Dear Ray,

after you left Saturday I read through the Lydia Carpenter Warren pension papers. The only new question they raised was "when is the one that should tell us when she was dropped from the rolls either by remarriage or by death?". Though the latest date in the record was December 20, 1866, we know she was living April 6, 1875 when she deeded her Quincy Twp property to James Walley. We don't know when or if she was living in 1877 when, according to their obits, both daughters were married — probably in Quincy Twp, since Joseph and Fay are both Quincy names.

Paul had another platelet transfusion in Coldwater yesterday at 4:00 pm. If the transfusion pattern that is beginning to emerge continues to develop

(CBC by visiting nurse around noon, call from hospital or doctor to appear in late afternoon or early evening), the prospect of trips to the court house while he's being transfused doesn't look too promising. However a death record for Lydia, marriage records for her daughters (she may have been a witness) and whatever for Matilda Hanke are on my list.

Thanks again for including us on your summer itinerary. The getting to meet you and Winnie, the pleasant dinner, the enjoyable conversation were all great.

Quite by accident, while looking for something else, I came across a reference to a Nicholas Jennings, who was flogged for fornication and forced to marry the woman, the child being born about 1643 in Saybrook. That would fit our Stephen. So I enquired more about it. Of course, Saybrook is a long way from Hadley, but not so far from Wethersfield, where the Dickinsons came from. What I found was horrendous and if it really was the parents of our Steven Jennings, no wonder they buried the traces. I repeat this not as a fact, but with fascination

Nicholas Jennings and Margaret Perre, "alias Bedforde, now wife to Nicholas Jennings" ran off with Jennings while she was indentured..not only violating her indenture agreement, but stealing some things from him to boot. Her husband was ordered to make restitution for both. When next they appear, they were accused of witchcraft, but acquitted by a hung jury. They were accused of causing the death of the wife of Reinhold Marvin by their witchcraft. Marvin was a big bug in Lyme. That would be enough to make any son run as far as he could!

Dear Ray,

Paul got home from a 10 day stay in the hospital on June 7 with a diagnosis of AML (acute myeloblastic leukemia). Without treatment the prognosis was grim indeed - fatal in two to four weeks. With the somewhat conservative chemo and other supportive medicinal treatment he's elected to undergo, the prognosis appears to depend on how assiduously he manages to avoid contact with viruses and bacteria that could lead to massive infection, pneumonia and/or hemorrhage. Time will tell. At present it's like living in a time warp. Right now he looks and feels better than he has in six months.

I don't have too much to add to the tid bits in your last letter, but do think it'd be a good idea that you check in with me when you first get to the area around August 1 before you set out on the search for missing links that I may have already.

The Lydia Folger, ^{whom} Julie Carr found in the 1894 index was Lydia Burroughs Westfall Folger, mother-in-law of Charles C. Young, not his step mother Lydia Warren Fox Young. I have a copy of her death record from the Township Register

of Death. Third wife of Alongo Falger,
she died Dec 15, 1899, aged 75-8-24. 2

IMMIGRATION HISTORY TIMELINE

The following timeline is an overall picture of important legislation and historical events relating to immigration from 1790 through 1990, and shows the immigration of over fifty-five million --- and counting.

Although this report is as accurate as possible given the factors of its statistics don't take everything you read as absolute. For instance, statistics provided by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service indicate twenty-five countries contributed over 85% of all immigration to the United States. However, these are countries of last residence not the country of origin. So the figures can differ, especially in the case of Canada, from the actual country of origin of some immigrants.

Genealogists find it a difficult world to summarize because of changing geopolitical climates, and changes in borders and titles of nations.

Furthermore, I.N.S. statistics are of national origin and emmigration and do not show ethnic backgrounds. This is particularly conspicuous in Jewish immigration. Several other populations are assigned to one grouping: Lithuania and Estonia are listed under the former USSR, Wales and Scotland are clustered to United Kingdom, Sicily is Italy. Puerto Ricans are not even enumerated due to their dual citizenship.

Prior to 1820, no official records of immigration existed. The accepted figure is 250,000 arrivals between the first census of 1790 and 1820.

Prior to 1868, all alien passengers were included in a single immigration statement. Although it is estimated that fully one-third of all immigrants eventually emigrated from the United States.

For the purposes of this paper the meaning of emigration and immigration is defined as follows:

An emigrant (noun) is a person who leaves one country or area to emigrate (verb) and to settle elsewhere.

An immigrant (noun) is a person entering, coming into; to immigrate (verb) into and settle in a country or region to which one is not native.

Mnemonic device: I-immigrant/ I-immigrate = I-in.

Many immigrants from Alexander Graham Bell to Albert Einstein are among those millions of individuals who came with bold determination becoming a dynamic force in the history of the United States. People who built railroads, highways and bridges. People from every corner of the world.

There is no reliable measure of illegal immigration. Estimates of undocumented immigration total in the millions and cannot be accurately statistically analyzed.

Seventeen million immigrants were counted who sailed past the Statue of Liberty and arrived at Ellis Island with their dreams of freedom.

