## The Cochran Family - Nova Scotia 1761 Onward based on Family Tree supplied by the late Very Rev. E.B.N. Cochran

(for full documentation of sources referred to other than  
E.B.N. Cochran's family tree, see end of this paper. I have enclosed the  
material from these other resources in square brackets.)

Felix Cochran (1725 - December 27, 1802) married Lady Mary Moran (1715 - December 24, 1779). "Lady Mary married her father's head gardener (bailiff) and came to Nova Scotia on 'Hopewell' in 1761, with Colonel Alex McNutt, one of whose executives Felix was. Colonel McNutt brought out immigrants from Northern Ireland, most of whom settled along headwaters of the Bay of Fundy." [Felix and Mary Cochran are buried in the old St. James Cemetery at Brooklyn.]

2. Felix (1793-1853) married Mary Lockhart (1800-1873) "Felix's brother-in-law (Lockhart) owned mill property founded by Day. Each had mills - one at each end of pond at Newport. These Lockharts (Mary's family) belong to the same family as John Lockhart who was son-in-law of Sir Walter Scott." [Felix was born July 28, 1793 at Newport and died July 16, 1853; marriage date August 18, 1819 - Duncanson p 410.] [Mary d. December 28, 1872 - cemetery marker; both Felix and Mary were buried at St. James Cemetery along with four children.]

[According to Duncanson (page 384) Sophia was the eighth child of William and Elizabeth (Miller) Smith of Scotch Village. The second daughter of Alex and Sophia (Florence?) married W. Cochran, First Mate (son of John T. Cochran and Harriet Smith) (page 383) and resided in California.] [According to the gravestones in St. James Cemetery, Sophia Jane was Alex Cochran's third wife. Also listed are: Mary Jane d. March 4, 1856 ae 31, (wife of Alex Cochran); Betsey Ann d. July 23, 1864 ae 26, (wife of Alex Cochran and daughter of James Secord, Esq. of Studholm, NB); Elizabeth Eagles d August 8, 1889 ae 68 (4th wife of Alex Cochran and daughter of Joseph Bezanson, Esq. of Chester). Judging by census records, she seems to have been the daughter of William and Mary Smith. By 1901, Rupert was again a widower according to the census records and was living with his mother in Scotch Village along with Martin (first marriage) and Felix (second marriage). (Clementine Cochran died the end of March.) There is no mention of William who was listed with Rupert and Emma in the 1891 census as age 1.

Dr. Stuart must have been another son because he and Mary Cochran lived at Kempt Lodge, the Stuart homestead at Newport Corner." [grave listing Brooklyn St. James: Mary Ann Stewart d. 1 October 1831 ae 3? wife of Dunbar Douglas Stewart] [Duncanson page 411: Mary Ann Cochran by whom he had six children. Notes:

The connection between William Cochran and this family is uncertain. The Rev. William Cochran was head of King's College (the precursor of Columbia University) in New York City in the post Revolutionary period. When we visited him at Mahone Bay a year before his death in 1992, E.B.N. Cochran referred to the existence of letters from William Cochran to the Cochran family in NS about the political uncertainty of that period. William eventually came to Windsor and became head of King's College in Windsor.

Fran Bickerton has notes of a William (1757 - 1833) as son of Felix Cochran and Lady Mary Moran. E.B.N. Cochran's family tree showed William and his brother, Owen, as lost at sea, and no further information is given.

Historically the Earls of Dundonald are Cochrans. E.B.N. Cochran showed me a small portrait of the Eighth Earl of Dundonald who, he said, was an Admiral of the Fleet, fought with Wolfe at Quebec, and was buried at the Fortress at Lunenburg. The exact relationship, if any, of the immigrant Felix Cochran to the titled family of Cochrans in Scotland is unknown.
