BIOGRAPHICAL:

"Michael Combs had a desire to preach the Word of God, but it took years of determination before he found a location where he was fully accepted. It wasn't until 1826, when he purchased land in Montgomery County that he was accepted as a 'worthy' preacher. After moving here, he found there was no organized church although there were

a few brethern and sisters, whose religion was bitterly opposed and grossly misrepresented. Combs volunteered his services as a preacher in the area. Being a stranger in the county, the people were reluctant to accept his services and feared he could not meet the attacks that were sure to come. At Combs persistance, the people agreed to allow him to preach one service with an elderly brethren to sit as his judge. They were clear in stating that if his effort was feeble and unsatisfactory, they would give him neither encouragement nor a second trial.

The big day arrived and Combs saw that he was facing a very crucial position, for people flocked to the location to 'hear what this babler had to say'. Rather than be discouraged, Combs was inspired by the attention and as a result won a favorable decision of the old judge and the love and confidence of the entire little brotherhood. The views of Combs presented found favor in the eyes of a few of his neighbors and that day was the beginning of active operations in a new extensive field. It was the early dawn of the Reformation in this section of Indiana and Combs found himself in the midst of it and started organizing a new church. The Conference approved his ordination to the ministry. Having gained this approval he immediatly organized a small church near or upon his farm in Montgomery County. The organization was later moved to Crawfordsville and the Christian Churches continue to flourish today from that early beginning. Combs became prominent among the early Reformers in Indiana. He traveled through the White River Valley and was the first to oppose human creeds and plead for a union of all Christians on the Bible alone.

Combs was born in East Tennessee on February 17, 1800, the son of Job, a Scotch descendant of Presbyterian faith, and Abigail Coons of German descent. The Coons were mostly Baptists and noted for their peity and zeal for God. There were many preachers in the family, one of whom, John Coons, was imprisoned in the days of the Revolution, by the English or Episcopal Church. Michael Combs and his brother, Job, were placed in the home of a maternal uncle after their mother's death. The uncle was a strict Baptist of the Calvinistic dye. The orphan boys were taken to the Baptist Church and became bias in favor of that faith. Under the circumstances of their situation, the Combs boys' education was neglected. They were taught only to read and write. Luckily they were both very fond of books and they read everything they could get their hands on. Michael became interested in the historical portions of the Bible which made a deep impression upon him, as did the Baptist preacher of that day.

But apparently no one paid attention to Michael's deep feelings about religion and lacking encouragement, his religious impressions soon wore thin and he went about the everyday things in life. Being of a very mirthful and mischievous disposition he was easily turned altogether out of the faith. Michael's father, having married again, heard that land in Ohio was more than 'milk and honey'. He went to Ohio only to be disappointed in the land and so proceeded as far west as Wayne County, Indiana, where he pitched his tent for a short period of time. His two sons had accompanied him to the Quaker territory and they were less than impressed with the Quakers' quiet worship and solean manner. The family then moved to Preble County, Ohio, where Michael became friends of the Newlights, a class of Christians. He became very impressed with their views and attended many of their meetings and although he never joined them, Michael became a strong defender of their beliefs.

Michael married a Quaker girl, Mary Edwards and they had 13 children. She left the Quaker Church and she and Michael continued with the Newlights. Young Job Combs also started attending the meetings to see, as he said, 'What the Newlights cut up'. Because Mary was somewhat despondent, Michael started preaching to dispel her feelings. Job was converted and this led to Michael's determination to reform his life for although he was preaching he had not been converted. It wasn't until he was 22 years of age that Michael decided to join the church and truly represent himself as a Christian. About 1822, Michael and Job both commenced exhorting a great revival in which Elder David Purviance preached, Michael was so moved by the preacher's thoughts on immersion that he was immediately baptised. After his immersion, Michael began to enlarge the field of his ministry. It became necessary for him to be licensed and his congregation strongly recommended it. However, when he appeared before the Conference for a license, he was turned away. He did not understand, but for some reason he was not regarded with much favor by that body. This hesitation troubled Michael because he felt deep inside that he had received a special call from God to preach.

At first Michael waited 'in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling' for his ministry to be accepted and grow. Being very poor, his family was dependent upon his labors for their daily bread, and his reputation as a preacher was not such as to command any considerable renumeration. While he labored, Michael's mind never left his desire to preach. After long days in the field, he studied the Bible to prove himself capable of preaching. After coming to Montgomery County and organizing a church, Michael continued preaching with great zeal and at great

personal sacrifices. He was beginning to be accepted as a preacher by the people and often served without compensation, moneywise. For a period of 12 years, he was one of the very foremost in the Revolution movement, leaving the care of the family to his wife.

Almost without warning, Michael found himself barren and unfruitful. Although he did not err from the faith, he began seeking to increase his earthly possessions which resulted in many sorrows in his life the years that followed. Michael wanted to provide for his children with an education and a start in life so he turned his attentions to the affairs of life. Although he continued to preach, moving to Illinois, he was no longer considered 'the shining light' that he was in former years."
