# THE HOME OF INDIAN DENNY.

## How Dennysville Grew From a One-Man Town.—Jottings From the Notes of the Missionary Ephraim Abbot.

(Written for Lewiston Journal)

**M**ANY of our little back country towns have been and still are "one man towns," and in the earliest days of known history, Dennysville was no exception, for the prominent Indian, Denny, lived and fished on the banks of the beautiful stream. The British, when they occupied a part of Passamaquoddy, called it Dainsfield, and the Americans knew it as Denny's River. And when Benj. Richard Jones, school master, magistrate, and surveyor, descendant of Priscilla & John Alden, settled there and made a map of the district it would seem that a one-man town it would ever remain.

That was in 1810, but in 1764 surveys of the coast region were made by John Mitchell and his deputy, Israel Jones, with Nathan Jones commander of troops on the

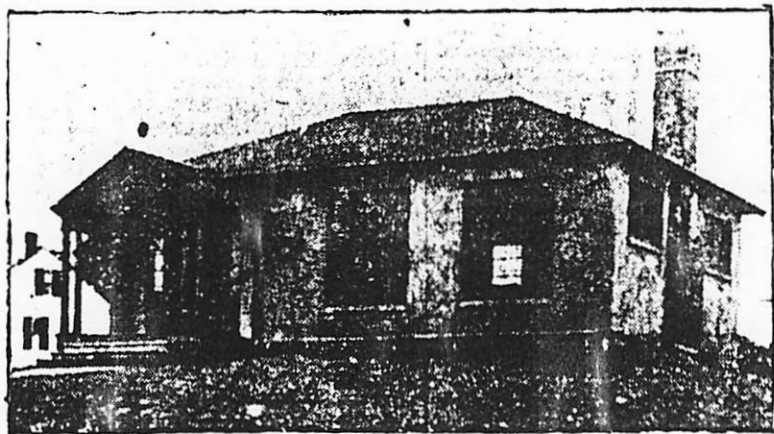
on the north shore of the river a head of tide and falls. Here they have lately erected a building to accommodate 200 people and it is so warm by having the walls filled with bricks that it is convenient for a school-house. The people are principally good farmers and raise crops of rye, wheats, oats, potatoes, hay, and abundance of garden sauce. They live as well as the majority of Massachusetts farmers. Preached Aug. 9 to a full house. Two persons came from Robbinston, 12 miles away; a few from No. 3 12 miles; 10 from No. 9, 10 miles, several from No. 10. There was a collection for the society, \$4.60. Visited Mr. Wm. Kilby, a worthy, pious man. Visited Mr. Rannels, Mr. Wilder, Mr. Eastman and Mr. Lippingcott. Mr. L. is a Quaker. Mrs. L. was baptized in infancy, was well educated and seems in some measure awakened. She thinks favorably of Quakerism, but is not sure.

truly good man. I trust he will be persuaded to join in establishing a church that will be a blessing to this place. (Eastport.)

March, 1812. Went from Eastport to Dennys River. Converted with family of Zenas Wilder. Went to B. R. Jones, catechized his children. He is desirous of joining the Congregational church, but he has doubts. Preached two sermons. Passed night with Mr. Kilby. Mrs. Kilby and daughter Mary appear worthy of joining the church, of which Mr. Kilby is already a member. . . . Visited Mr. Mayew, visited families of Bosworth, Benner, etc., preached a lecture in school-house, visited Zadock Wilder on east side of Pennamaquan. Preached at Isaiah Hersey's in the afternoon and in evening at Warren Gardener's Jr. on west side. Visited Ox Cove, Jos. & Abraham Bridges & John Carter & preached at Solomon Cushings."

(Cathanisk) accent on the final syllable, is the Indian name for the river upon which the old chieftain Denny was first established. Mr. Peter Vose, one of Dennysville's descendants of the old stock, was a student of Indian Lore, and gave Pewagon as the native name for the west branch of the Pennamaquan, Hemancwanargum, Pembroke Lake; Maddyhangsook, Meddybamps; Subowangamaik, Hadley's lake; Nandamas-uagum, Gardner's Lake; Posseswanganook, Cathance Lake; and Neconaugamook, Round Pond, all in the vicinity. Solomon Cushing, situated at the Pennamaquan village included in Dennys River before being set off as Pembroke, was one of the early surveyors.

