William Moncrief, Jr., made out his will Aug. 5, 1819. In it he provided for his "beloved wife Sarah." To his daughter, Mary Safford, he bequeathed \$600, payment to be made in cattle; a large looking-glass; and half of his religious books. To his son, William Moncrief, Jr., he willed all the use and income of his estate both real and personal—but not the power of disposing of any part of the real estate! Robert Hanna and Rufus Chou were appointed executors, and it was witnessed by Abn. Alien, Agness Moncrief, and Robert Armstrong.

⁴ HUGH² MONCRIEF (William¹) was born ca. 1759 in Ireland or Scotland.⁵ He died Mar. 27, 1813, age 53 years according to his tombstone in the Revolutionary War Cemetery, Salem, N.Y.

Hugh married Jennette Foster before 1781. Jane, as she was called, was born in 1754, probably in Ireland.⁶ After her husband's death, Jennette went to St. Lawrence County, N.Y. with her son, James, and there she died on April 10, 1836. She was buried at the Campbell Cemetery in the town of Lisbon, St. Lawrence County, N.Y.

Jennette's parents were John Foster and his wife, Mary McCombs. The Fosters had come along with Dr. Clark from Ireland in 1764; John Foster was one of the original Elders in the Salem congregation as was Hugh's father, William Moncrief. John and Mary Foster's children were: Hannah (of Hebron), Matthew and Isabel (twins?), Abigail, Kerinah, Elizabeth, Jane, John, Sarah, Mary (born ca. 1764), and James.

Hugh Moncrief served in the Revolutionary War in Captain Armstrong's Company of the Charlotte County Militia under Colonel John Williams. He was fined 40 shillings on Mar. 23, 1778 at a Regimental Court Marshall at Fort Williams when he stayed on his farm and disobeyed orders. A copy of the original document is on page 32.

Hugh Moncrief also followed in the family tradition of Christian service. Pitch recorded that on Sept. 15, 1792 Duncan McNaughton had a son, James, baptized at Hugh Moncrief's in Salem; and on Aug. 25, 1793 John McCleland had a daughter.

Sarah, baptized at Hugh's. When the Associate Presbyterian Church of West Hebron was organized in 1799, the first three Elders were Andrew Beveridge, Hugh Moncrief, and William McClellan, "names eloquent of sterling worth and high traditions."

Hugh Moncrief lived on lot #25 of the Turner Patent, which was about 88 acres. (See map on page 17.) In 1782 his house and land were valued at £1159 and his personal property at £86.0.8d. He inherited the north half of lot #32 and one other lot (probably #20 or #29) from his father upon his death in 1794. His real estate in 1795 was assessed at £350 and his personal property at £51.6.0 (whereas before his inheritance his real estate value was £111 and personal estate was £33.5.15).⁷

Hugh Moncrief served the town of Salem, N.Y. as one of the pathmasters in Feb. 16, 1787, 1792, 1794, 1797; and in 1806 he was appointed fence viewer.

Hugh Moncrief was rich in children. He had at least five sons and five daughters. The 1790 census of Salem shows his family consisting of three males and one female besides he and his wife. The 1800 census of Salem shows Hugh and his wife, five males and five females. (A check of N.Y. and surrounding states' census records for 1810 did not list Hugh Moncrief in any of the indexes.) From the information we know and the age categories of these indexes, we can get an idea of the ages of their children. There was no widow Jane Moncrief listed as head of a household in 1820. She was probably living with one of her children. Checking this census, she was not in Greenwich with sons James or John; nor was she in Salem with son, Hugh Moncrief, Jr. However, her son, William H. Moncrief, living in Salem listed a female of the correct age to be his mother in his household.

We do not know what caused the death of Hugh Moncrief in 1813. It must have been very unexpected as Hugh died without making a will. He died intestate and Letters of Administration were issued April 12, 1813 to Jennett Moncrief, William H. Moncrief, and John Foster (probably Jennette's brother).⁷

7 WILLIAM H.³ MONCRIEF (Hugh², William¹) was born about 1782 in Salem, N.Y. He seems to be the oldest of Hugh's children, and as you can see, he is named for his paternal grandfather. He died June 27, 1858 at Salem, at age 75. He is buried in the Old Cemetery in Salem.

