

Dear Toni:

I will confine myself to the results of my Avery/Hawes research in this letter to keep the two lines of research separate in my files. Another letter explaining the delay in responding to your letters and discussing our Warren research will follow. I've spent a day and a half so far on this project and expect to spend a bit more later. I'm not worried about trading a fixed number of hours of research; I'm sure that you've put in far more than six hours on my behalf and will put in more before were done. Besides, research is supposed to be fun and a challenge, isn't it? I found very little on the Averys, but I have no evidence that any of them other than William and Mary (sounds like the royal couple) came to California. So far, I've:

Checked the Social Security Death Benefits Index on CD-ROM for all Averys and Hawes in what you sent me. The only match found was a Minnie Hawes, who was born too late to be Harry W.'s wife. She could be a daughter, but there is no evidence connecting her to Harry. The printout is included anyhow.

Checked the IGI on CD-ROM for all Averys and Hawes in what you sent me. I found only the birth and marriage of Norman S. Hawes, which are enclosed. There were no children of Norman and Sarah in the IGI, and I didn't order the submitter batch films. No doubt the woman researching this line has already checked the IGI, so this will not came as news. She may even be the submitter. Printouts enclosed.

Checked Family Search Ancestor File for all Averys and Hawes in what you sent me. Found nothing.

The above is all routine stuff and probably was done long ago, but I had no way of being sure, so I did it just to be sure. It was basically a waste of an hour of computer time. The results from the California State Vital Records Indexes that we have in our Family History Library are more interesting:

Hawes, Frederick N.; Sp. Init: AH; Male; Age 60; Died Los Angeles Co., 7-2-32; Cert. 32-37541 (State). (This is "our" Frederick N. - the age and date are right.)

Avery - none significant.

Hawes, Harry W.; Sp. Init.: ML; Male; S.S.: none; Died Orange Co., 5-17-47; Cert. 47-344 (Co.), 47-37895 (State). (No age on fiche, but this one sounds likely. Orange Co. next to Riverside.)

The fee was \$9.00, but may have changed. The number to call to verify current fees is 916-445-2684. Personal checks are accepted.

They are also obtainable from the respective counties using the county certificate numbers. The addresses are listed in the Helper. Riverside County death certificates after 1920 are not microfilmed, so they are not available at Family History Libraries.

There are a number of Riverside County vital records on microfilm, but we have only one reel in our library. That one is:

Item 7. Marriage License Index, Groom and Bride, 1899-1910. No Hawes.

That takes care of two of Norman's sons. Frederick N. may be indexed on Film 1290206. These marriage certificates are on Film 1249947 or can be obtained from the county clerk. There is no

point in my ordering the film, waiting three weeks, and making copies when your "client" can do it herself.

The same can be said for the other vital records films that are available, but are not on permanent loan to our library. I've made printouts of the Family History Library Catalog of vital records films for Riverside County and will enclose them for her convenience. Similar listings for Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego counties are in the FHLC.

I did not find any obituaries yet. There are some birth, marriage, and death notices in the FHLC, but they are available only in book form, not on microfilm. I will have to wait until I can go to the Riverside library to look in their books or wait until I go to Salt Lake City this Spring. The heck of it is that, if I find any more kids, I'll have to recheck the death indexes. Again, your client can order birth and marriage films as easy as I can.

My feeling is that "Soldiers Homes" or "Old Soldiers Homes" were the equivalent of today's VA hospitals. The records of William Hause Avery and Norman S. Hawes relating to their stays in soldier's homes may be in the custody of the Veterans Administration. I obtained a large file on my grandfather by writing to:

He was a Spanish-American War veteran and died in a VA hospital in Little Rock, Arkansas. I don't think there was a charge for the copy of his records.

The town of Sawtelle was absorbed into Los Angeles and it is now the Sawtelle District of Los Angeles. It lies east of Santa Monica. I've copied a couple of pages from my map book to show its location. The present Veterans Administration Hospital is not far north of there in northern Los Angeles, near Northridge (where the quake was). It is probably the former soldiers home, or on the old site. A map is also enclosed.

The Riverside Veterans Administration Hospital is also probably the former old soldiers home or on the same site, but I do not have a map book for that area to show its location.

Even though I was able to come up with a few pearls, I haven't done much to extend the family group sheets of the Hawes families. That will require birth records and obituaries. I've pointed your client to the birth records and will leave them to her. The same goes for additional marriage records. I will try for the obituaries as soon as I can get to the newspaper extract books; I could also find births and marriages in the extracts.

Dear Toni:

Once again, a separate letter on the Hawes research to keep it out of my Warren files. Since the local LDS library is closed on Monday, I spent yesterday in Riverside - and I didn't even get a dinner out of my daughter. I wanted to get home, so I didn't stop there.

The genealogy collection in Riverside is a mess. There was no volunteer on duty to help find things, and I could discern no organization to the collection. Apparently everything was shelved by author's name, regardless of content. The New York 1850 census index might have been shelved next to a family genealogy on one side and Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors on the other. It was awful. Thankfully the collection was fairly small, so I browsed the book spines, without finding anything of interest.

It turns out that what I was looking for was in the Local History section, next to the genealogy collection. There was a person on duty there, and a good thing, because what I wanted was in locked cases.

She directed me to the obituary card file, which was in the genealogy area, but was not labeled as such. There were obituaries indexed for Sarah Hawes and her daughter Winnifred [sic]. Norman was not in the index, nor were any of the sons. I did copy Sarah and Winifred's obits and looked for Norman's from the day before his death date until a week later, with no results. Apparently being in a home and his wife already dead, no one cared enough to notify the newspaper. Anyhow, the information that you wanted is all in Sarah's obit, but not much that you didn't already have. Apparent Ray should be Roy, and there were no more children other than those you already had.

For the heck of it, I copied a page out of the 1818-19 Riverside city directory. It locates Harry W. and Roy C. The Roland was Roy's son.

I asked the attendant about an old soldier's home in Riverside. She consulted with someone on the phone, and they could not come up with anything specifically called a soldier's home. She did come up with the Woodcraft Home, which was a home for the elderly of both sexes, and not specifically soldiers. She had an article about it in a book about local landmarks. I copied the page, but failed to get the title of the book for citation. Damned poor form if you ask me. It may or may not be where Norman died. If they have the address where he died, it may match that of this home.

That's about it. Riverside didn't have the local vital records on film and I hadn't planned to order them into my local library. It doesn't sound like your friend is interested enough in this line to go to the trouble and expense to document all of the vital events that occurred in Riverside. If I'm wrong, let me know. Unless I hear otherwise, I'm closing the file on this one and consider the job done.