In 1790 the census gave the inhabitants as 144, including, besides heads of families already mentioned, such names as Ash, Bender, Henderson, Buckings, Harper, Lea, Leighton, Mahar, Morain, Sprague, Smith, Stoddard, Wilson. When military service was required of all men between 18 and 21, the Dennysville Company formed Jan. 1812, with Ensign Wilder its only commissioned officer. Later Ebenezer Wilder became captain and Daniel Kilby ensign. Daniel Kilby was one of the collectors of customs for the Passamaquoddy district, located at Eastport. And Eastport business

"Dennys River, where Mr. Lincoln lives," was the way it was spoken of by adjacent plantations.

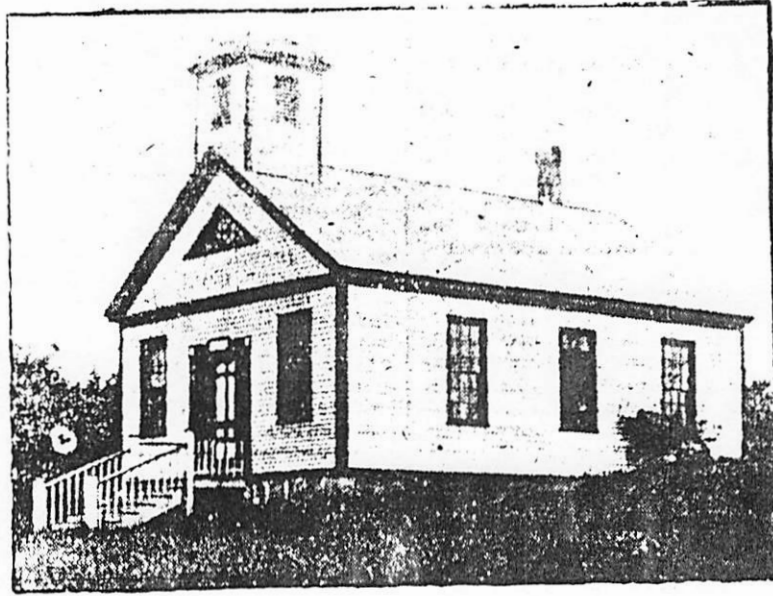
The Kilbys, Corthell's, and Gardeners, were other distinguished families, also Allens, sent their sons into other towns and states to become respected, and frequently honored, there Benj Foster Kilby was 39th representative from Eastport.

The first missionary to preach in the country, Ebrahim Agha, left in his notes of 1811 the paragraph, "Aug. 2, Left Robinson for Dennysville to go in company with the post. Arrived at Pembroke. Judge Lincoln requested me to be there in time to attend the funeral of Mrs. Wilder, mother to considerable part of the town. Her husband, Capt. Theophilus Wilder was one of the early pioneers, a passenger on the sloop 'Sally,' which brought the Hingham immigration in May, 1786, to Dennysville. He was a Revolutionary War hero and commanded the Hingham's company at Burgoyne's surrender. Descendants of this couple still occupy homes in both towns. I accompanied Judge Lincoln home, and am still at his home.

