Thank you so much for all of your kind assistance when I visited your library in July. I am sending to you, as I promised, some information on some of the early settlers of the Redfield and Orwell area.

I have included some information on the following three families, Bennett, Brooks, and Strong. These families inter-married in the Redfield/Orwell area in the early 1800s.

Nathaniel Bennett (III), son of Nathaniel Bennett (II) of Orwell, married Laura Strong. Hannah Bennett, daughter of Nathaniel Bennett (II) married Stephen Brooks of Redfield. Samuel Brooks of Redfield married Lament Strong. Lament and Laura were sisters and daughters of Eli Strong of Redfield. I believe Stephen and Samuel Brooks were half-brothers.

There are group sheets here for each family. They do not contain all of the descendants, but just those I thought would be pertinent to the Orwell/Redfield area.

I have given the denotables(?) (I), (II), and (III) to the Nathaniel Bennetts to make it easier to keep them straight.

Please make it known that anyone interested in these families may make copies of these pages and I will welcome all inquiries, comments and/or further information. I am a descendant of Nathaniel Bennett (I) and Elizabeth Whipple, so consequently have more information on their descendants. I have been trying for years to link the last two people to their parents, but with very little success. The search will continue.

Again, thank you so much for your help and I hope that these few pages will add to your wonderful collection of local history.

Stephen's birth and death dates from "Some Pioneer Families of Wisconsin, An Index", WSGS, 1977. The following information from a descendant of Stephen Brooks: "Stephan and his older half brother, Samuel migrated from Middletown, CT to Redfield, NY with the first group of immigrants to the area. Stephan had some surveying skills and was instrumental in laying out the first roads in the area. It was stated that his primary motivation was to make it easier to court Hannah Bennett. They were married in Nov 1809 and over the next 22 years had 8 or 9 children. Stephan's half brother died in 1814 leaving several children. Sometime within the next few years Stephan's parents joined him from CT. In 1837 at the age of 56, Stephan came to Wisconsin. He did some road work for a few years before he settled in Winnebago County in May 1839. Soon his nephew joined him."

Town of Halifax, VT. Vital Records, Vol.1, Book of Records, p.386 for marriage of Nathaniel and Elizabeth and the births of their children. One of Nathaniel Bennett's daughters may have married a Robert Woolery. Marriage and births of children were registered at same time, sometime after Anna was born. All children registered in VT but not necessarily born there. Census and biographical records found recently would indicate that the first three children, at least, were born in CT.

From "Gazetteer of New York" compiled by J.H. French LL.D, 1860 Eighth Ed:

"The first settlers of the town of Orwell, NY were Nathaniel Bennett and his son, Nathaniel, from Rensselaer County, NY on lots 82 and 83 and Capt. Noyes on lot 29."

From: "Landmarks of Oswego County NY," Churchill, John 1895:

"In 1807 Nathaniel Bennett, Sr., and Nathaniel, Jr., settled in the Eastman and Merrill locality" [Eastman and Merrill were the first settlers of Orwell].

From: "Landmarks of Oswego County NY," Churchill, John 1895:

"In 1808 David Eastman, another son of Frederick, married Betsey, a daughter of Nathaniel Bennett, which was probably the first marriage in town. 'State Gazetteer' gives this honor to Robert Wooley and a daughter of Nathaniel Bennett, Sr. in 1807," but the best authority points to the accuracy of the first statement. The first white birth was that of a child of David Eastman, whose young wife was the first victim of death, in 1810, unless it was the mother of Timothy Balch, who died about the same time."

"Landmarks of Oswego County NY," Churchill, John, 1895:

"Methodist Episcopal Churches.--It is said that Bishop Asbury, on his way from Canada early in the century, came through Sackett's Harbor

and followed the old military road through Redfield and thence continued down the Salmon River to Pekin, Williamstown, Camden and Rome. The beginning of Methodist preaching in Orwell was at Pekin by Ira Fairbanks in 1811. A society was organized in that neighborhood and since that organization, Pekin has remained a regular appointment. A small church was built there in 1850. Elder Fairbanks, during his year on the Mexico circuit, received only \$25.00 and left the charge out of debt. The number of members then on the circuit was 258. Among the early members of the class at Pekin were Frederick Eastman, at whose house the meetings were held, and who had previously been a Presbyterian; the two Nathaniel Bennetts and their wives; Millen Aiken, John and Caroline Reynolds; Robert Wooley, Aaron West, Betsey Beadle, and a man named Herrick, and the wives and sons of most of these."

Headstone at Pekin Cemetery: "Elizabeth Bennett, wife of Nathaniel Bennett died 8 Feb 1835 AE 90 yrs". Elizabeth's stone faced West. Elizabeth's headstone is broken at the point where her age was engraved. Even though there was a small piece of stone missing, the age at death appears to be 90. The upper two thirds of the stone was propped against the bottom piece. Some of the ladies of the area copied this cemetery in the late 1970s and from their records, Elizabeth's age at death was written 70.

The Wright burial information came from the Orwell, NY, Town Historian, Mrs. Martin. Ann Janette (Bennett) Wright was Gill N. Bennett's daughter. There were other Bennett families in the area, but connection, if any, is unknown. The following was researched and written by Mrs. Ralph O. Frazer of Syracuse, NY:

"Pekin Cemetery, Town of Orwell, Oswego County, New York. This old cemetery is on the top of a high knoll, on the east side of an old road going north from Bennetts Bridge to the Village of Orwell. In the summer it is easy to miss as the trees and bushes hide the stones from the road. The later burials were about 1920. The cemetery is unkempt and uncared for. The ground is thickly covered with myrtle and berry bushes. Many stones have been knocked over; many graves are sunken in; many markers have been carried away. For all its neglect it is not an unattractive place; high on the hill with the sky overhead, the soft green myrtle carpet underfoot, and the quiet. The old town of Pekin has long since disappeared. An old timer, long ago told of the church next to the cemetery, and the horse sheds reached by the same long narrow, ledge-like road that led to the cemetery. There were a few stores across the road and a mill on the river. The Salmon River runs about a mile south of the place. On the north side of the Cemetery next to a pine plantation are the Bennett graves, in a row. There are several places where there have been burials but there are no stones left, only the sunken places to show that the ground has been disturbed. [July 1992 - there is a Pekin Cemetery sign posted (by the Cemetery Association) on the east side of the road near the cemetery making the cemetery easy to find today.]

Anna's headstone is in the first row on the north west side of the cemetery about half way down. Most of the headstones in this cemetery face West. Anna's headstone was out of its holder and lay face up on the ground. The stone is tall and slender and about 2" thick.
