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

Infirmities

- Wounded in right knee when captured at Brasher City, La. ca. 1 Jun 1863; ball is still in leg, causing disabling pain; suffered attack of diarrhea at Baton Rouge in 1862; severely wounded on the scalp by a piece of shell at Fort Morgan in 1862 (deposition 7 May 1886).
- Sight of right eye began to fail in 1888, subsequently totally blind; due to exposure and hardship in service; gunshot wound to right knee in Battle of Mobile Bay; scalp wound at Battle of Fort Morgan; acute rheumatism in right shoulder since 1888 (general affidavit, Jackson, Mich., 9 Dec 1891).
- Chronic rheumatism; scar over right temporal bone caused by a shell, also one at inner side of right knee, both apparently the result of flesh wounds; history of chronic diarrhea; examination reveals pile _____ and contracted irritable sphincter (doctor's affidavit 1 Sep 1894).

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

Sworn and subscribed to, at Fator Royce La this fores acol : BEFORE I CERTIFY, ON HONOR, That I have carefully examined the above named Volunteer, agreeably to the General Regulations of the Army, and that in my opinion he is free from all bodily defects and mental infirmity, which would, in any way, disqualify him from performing the duties of a soldier.

EXAMINING SURGEON.

I CERTIFY. ON HONOR, That I have minutely inspected the Volunteer, Second previously to his enlistment, and that he was entirely sober when enlisted; that, to the best of my judgment and belief, he is of lawful age; and that, in accepting him as duly qualified to perform the duties of an able-bodied soldier, I have strictly observed the Regulations which govern the recruiting service.