William H.'s first wife was Mary (last name unknown). "Folly" was born about 1785 and died April 18, 1813 at Salem, N.Y., age 27 years. She was buried at

the Old Cemetery in Salem, N.Y. They had a daughter, Esther, born Nov. 15, 1812, and died June 29, 1813 at the age of 7 months and 14 days. She was buried beside her mother in the Salem Cemetery.

William's second wife was Agnes Law Irving, the widow of John Irving. Agnes, born about 1788, died on June 16, 1821 at the age of 32 years. She also is buried at the Old Cemetery in Salem, N.Y. William and Agnes had at least three daughters. The 1820 census of Salem shows William H., Agnes, and 4 females under age 10 (plus an older female which was probably William's widowed mother, Jennette).

The third wife of William H. Moncrief was Hepziba Gould. Hepziba was born ca. 1790 in Vt. (probably Windham County). She was the second child of Ebenezer Gould (see page 107 for Gould family information). She died Oct. 30, 1877, age 87, years. Hepziba was living with step-daughter Isabel and her husband, Ransom Buck, on the 1870 census of Salem. With Hepziba, age 79, was also step-daughter Elizabeth Moncrief, age 53. (Isabel was listed as age 50 and Ransom age 48) Hepziba's will dated Dec. 7, 1874 left everything to Betsey Moncrief, her step-daughter.¹⁰

William H. Mccrief spent his whole life in the Salem area. He was first listed as a pathmaster for District #26 in April 1813; and in April 1814 was appointed commissioner of highways.⁶ All the census taken during his lifetime show him in Salem.

The 1835 N.Y. State Census also listed William H. in Salem with his family and recorded that he had 50 acres of land. The 1855 N.Y. State Census showed the same information but he had 50 acres of improved land and 25 acres of unimproved land at that time. According to Fitch, William H. kept his father's place after his death in 1813—that probably would have been lot #28. In 1819, William H. bought lot #47 from David Russell for \$1,700.⁴ Sometime after the mid 1850s, William and Hepzibah moved to lot #223 in South Salem.

No will was found in the Surrogate Court of Washington County in Salem for William H. Moncrief. Apparently, he took care of all his business before his death, and therefore, had no need for a will. Hepzibah and Isabella did sell some land to Elizabith Moncrief in 1859, so perhaps he had left some instructions of some sort.

Mar. 10, 1878, Betsey Noncrief's will dated Sept. 18, 1893 and probated April 30, 1894 bequeathed property to Daniel Steele, his wife Emma E. Steele, and to their children Charles Bell Steele and Adelaide Mary Steele. Their relationship to Elizabeth Noncrief, if any, is not known at this time.

⁹ JOHN³ MONSELIEF (Hugh², William¹) was born Mar. 25, 1786 in Washington County, N.Y., and died in Argyle on Nov. 17, 1852, aged 66 years, 7 months, 23 days. He is buried in Argyle near Cossatoga Lake at the McKachron Cemetery. (See map of the Argyle area on page 12.)

John was married to Catharina Reid. She was born Sept. 16, 1780 in the Washington County, N.Y. area, and died in Argyle, June 16, 1853, aged 77 years and 5 months. She is buried with her husband at the McEachron Cemetery.

Catherine's parents were Alexander Reid and Eunice Campbell. Alexander Reid was born Jan. 17, 1752; the son of John Reid and Margaret Hyman, who emigrated to this country from Argyleshire, Scotland, in the company brought over by Laughlin Campbell in 1739. Alexander Reid died June 3, 1833, aged 81 years. Eunice Campbell, a daughter of William Campbell and his first wife, Catharine Kennedy, was born Mar. 9, 1762 and was married to Alexander Reid on Nov. 16, 1779 by Rev. Thomas Clark of Salem. Eunice died Oct. 12, 1843, aged 81 years. They were among the early settlers in Argyle and remained there until his death. The children of Alexander Reid and Eunice Campbell were all mentioned in his will. i. Catherine Reid who married John MacCleish; ii. Margaret Reid born in 1782 and married Robert McFarland; iii. Daniel T. Reid born in 1786 and married to Rosanna Rainey; iv. John J. Reid born 1788; v. William Reid born 1789, married Ann King; vi. Peter Reid born 1795 and married Phebe Hutchens; vii. Alex Reid born 1797, married Barbara Dutcher; viii. Duncan Reid born 1800; ix. David P. Reid born 1803; and x. Eunice C. Reid born 1806.

