Infirmities

- Sight of right eye began to fail in 1888, subsequently totally blind; due to exposure and hardship in service; gunshot wound to right knee in Battle of Mobile Bay; scalp wound at Battle of Fort Morgan; acute rheumatism in right shoulder since 1888 (general affidavit, Jackson, Mich., 9 Dec 1891).
- Chronic rheumatism; scar over right temporal bone caused by a shell, also one at inner side of right knee, both apparently the result of flesh wounds; history of chronic diarrhea; examination reveals pile _____ and contracted irritable sphincter (doctor's affidavit 1 Sep 1894).
