volunteered this *Fifth* day of *December* 1862,
to serve as a **Soldier** in the Army of the United States of America, for the period of **THREE**
YEARS, unless sooner discharged by proper authority: Do also agree to accept such
bounty pay, rations, and clothing, as are, or may be, established by law for volunteers. And
I, *Eli Baubler* do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith
and allegiance to the **United States of America**, and that I will serve them
honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will
observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the
officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.

Dear Raymond,

Thank you for the order, and it surely does look as though I've been able to answer some of your genealogical questions here...

Catherine (Warren) Sutton did remarry on 7 Nov 1861 in Hillsdale County, Michigan to Eli Banker. The good news for your genealogical purposes here is that Eli Banker then served from Michigan in the Civil War.

I suspect that perhaps they left Michigan or at least Hillsdale County as they are not listed among the indexed tombstone write-ups of Hillsdale County. The 1900 soundex for the census should also be checked out.

The answers as to what did happen to them will surely be all answered if he did receive a pension from the government. His military and pension papers can be obtained from the National Archives in Washington, D.C.

I also have something here that may be of interest regarding the Warren family. On an enclosure here you will notice an Anna Eliza (Sharpsteen) Warren, and notice too that she was born the very same year as the Mary Warren that you speak of on the 1860 census. Perhaps Mary was knicknamed Anna or visa versa.

This Anna and her husband are buried in the Bankers Cemetery, and I have nothing here that tells us if this Banker has any relationship to our above mentioned Eli Banker. I do see that there is more information here to be found on Ira & Anna Warren, but donot see a Catherine mentioned among their children.

I surely hope that the above has been of substantial help towards solving your Hillsdale County problems. Would surely like to help again if needed. Hope this finds all well out there in Tustin, and have a nice day...