John Moncrief, "son of Hugh from Scotland, 1st Elder of the United Presbyterian Church of West Hebron, was a blacksmith."¹⁰ We find John Moncrief first listed on the 1810 census of Hebron. With him and his wife are three females under the age of 10. The 1820 census of Greenwich lists John, his wife, 7 males, and 6 females. By the time of the 1830 census, John's family had moved a few

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PREFACE

This book is an enlarged edition of the author's first book in this series entitled "North Kingstown, South Kingstown, Exeter and Richmond, Rhode Island Marriages from the Probate Records 1692-1850". Since that book was well received, it has been decided to expand it to include all of Washington County, Rhode Island. As the expanded volume contains more than twice as many entries as the first book (7600 entries compared to 3700), the present book has been renumbered Vol 5.

The chief features of a marriage record are the names of the bride and groom and the date and place of marriage. If given in the record, the names of the fathers (or parents) of the bride and groom are of particular genealogical value. In the 1700's and early 1800's before 1853 when a more exacting vital record law was passed in Rhode Island many marriages there were never recorded. As detailed in the preface of his Vol 3 the author has calculated that only one marriage in 7 which actually took place in a part of Washington County between 1800 and 1850 was recorded in the civil vital records and appear in James N. Arnold's "Vital Record of Rhode Island", Vol 5 Washington County. Thus an alternative marriage record would be welcome. Such a record exists in wills where the father (or other relative) mentions his married daughters (relatives). These wills are rarely available in printed form, generally existing only in the original repositories and often as microfilm copies in the genealogical records of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Even more rarely if ever have these records been indexed and arranged in such a way as to serve as an alternative marriage record. It is the purpose of this work to compile such a record for Washington County, Rhode Island from the incorporation of the towns to the year 1860 or shortly thereafter. Often a man's children have been married quite a number of years at the time he writes his will, and thus the wills were abstracted up to the period between 1860 and 1870 in an effort to include the bulk of the marriages which actually took place before 1853. These records give the names of the bride and groom, although in just under half (47%) of the cases the groom is identified only as, for example, Mr. Brown.

Rarely the given name of the bride will be either lost (as from the partial destruction of the North Kingstown records) or never mentioned which circumstance occurs occasionally with deceased daughters. Such daughters are recorded as, e.g. Miss Allen. In no case has the marriage of, e.g. a Mr Brown to a Miss Allen been recorded in this book since it is felt that such an entry provides too little data to be of value to most users. The date of marriage is replaced by the date the will identifying the bride and groom was written, the year being preceded by the abbreviation mwd = mentioned will dated. The year the will was written rather than the year it was proved is chosen because the former is frequently nearer to the actual marriage date. In North Kingstown the year the will was written has often been lost in which cases the year the will was proved was used instead indicated by the abbreviation mwp = mentioned will proved before the year. If a probate record other than a will was used the letters mp = mentioned probate record dated precede the year. These dates may be soon or many (perhaps 40) years after the date of marriage. The place of marriage is replaced by the town of residence of the father of the bride at the time of his death. Since during the time period covered people moved about far less than they do at present, and if they did move, removed usually only a relatively short distance, this difference is generally not too serious a matter. A particularly valuable feature of these records is that the father and/or mother (occasionally brother) of the bride is given in virtually every entry and frequently additional data is given on her grandparent(s). The very rare cases where no relative of the bride is given were usually obtained when an unmarried woman witnessed a will but was married when it was proved and her change in surnames at the two dates was explained in the original records.

