ST. MARY'S CEMETERY

(Bloomington Twp.)

St. Mary's Cemetery, West Washington Street Road. Started on 13 acres bought in 1856, by the Rev. Fr. Bernard O'Hara, first priest in city. It is property of Holy Trinity Parish, and Msgr. Michael Weldon, who served Holy Trinity from 1879 to his death in 1924, is buried in the central circle.

On Nov. 6, 1856, Rev. Fr. Bernard O'Hara deeded to Bishop O'Regan 6 acres for a cemetery. Until Oct. 23, 1885, the cemetery consisted only of the original 6 acres. On that date, Patrick Carroll conveyed to Bishop Spaulding 6 acres lying directly east of the original cemetery, for \$1,200.00. This was the very first addition to the area of the cemetery, and nothing more was purchased in the way of cemetery lands until Nov. 8, 1913, when John J. Morrissey, as executor of the will of Ellen Doonan, gave deed to Bishop Spaulding for 5.34 acres extending to the east of the Carroll 6 acres, for a consideration of \$3,000.00. This makes the total acreage of the cemetery at present, according to the recorded deeds, 17.38 acres--from which must be deducted the fractional acreage taken out by the right-of-way deeded to the Big Four.

Parents' names, maiden names, marriage and birth dates and some historical information have been added by reading courthouse records, obituaries, newspapers, Duis's "Good Old Times," Historical Encyclopedia of Illinois, History of McLean County Vol. II 1908, Biographical History of the Members of the McLean County Medical Society 1854-1934, in an effort to obtain as correct genealogical information as possible.

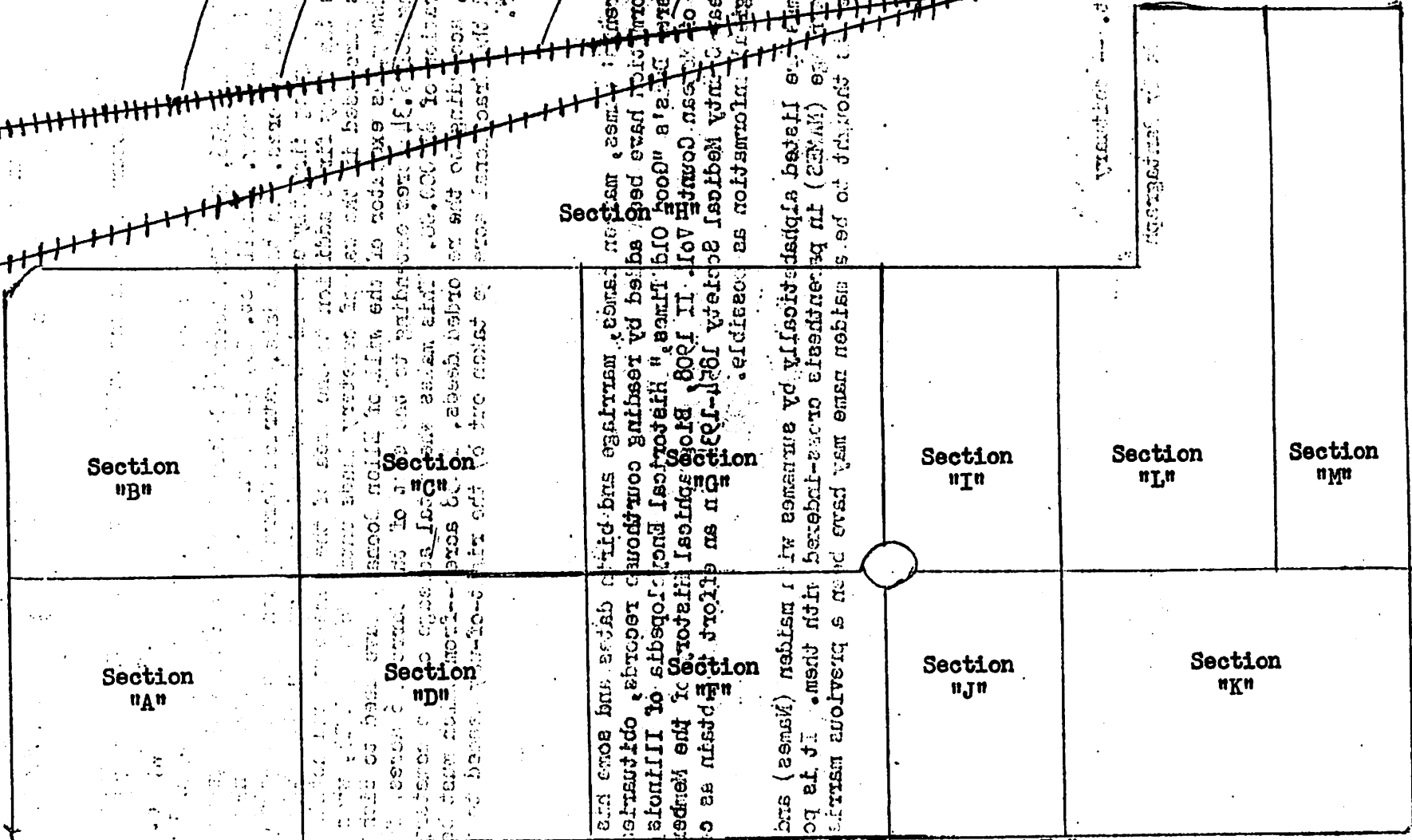

Bertha Changed her name from Budget to Bertha, She didn't like it, She had blue eyes, dark brown hair, heavy, was know for telling the truth, no matter what, She like to sew, Cook, work Cross word puzzles, Sing as she did house work, She was sick a lot, People them days never talked about these problems, She would Cry a lot, Many the Change of life etc, She had very few grey hair when she died, She liked it long and on a bun, a good Church going woman, Seemed to be Close with her family, She wrote and received letters from them all the time, Got along good with the in-laws, (Cahills). She liked to play Cards with the ladies of the Church, also Bingo, She liked to eat out but daddy didn't, She had many strokes, and ended up in a home, till she died, She loved her grand children very much and that is what kept her going, I just wish she could of lived to see all the honas they got in High school and College, and the good way they all turned out,

Bertha Flaherty (Cabell)

She was born on the 1300 block of West Chestnut I think 1312. The house is still there. When she got older she changed her name to Bertha from Bridgett. She hated that name, probably in school. Her full name Bertha Maria Rose. Rose is her Confirmation name. She talked of going to dances when young. Her mother died real young. I think mom was 13 or 14 a freshman in High school. So mom quit High school to take care of the house and the section men that stayed there when working. Like a boarding house.

She talks about walking across the Mississippi River railroad bridge when she was real small. The Engine on the train broke down and everyone had to cross the bridge. They were going to St. Louis for a picnic. That is probably when they lived in Ubbli in Southern Ill. She took her back there one day. The house is still there. Her father travel around with the section crew. He was the boss. I think most of her life was in Chicago. I think the girls all had a close bond. They kept in touch all their lives. 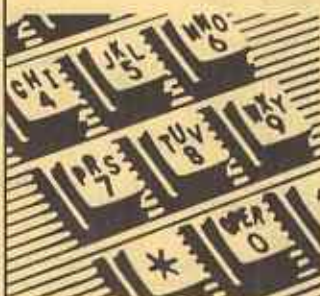
