He married second 18 July 1831 Eleanor Moore, daughter of Thomas Moore, probably Mary's younger sister. Their children were Jackson Sutton and several others. Levi left his family in 1844 or 1845. I have seen your Family Group Sheet in THE FAMILY TREE and am writing to ask if you have found the name Charles Rogers in your search. I will enclose a sheet giving information about him and his wife, Eliza Phillips. You will note that he was born in Sharon, Connecticut, April 5, 1799.

We do not have the name of Charles Rogers' father, but my brother thinks it may have been Ichabod. According to his obituary, Charles went to Vermont with his grandfather when he was 6 years old and remained there until he was 16. We don't know whether this was his maternal or paternal grandfather.

When he was 16, according to the obituary, he went to Stockbridge, New York. According to HISTORY OF MADISON COUNTY, a Herman Knox lived there in the 1820's and then went to Illinois. Your query in the October 1989 issue of NEHGS NEXUS about Samuel ROGERS has me wondering if there could be any connection with my illusive Samuel ROGERS. Does your Samuel ROGERS b Jan 1754 have a son Samuel b ca 1773?

My Samuel was supposedly born near Boston, MA about 1773. But I have found no proof. I did find a ROGERS family in Newton, MA with a son Samuel born 15 Jun 1772. Parents Nathaniel and Susannah (HALL) ROGERS and siblings Susanna and William were all also born in Newton. But the Newton Vital Records gave no death dates for any of them and no marriage dates for the children.

My Samuel married Rhoda NEWELL probably not long before they went to Oneida co., NY in 1797. Rhoda was supposed to have been born near Boston also, about 1772. The only likely Rhoda whose birth I have found was born in Dudley, MA, bap 10 Sep 1775, daughter of Daniel NEWELL (no mother given) - Dudley MA Vital Records. If this is my Rhoda, your mention of Dudley in your query made me wonder if my Samuel was from around there too. Not very "near" Boston! Also I see that Sandy Creek, NY isn't very far from Mexico, Oswego co., NY, where Samuel and Rhoda ROGERS settled about 1800.

Isn't it unfortunate and confusing that so many ROGERS' sons were named Samuel? I shall be interested to hear if any of your research fits into my ROGERS problem areas.

## Dear Lucille:

I'm afraid that I have to agree with on the number of Samuel Rogers in the past; they must rank right after John Smith in number.

Unfortunately, I can't help you on the Samuel Rogers who lived in the town of Mexico. I keep running into him in census and deed research, but as far as I know, he is not related to my Rogers line. There was a Samuel Rogers, Jr. in my line who could have been him, but they were both listed in the 1820 census, yours in Mexico, and mine in Richland (later Sandy Creek).

I also have extensive information on another Rogers line that came from Rhode Island and settled in Washington County, NY. (My Rogerses came through Washington County to Sandy Creek.) There were several Samuels in it, but none married a Rhoda or moved to Mexico.

There is a book, Descendants of John Rogers of Boxford, MA through his son Nathaniel by Edwinna Bierman, that has a lot of Samuel Rogerses in it. I couldn't connect to any of them. Perhaps you can; it's in the LA Library and the LA Mormon Temple Library.

Sorry I couldn't be of more help.