The arrangement used in this compilation is that generally used for published marriage records. Surnames are arranged alphabetically, and given names are then arranged alphabetically (rather than chronologically as was done by James N. Arnold in his "Vital Record of Rhode Island") under the surnames. When the same given name is repeated several times, these are arranged chronologically. Each marriage is recorded twice, under the

name of the bride and under the name of the groom. Full data are given in each entry. The North Kingstown records were partially destroyed by fire, and occasionally the edges of the pages of any of the records may have crumbled with age. If a part of the record has been lost, the lost part is indicated by a dash. If a widow wrote her will not identifying her deceased husband, his name is replaced by a dash. In this case a bride would be recorded, for example, as Mary Brown of _____ & Elizabeth. It should be emphasized that such an entry merely indicates that the father's name is not given in the original record; in NO case does it imply illegitimacy. Since the date available is that of the will, rather than the actual marriage date, only the year the will was written is given, the day and month not being considered to be especially significant. The abbreviation dec after the name of the bride or the groom (or of some other person) indicates that he or she was deceased by the year given. Remarriages of widows have been included in this volume, but in each case it is clearly stated that the bride is a widow, and in most cases the full name of her former husband is given. In the old civil vital records where the father of the bride was only occasionally recorded, it is often impossible to recognize the remarriage of a widow since the record often omitted this fact.

The probate reference is given as follows: The towns are abbreviated as given below. The probate volume and page are then given, separated by a colon. In all the towns the early Town Council and Probate Records were combined in the same volume. About 1800 the towns of South Kingstown, Charlestown and Westerly began recording their Probate Records in separate volumes which were renumbered starting again with Vol 1. (Those wishing to use the original Westerly records should consult the Preface of the author's Vol 4 for a more detailed explanation of that town's numbering system.) For example SK 3A indicates South Kingstown Town Council and Probate Volume 3, while SK 3B indicates the later Probate Volume 3.

The wife mentioned in a father's will may or may not be the mother of his married daughters, or she may be the mother of some but not all of them. The wife mentioned in the will is usually recorded in this book as though she were the mother of

the married daughter with the CAUTION that this may not be true in all cases in which it is so recorded. If the wording of the will suggests that there is a doubt that the wife named in the will is the mother of the married daughters, her name is left out. Also the compiler has not knowingly entered any misinformation. Thus in a relatively small percentage of the cases he has information from other records showing that the wife mentioned in the will is not the mother of the married daughters, and in such cases her name has been left out. Another, presumably less common, source of error exists if a widow having married twice mentions no sons and only married daughters. These daughters may be the children of the widow's unmentioned first husband and their maiden names be different from their mother's surname when she wrote her will. Occasionally the relationships given in some probate records are not as clear and precise as one would wish. Rather than discard such data, the compiler has used them and added the word probably (abbreviated to prob) at an appropriate place in the entry to indicate that there is some uncertainty in the record as given. In an entry such as:

GARDNER, Mary of Samuel AND Mr Gardner mwp 1815.....
If no more were known it could not be told that a daughter called "my daughter Mary Gardner" in the will of her father Samuel Gardner was married to a Mr Gardner. Thus the other evidence in support of such a marriage is presented; e.g., if her child or children are mentioned, or if she is called a widow. See the complete recording of the above example on page 143.

For clarity a marriage entry giving considerable data on the ancestry of the bride will be explained in detail:

ALLEN, Lucy of Samuel (of Thomas, Jr & Patience (Green of Daniel)) & Prudence AND Dr Thomas Tillinghast mwd
1812 NK 11:16; 12:244,299; 19:45

The bride is Lucy Allen daughter of Samuel & Prudence Allen. Her father Samuel is the son of Thomas, Jr & Patience Allen. Patience wife of the bride's grandfather Thomas Allen Jr was the daughter of Daniel Green. Note her maiden name and her father's given name in the second set of parentheses. The groom was Dr Thomas Tillinghast. The names of the bride and groom are always separated by AND whereas the names of the parents or

grandparents of the bride or groom are separated by &. Lucy Allen and Thomas Tillinghast were married before they were mentioned in a will dated 1812. The probate references are North Kingstown Town Council & Probate Vol 11 page 16, Vol 12 pages 244 & 299, and Vol 19 page 45. If the maiden name of the bride's mother is known this is put in parenthesis along with the father of the bride's mother if given. If the father of the bride's (or groom's) father is given, his name is put in parenthesis. Occasionally data on even a further generation back is given requiring a double set of parentheses as in the example above.

