per day for artisans to as low as one shilling per day for labourers.

Small settlements of "Foreign Protestants" sprang up at and near Halifax as the immigrants worked off their indebtedness and awaited settlement. Two villages composed entirely of families that came in the Murdoch sprung up on the isthmus between the head of the Northwest Arm and Bedford Basin. Most of them remained there until the move to Lunenburg in the spring of 1753.

It had been planned to settle the immigrants as soon as their indebtedness had been worked off, but there were problems proceeding from the antagonism of the French and active hostility of the Indians. It was 1753 before they were settled permanently.

The Council at Halifax resolved on May 10, 1753, that the settlement be made Marlegash to be called the township of Lunenburg. The name was chosen by the Governor and Council some weeks before the first foreign settlers set foot on the site.

The settlers boarded boats for Lunenburg on May 29, 1753, and finally sailed on June 7.

On Tuesday, June 19, 1753, the settlers were given

their town lots in the township of Lunenburg. These lots were 40 x 60 feet each. Garden Lots just under a quarter acre with a few larger lots also given a little later. Material for homes for each family not exceeding 500 feet of lumber, 500 bricks and nails in (250) proportion. Later 30 acre farm lots in a number of ranges spreading along the shores and into the country were granted. Still later 300 acre lots spreading over an area that reached inland as much as twenty miles from Lunenburg town were available for those who wanted them and were able to pay a modest survey fee. Some livestock was given to settlers in 1754.

Military protection was given to the new settlement, with 92 regular troops and 66 rangers being sent for its defence. There were many Indian attacks with thirty-one settlers being killed in the first few years. The Indians kept up hostilities as long as they could receive ammunition and certain other supplies from the French.

The settlement of Lunenburg was plagued by storms, drought, as well as Indian attacks during its early years. Because of these, the settlers could make little progress toward maintaining themselves. The Government was obliged to continue the free victualling commitment several years longer than they had promised. Free food was given at the rate per person per week of 5 lbs. bread or flour, 3 lbs. beef, 2 lbs. pork, $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. butter, 1 pint pease, $\frac{1}{4}$ pint vinegar, $\frac{1}{4}$ pint oatmeal, $\frac{1}{2}$ pint molasses, $\frac{1}{2}$ pint rum. The bread was understood to be hard tack, the pease as dried, the beef and pork normally as salted in casks.

The Indian raids finally stopped in 1759 and the free food was able to be discontinued when the settlement became self-supporting in 1760. The settlers were able to produce more than they needed for themselves and had a ready market for their goods at Halifax.

These facts regarding the Foreign Protestants have been taken from the book "The Foreign Protestants and the Settlement of Nova Scotia" by Winthrop Bell.

The two Hiltz brothers came from Stelberg in the small state of Kenigstein in South Western Germany.

Alexander, son of Johannes, son of John Daniel. Alexander was born at Marriott's Cove on September 10, 1806. On December 30, 1830, at Chester, he married Sarah Bezanson of Marriott's Cove. Family members have thought she was an adopted child with the name of Marritt, but the records show she was born December 27, 1807, the third child of Alexander Bezanson and his wife Catherine Sweimhamer. Her mother probably died when she was born or soon afterwards as Alexander remarried November 8, 1808, to Anna Barbara Lantz by whom he had seven children. Following his death sometime before 1826, Anna Barbara married James Marriott. Four children of the Bezanson family were to marry into the Hiltz family, including Sarah's half-sister, Hannah, who married Alexander's brother, Edmund. Alexander and Sarah Hiltz moved to New Ross shortly after it was settled, where Alexander was a farmer. Their homestead is still in the Hiltz family with great-grandson Hencie Hiltz being the present owner. His brother, Russell Hiltz, told me of a huge flat boulder, like a stage, being on the property years ago. Alexander's daughter, Maria Louisa, conducted Sunday School classes from this boulder. Unfortunately, the rock was destroyed and taken away in recent years. Another story I have heard is of the large ash tree that stood on the property, by the driveway. The tree was believed to have been planted by an old soldier by the name of Tupper. When the new highway was put through New Ross, (sometime before 1967), the old tree had to be removed. It measured 6 ft. in diameter and stood between 40 and 45 ft. high. Alexander and Sarah were Church of England. Alexander died in 1875 and was buried in the old New Ross cemetery, I am told, beside his son David's first wife, who died shortly after marriage. Sarah spent the remainder of her life with her son James, and died on the North Mountain, March, 1883. She is buried in St. John's Churchyard, Church Street, Nova Scotia. Family as follows:

Fourth Generation Hiltz Family

James Edmund Hiltz, son of Alexander (Johannes, John Daniel), born May 1830. Between 1857 and 1859, James purchased 251 acres of land on the North Mountain for 576 pounds. On September 24, 1860, at St. John's Church, Church Street, James married Sarah Catherine Barkhouse of Blomidon. The church records show that the couple signed their wedding banns with "X"s. A search of the 1891 Census, reveals that while James and Sarah could read, they were unable to write. Granddaughter Mary (Hiltz) Milbury, remembered her grandmother Sarah, telling her that when they had moved to Scott's Bay Road (by oxcart) there was no road, only a cowpath. At one time there was a watering trough going up the mountain on the left hand side where everyone stopped to water their team and get a cold drink. There was a big willow tree that is supposed to have grown from a willow walking stick that James stuck in the ground. James is noted with having a robust constitution. When he died (October 13, 1912), his obituary reported that he had received medical attention for the first time in his life. James is also remembered for his lovely curly hair. Granddaughter Lillian (Barkhouse) Schofield, has a curl of his hair in her possession. Sarah is remembered as a feisty, quick tempered lady who was an excellent gardener. James and Sarah moved to Canaan with their son Thomas and his family about 1902. They lived in a small house opposite Thomas's farm. Sarah was born in 1835, and died April 23, 1925. They are both buried in St. John's Churchyard, Church Street. 7 children as follows:

