I do hereby certify that the above named persons of the County of Washington has given me satisfactory proof that they actually resided on the Respective Farms -annexed to their names, in the division of a patent of Twenty five Thousand acres of Land Originally granted to Alexander Turner and twenty four others on

the 7th day of August 1764, and that on Account of the late War, they were respectively Obliged to quit their said Farms by the Incursions of the Enemy, as Witness my hand this 24th day of January 1769.