TIMELINE SHOWING SOME FEDERAL HISTORY

The Great Movement West and the Settlement of the Northwestern Plains

This is an overview of the continental United States Frontier Migration. Included are a few significant dates regarding the nation's railroad industry creating an intercontinental system facilitating movement west. The migration westward started about ten years after 1776, and continued for over one hundred years. By the mid-1860s only the U.S. Great Plains region is left unsettled. The Frontier Era is considered over by 1890.

- 1785 Federal Ordinance regrading westward expansion signed into law
- 1785 Northwest passage Ordinance signed into law
- 1801 Napoleon's war in Europe set stage for the U.S.A. to negotiate; Thomas Jefferson (1743-1826; 3rd U.S. President from 1801 to 1809) determined the Louisiana Purchase of 1803
- 1803 Napoleon, who had recovered Louisiana from Spain by secret treaty, sold all of Louisiana, stretching to Canadian border, to U.S., for \$11,250,000 in bonds, plus \$3,750,000 indemnities to American citizens with claims against France. U.S. took title Dec. 20, 1803
- 1804 Purchases doubled U.S. area, an est. 828,000 square miles of land.
- 1804 Lewis and Clark expedition explores northwest U.S., starting Mo.
- 1811 Cumberland Road begun at Cumberland, Md; is major route west
- 1812 The War of 1812 with Great Britain; Lord Selkirk's Red River Valley exploration; The United States and Great Britain sign the Treaty of London; The Settlement of the 49th Parallel; Northeastern North Dakota is ceded to the U.S.A.
- 1818 Treaty with Great Britain cedes northeast North Dakota to the U.S.
- 1819 Treaty with Spain; Fort St. Anthony is established in area of Minneapolis-St. Paul. Spain cedes Florida to U.S. Feb. 22, 1819
- 1825 The Erie Canal is completed Oct. 26, Great Lakes to Atlantic's NYC
- 1828 First railroad carries passengers
- 1833 Iowa is granted statehood
- Pre-Emption Act (right to buy before others government-owned land)
- 1836 First white women to cross plains
- 1838 Cherokee Indians "Trail of Tears," removed from Georgia to Okla.
- 1841 First emigrant wagon train for California left Independence, Mo.
- 1842 Settlement of Oregon begins via Oregon Trail
- 1843 More than 1,000 settlers left Independence, Mo. for Oregon
- 1845 Texas Congress voted for annexation by U.S. July 4; U.S. Congress admits Texas to Union, Dec. 29, 1845
- 1846 Treaty with Great Britain June 15 sets boundary in Oregon Territory at 49th parallel, extension of existing line. (The Act of the Treaty of 1846, also encourages settlement in the Great Plains of the northwest part of the country).
- Treaty with Mexico in Feb., ceded claims to Texas, California, Arizona, New Mexico, Nevada, Utah, part of Colorado to U.S.
- Elias Howe invents the sewing machine
- 1847 Salt Lake City, Utah settled July by Mormons under Brigham Young
- 1848 Gold discovered Jan. 24 in California; 80,000 prospectors emigrate
- 1849 Minnesota Territory established
- 1850 Millard Fillmore (1800-1874; 13th U.S. President from 1850 to 1853) The Land Grant Act of 1850 sells the Railroad's right-of-way land to settlers; RR retains a checkerboard property configuration plus

- beside the RR, so that no structure may be built across the tracks
- Sen. Henry Clay's Compromise of 1850 admits California as 31st state; made Utah and New Mexico Territories
- 1855 First railroad crossing the Mississippi
- 1858 Minnesota is granted statehood
- The Bessemer steel process is developed
- 1860 First Pony Express between St. Joseph, Mo., and Sacramento, CA.
- 1861 March 2nd: Dakota Territory is created
- First transcontinental telegraph is put into operation;
- 1862 Federal Government creates the Homestead Act, May 20, 1862; Homestead Act grants free family farms to settlers
- Sioux Uprising; War with Native American Indians' of Sioux Nation.
- 1867 Alaska sold to U.S. by Russia for \$7.2 million Mar. 30, 1867
- The Grange was organized Dec. 4, 1867, to protect farmer interests