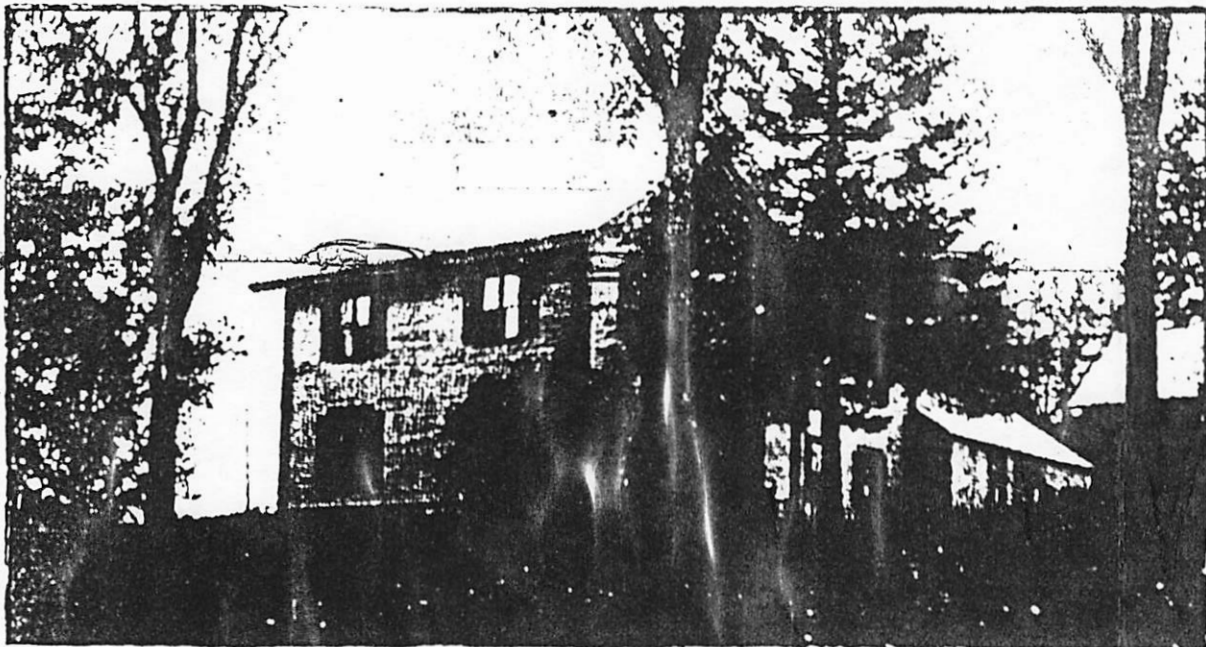

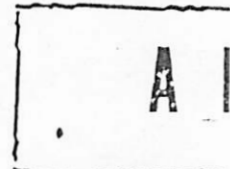

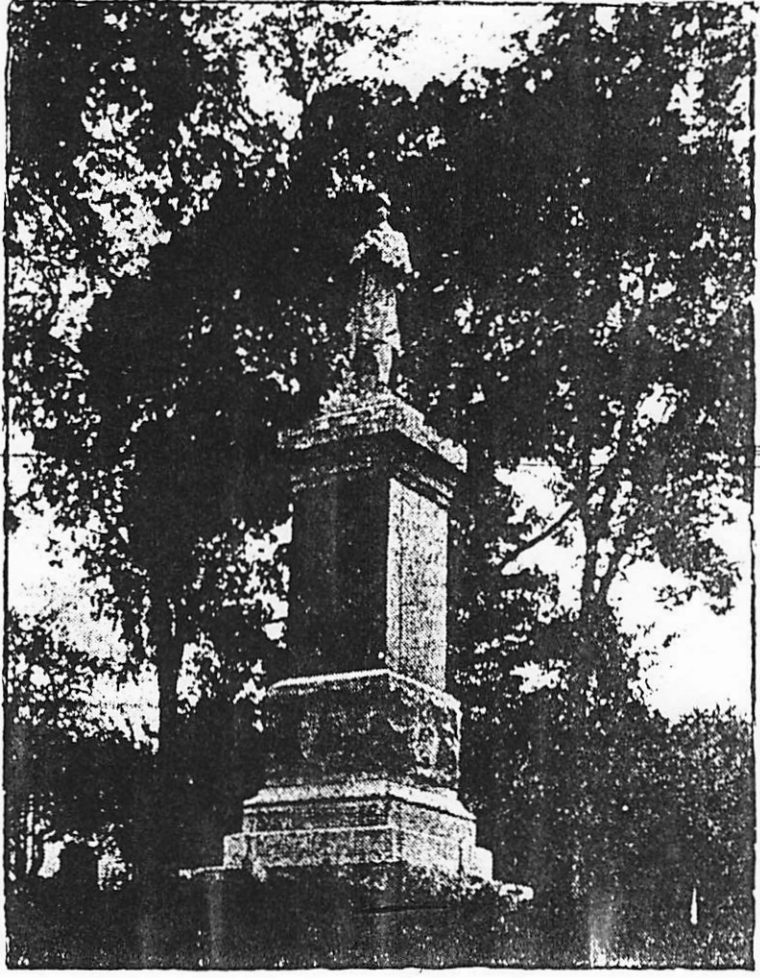
