-?---] {2175} 1715/1716. She was born about 1630. Eliza died 24 Nov 1706 in Southold, Suffolk Co., New York.

Eleanor also married (2) George HAVENS {9406}. He was born 1653 in Jamestown, Rhode Island. George died before 4 Apr 1706 in Shelter Island, Suffolk Co., New York.

George's estate was inventoried and appraised at 123 Pounds by Thomas Terry and Jonathan Hudson on 4 Apr 1706. The only ^{one} of plate was a silver cup. His wife, Eleanor, a Quaker, was the administratrix (Scott, K. and J. A. Owre, "Genealogical Data from Inventories of New York Estates: 1666-1825," New York, 1970, p. 70).

Elenor was the widow of George HAVENS. Her epitaph reads: "In memory of/ Ellenor ye Wife of / Thomas Terry & formerly / ye Wife of George Havens / died Novem[ber] ye 7th 1747 / In ye 93 year / of her age" (source: Harris, E.D., "Ancient Long Island Epitaphs from the Towns of Southold, Shelter Island and East Hampton, New York," 1903, p. 43.

21. Abigail³ TERRY {2072} (7.Richard²) was born 7 Mar 1650. Abigail died 1716, at the age of 65. She married Thomas RIDER {2078}. He was born 1645 in Southold, Suffolk Co., New York. Thomas died after 1699.

He married Deborah WELLS {1964} in Southold, Suffolk Co., New York. She was born about 1662. She was the daughter of William WELLS {5997} and Marie (Mary) YOUNGS {5999}. Deborah died 20 Oct 1729 in Cutchogue, Suffolk Co., New York, and was buried in Cutchogue, Suffolk Co., New York.

27. Samuel³ TERRY {1536} (7.Richard²) was born Apr 1664 in Southold, Suffolk Co., New York.

SOURCE NOTES for Samuel:

Source: Southold Town Records (p. 464). W. Z. Terry ("Terry Family") stated that both J.P. Terry and S.T. Terry, in their Terry Manuscripts (Mss), claimed that "Samuel either removed from Southold and/or died by 1698 or at least prior to 1714." W. Jefferson, in his "A Short History of Southold Town," stated that Samuel "probably died unmarried as no land was allotted to him in any town dividend" (p. 31). C. Moore ("Town of Southold, Long Island: Personal Index prior to 1698 and Index of 1698") stated that Samuel's father Richard, willed him half of his land at Corchaug [now Cutchogue] (p. 40). Samuel was a land owner in Southold in 1721.

28. Elizabeth³ TERRY {2075} (7.Richard²) was born 2 Apr 1666.

29. Mary³ TERRY {2077} (7.Richard²) was born Feb 1668. Mary died 4 Feb 1705, at the age of 37. She married (1) _____ WELLS {2571}.

Mary married (2) Thomas MOORE {2572}.

30. Bethia³ TERRY {2076} (7.Richard²) was born 13 Sep 1672. Bethia died 11 Oct 1739, at the age of 67. She married (1) Thomas GOLDSMITH {2568} 7 Jun 1693 in Southold, Suffolk Co., New York.
