He went to school in Groton, Mass. and Bristol, N.H. where he played on the base-ball team and is still remembered. The family noved to Stoughton, Mass. and he graduated from High School there. The family then moved to Hudson, Mass. and he went to work in his father's paper box factory, learning the business from the bottom up. He becare known in the business and in 1897 he was asked to go to Augusta, Me. to build up a paper box business there that was in trouble. While there, he and his wife lived in the best suite at the Augusta House and were a very popular couple. In 1901 they returned to Hudson, Mass. so that their first child would be born there. Herbert's father had opened a box fac-

Tirst child would be born there. herdert b lather had opened a box faber tory in Roxbury, Mass. and be went to work there and trained his brother Howard in the business. Herbert was an excellent salesman and landed a big socount, for which he took full credit. That led to unplesantness with his father, who sold out to Herbert and moved to Somerville, Mass. leaving Herbert and Howard at the factory in Roxbury. Early in 1902 Herbert moved to Somerville, Mass. and in the spring of 1905 moved his family to Winchester, Mass. where he spent the rest of his life. In 1909 he gave up his box business and went with the Carr Fastener Co. as vice president and manager of sales. In 1919 he had a disagreement with Mr. Carr, and decided to retire as he had a confortable income. That same year he was talked into buying oil stocks against his better judgement. The deal turned out to be crocked and he lost much of his money. The crash of 1929 took the rest of his income, and in 1930 he studied the insurance busimess and became a top salesman for Sun Life of Canada for the next three years. He stayed with that company and other insurance companies until

his death in 1944. He was a member of the Calumet Club in Winchester where he won numerous trophies for bowling. He was also a member of the Winchester Country Club where he won the president's cup. He had a handicap of 3 in the Mass. Golf Assoc. and was a fine athelete in every sport. He was 5' 11½" tall and weighed 240 lbs. as long as I knew him, but he was not fat, his weight being largely muscle. He had brown eyes and dark brown curly hair, which turned gray very early. He was a generous and humorous father and the idol of his small daughter.

Charles G.M. Bond went to school in Petershar, Mass. and then went to Detroit, Mich. where he worked for Fingree & Smith, boot and shoe factor as head book-keeper. He was very successful and became a member of the firm, but in 1887 his eye-sight began to fail and his wife urged him to return to Mass. He moved to Groton, where he bought a small farm and ray ed chickens, but didn't like farging and after two years he moved to Whi zan, Mass. where he opened a paper box factory, and regained for six no Mr. Pingree became Governor of the state of Mich. and sent for Charles Bond to go to Jackson, Kich. to help a friend who had a fertilizer busi ness on its last legs. It was too late to save the business, which fail ed in seven months. Charles Bond then moved his family to Bristol, N.H. where he went into partnership with his wife's Uncle Cyrus Taylor. The two men couldn't agree and after a year he left. His wife gave him a \$25,000. inheritance of hers, to open a paper box factory in Stoughton, Mass. After two years he left there and moved to Hudson, Mass. where be started a paper box business, and built a house for his family. He sonn left that factory in charge of his son-in-law, Harry Moore, and opened other factory in Roxbury, Mass. After a disagregent with his son Herber be sold out to him, and opened another paper box factory in East Cambrid Mass. He took his sons Alfred and Harold into the business, which they eventually turned into the & Consolidated Paper Bpx Co, of Somerville, Mass. John Bond emigrated to America 1639 and settled in Newbury, Mass. where he was proprietor 1642. When Rowley was set off from Newbury, his property was found to be in Rowley. In 1660 he moved to Haverhill, Mass. and took all of his family except his son John who went to Beverly, Mass. In 1661 he purchased Nelson Island for 20 lbs.

The Bonds were an ancient Anglo-Saxon fazily dating at least from the time of Edward The Confessor. The Dooksday book of William The Conqueror lists them as having wast estates and holdings in Dorset, Essex, Cornwall and eight other shires. Our branch of the family goes back to Earth in Holewood, co. Cornwall. The pedigres goes back to 1250.

The surname Bond is derived from the Anglo-Saxon word "bonds" meaning householder, proprietor, husbandgan, the gan highest in position after the Earl and responsible only to the Earl. Three brothers, William, Thomas and John em-

After their marriage, she moved many times but always loved New Hampton, N.H. best of any place and finally bought a summer home there where she died in the fall of 1909. She is buried in the New Hampton Cenetery, in the town she loved so much. She was exactly 5' tall with hazel eyes and dark brown curls.