Note: The birthdates for some of the children given here were taken from family records. In some cases the baptismal records for these children as taken for these children from the records of St. John's Church, Church Street, are different. The birthdate for John Owen is given as January 1, 1868, baptized August 30, 1868. The birthdate for Mary is given as August 20, 1869. Her middle name is given as Sybella. The birthdate for Martha Jane is given as January 14, 1878, baptized September 17, 1880. I have been unable to confirm which dates are correct.

Note: I have been unable to find out the names of the parents of Sarah (Barkhouse) Hiltz. A Bible at the home of Thomas Hiltz, records that "Grandmother" Barkhouse died August 28, 1905. No further information given.

Family of Thomas and Rebecca (Rafuse) Hiltz

Thomas Edward Hiltz, sone of James Edmund and Sarah (Barkhouse) Hiltz, born at New Ross, March 5, 1862, died August 1, 1952. Married December 29, 1883, by Rev. Ruggles, Kentville Church of England, to Julia Rebecca Rafuse.

Rebecca was born March 14, 1864, in Chester, Nova Scotia, the daughter of Daniel and Sarah Rafuse. She resided at Steam Mill Village at the time of her marriage. When he was young Thomas worked as a ship carpenter and also made a few trips to sea. For a number of years he and Rebecca lived on Scott's Bay Road where most of their family were born. In 1902, they bought a farm in Canaan, Nova Scotia, where they spent the remainder of their lives. Thomas is remembered as a small, energetic man who was always busy. Rebecca was an accomplished sewer and knitter. We have in our possession a pair of double knit mittens made when she was in her seventies. Rebecca died September 25, 1946. They are both buried in the Oak Grove Cemetery, Kentville, Nova Scotia. Fourteen children as follows:

He was born March 25, 1883, and died November 6, 1948. He worked for the town of Wolfville and they resided in Wolfville. Dora died May 30, 1955. Both buried in Willowbank Cemetery, Wolfville, Nova Scotia. Four children as follows:





"Active, and in good health, Mrs. Lemuel Rogers, oldest resident of Blomidon, will Saturday celebrate her 95th birthday. She has 151 living descendants. Eleven of her 13 children are living. Mrs. Rogers, the former Maria Hiltz of New Ross, has 85 grand-children, 54 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild. Though she suffered two broken wrists in a fall two years ago, Mrs. Rogers, during the last winter, knitted 25 pairs of socks, and twenty-five pairs of mittens, mainly from wool she spun and twisted herself.

Her 11 children are, Mrs. Clara Gardiner, Boston; Mrs. Maud Broad, Colorado; Mrs. Malcolm McBride, Blomidon, with whom she resides; James Rogers, Sheffield Mills; David Rogers, Perea; Moore Rogers, Blomidon; Mrs. Fletcher A. McBride, Habitant; Steven Rogers, Colorado; Harold Rogers, North Mountain; Mrs. Cleveland Munroe, Scotts Bay; Mrs. George Woollover, Blomidon.

Note: We cannot be sure that this John Hiltz was a son of Alexander and Sarah (Bezanson) Hiltz. He is not included in the church records listing their children. He was however, part of their family at the time of the 1871 Census, his age given as fourteen. For this reason, I am including here, what little information I have on John and his family.

The Rafuse Family

This genealogical sketch is about the branch of the Rafuse family of Rebecca (Rafuse) Hiltz and is included in the books that will be going to the descendants of Rebecca (Rafuse) and Thomas Edward Hiltz.

Several branches of the Rafuse family were among the Foreign Protestants who came to Nova Scotia. The name was spelled Rehfuss then, changed to Rafuse in Nova Scotia. I have been unable to find out which family Rebecca was descended from, but we know her father, John Daniel, was supposed to have a 500 acre grant farm at Beech Hill or Gold River, Lunenburg County, Nova Scotia. Records by Canon Harris speak of a John Rafuse of Gold River, who had the following family: John born 1817; Daniel born 1818; Jacob born 1819; Elizabeth born 1821. Since our family records show John Daniel as being born January 12, 1818, we can probably conclude he is the Daniel mentioned in Canon Harris's records. John Daniel married Sarah Awalt, who was born July 1, 1830. We know nothing about her.

Sometime after 1870, John Daniel, Sarah and their family left Lunenburg County and moved to Steam Mill, Kings County, on a farm on what is now part of the Aldershot Army Camp. There John Daniel died February 23, 1896, and Sarah on February 21, 1896, as a result of a flu outbreak. Both are buried at the back of the Oaks Cemetery, Kentville, Nova Scotia. Family as follows:

----- Snair, Steam Mill. No family. Emma's "Obit" says Scott and Fannie were a nephew and niece. I've been unable to find out which is correct. Nor do we know why John Daniel and Sarah brought up Emma. Since she was older than John Daniel and Sarah's family, perhaps John Daniel was married before. He was several years older than Sarah. We have no knowledge of this.

Note: In talking to older people about the Rafuse family, I have been told stories of violent, uncontrollable tempers. Hopefully the younger generations have mellowed!