- 1870 J.J. Hill buys the St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba Railroad which became the Great Northern Railroad in 1893. The U.S. Government did not grant lands to the building of this railroad line.
- 1872 Congress founds the first national park, Yellowstone in Wyoming
- The Northern Pacific Railroad reaches Fargo in east N.Dak.
- 1873 Banks failed, panic begins in Sept., Depression lasts 5 years
- Northern Pacific reaches south central N. Dak., capital, Bismarck
- The Tree Claim Act of 1873 is signed into law
- 1875 Bonanza farming begins in the Dakotas
- 1876 Battle at the Little Big Horn, Mont., Col. George A. Custer and 264 7th Cavalry soldiers killed June 25, 1876, in Sioux Indian War
- 1878 The Timber Culture Act of 1873 is signed into law
- 1881 Peace Treaty with the Dakotas' Indian Nations
- 1883 North Dakota is opened to homesteading
- Several branch lines of Hill's RR cross Red River Valley
- 1884 The Carnegie Steelworks is founded
- The first shipment of iron ore from Minnesota's Vermillion Range
- Railroad stock becomes available to the investing public
- 1886 Geronimo, Apache Indian, finally surrenders, Sept. 4, 1886
- The Statue of Liberty is dedicated, Oct. 28, 1886
- 1887 Railroad reaches Helena,
- 1888 Railroad systems reach from Buffalo NY to western Montana
- 1889 U.S. declares Oklahoma open to white settlement, Apr. 22, 1888
- North Dakota granted statehood
- 1890 Battle of Wounded Knee, SD, Dec. 29, 1890; the last major conflict between Native American Indians and U.S. troops. About 200 Indian men, women and children, and 29 soldiers were killed.
- 1891 Forest Reserve Act, Mar. 3, 1891; lets President close forest land to settlement for establishment of national parks.
- 1892 Strike at Carnegie steel mills is a setback for unions
- Ellis Island, immigration depot opens at N.Y.
- 1893 The railroad system extends to the west coast.

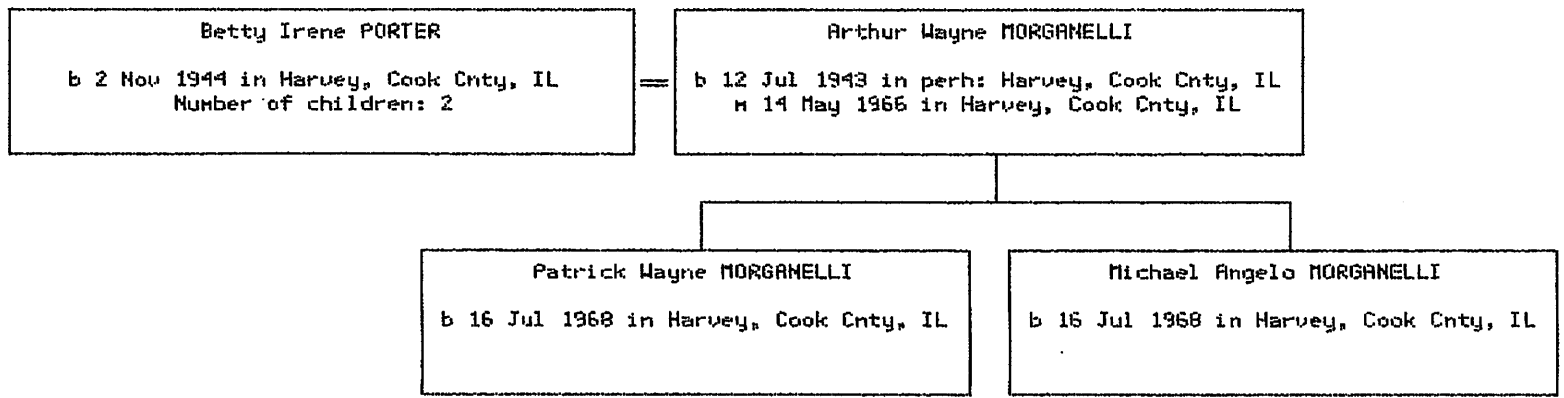
Enlistment, Service, Discharge

- Enlisted and mustered in as Private 18 Oct 1861 at Mansfield, Ohio in 6th Independent Battery, Ohio Light Artillery for 3 years (Battery Muster-in Roll, 10 Dec 1861).
- Fell off a precipice and injured head in Aug 1862 at Cumberland Mt., Tenn. while helping to get the gun carriage up the mountain (Invalid Pension Application 19 Nov 1878).

- Reenlisted 12 Dec 1863 at Chattanooga, Tenn. in 6th Independent Battery, Ohio Light Artillery for 3 years; Born Cork Ireland; Age 26 years; Occupation farmer; Eyes blue; Hair Light; Complexion light; Height 5 ft., 8 in. (Veteran Volunteer Enlistment paper 12 Dec 1863).
- Mustered in 27 Dec 1863 at Chattanooga, Tenn. in 6th Independent Battery, Ohio Light Artillery; Bounty paid \$60; Due \$340 (Muster and Descriptive Roll of Vet. Vols., Chattanooga, Tenn., 27 Dec 1863).
- Transportation granted from Cleveland, Ohio to [illegible] 18 Feb 1864, which has been entered on his furlough (U.S. Quarter Master Office memo to Payroll General, U.S.A.).
- Promoted from Corporal to Sergeant 1 June 1864 (Battery Muster Roll, May & June 1864).
- On detached duty at Headquarters Artillery Brigade, 4 Army Corps (Battery Muster Rolls, Sep 1864 to Jun 1865).
- On duty in Head Quarters Artillery, 4 Army Corps in Huntsville, Ala. (Muster Roll, Jan & Feb 1865).
- On duty in Head Quarters Artillery, 4 Army Corps near Nashville, Tenn., (Muster Roll, Mar & Apr 1865).
- Mustered out at Camp Chase, Ohio 1 Sep 1865 (Detachment Muster-out Roll).