A comparison of this work with the published "Vital Record of Rhode Island" Vol 5 Washington County by James N. Arnold seems to be in order. This record contains about 7600 entries, while Arnold's record of marriages in his Vol 5 covering the same geographical area contains about 9200 entries. More significant is the amount of duplication in the two works. Approximately one fourth of the marriage entries in this book were compared with Arnold's Vol 5 for duplication. Of these 21% were found to be duplicates of marriages recorded in Arnold's Vol 5. None of the marriages in the town of Westerly were included in this check. Since the recording of the civil vital records in Westerly appears to have been somewhat more complete than in some of the other towns, it is estimated that the percentage of duplication of this book as a whole compared to Arnold's Vol 5 is about 25%. In addition all the marriage entries in this book were compared with those in the marriage section of the author's Vol 3: "Washington County, Rhode Island Births and Marriages from Gravestone Inscriptions 1688-1850". Only about 10% of the marriage entries in this book duplicate those recorded in my Vol 3. Thus about 2/3 of the marriages recorded in this book give new otherwise unpublished data. Even in cases where duplication exists the identification of the parents of the bride is usually more complete in the probate records than in the published civil marriage records for the time period involved, making these records a useful supplement to those previously published. The marriages in this book which duplicate those in my Vol 3 have all been indicated. Thus

3-102) at the end of a marriage entry in this book indicates that the same marriage may be found on page 102 of my Vol 3. Of course the civil marriage records give an exact date and place of marriage and in some cases give data on the father (parents) of the groom which is only rarely given in the probate records. Because of the supplementary nature of all these records it is recommended that Arnold's Vol 5, this Volume and the author's Vol 3 all be checked and compared in attempting to solve genealogical problems.

In addition to such obvious abbreviations as Capt for Captain his book makes regular use of the following abbreviations:

When writing his will a father frequently mentions his daughter without giving her husband's given name. If there is no receipt signed by this son-in-law in connection with the will, or his name is not given elsewhere in the probate records (e.g. in the will of a brother of his wife which can be compared with her father's will), then the husband will appear in this book as Mr Brown or whatever. Since almost half the husbands in this book are identified only as Mr, the problem of identifying these persons has been a concern of the author. He has worked out a method of obtaining leads to the identity of some of these Mr's

which is best illustrated with an example, see p 9:
ARNOLD, Mr AND Eleanor Brown of Charles mwd 1786 Ex 7:267
First a check of Arnold's Vol 5 and the author's Vol 3 gives no duplicate of this entry. However other records of the author show an Edmund Arnold b 1758 d 1843 and his wife Eleanor b 1758 d 1843 who are buried in Exeter. They would have been 28 years old in 1786 and so could have been married before that date. Also Eleanor Arnold was mentioned as the wife of Edmund Arnold in his will dated 1838 proved 1843, NK probate Vol 29 page 156. (In other cases where a man died intestate (without a will) his widow was often named in connection with the administration of his estate or the taking of his inventory.) The foregoing does not prove that the Mr Arnold in the marriage on p 9 of this book is Edmund Arnold, but it is certainly a good lead to follow. Unfortunately leads can be found for only a small percentage of the Mr's in this book. An index of the husbands and wives from the Land Evidence would be very useful in this connection, but would require a great amount of effort to compile, and so at best is only a possibility far in the future. Users of this book who have found a Mr whose identity would be of especial value to them are invited to inquire of the author enclosing a SASE and they will be informed of the charge for the search. They should bear in mind that at present the chances of finding a lead are somewhat low--perhaps one in five. Also the system is of little value for very common names like John & Mary Smith.

The author wishes to express his thanks to those who have supported this work by purchasing earlier volumes, thus making a continuation of this series possible. He also invites readers to send him their suggestions, errors they may have found, and any questions or ideas they may have concerning future volumes in the series.

Dear Sir:

I do not have a Graves Registration Form to fill out, so I will supply grave data on one of my Revolutionary War ancestors by this letter. The ancestor is Thomas Baker, late of Sandy Creek, Oswego Co, NY. Most of the following was taken from his pension application affidavit of 24 September 1832, as amended 27 December 1832. His pension was granted. His file is No. S12097.

Excerpts
Thomas Baker was born 20 October 1751 in Colrain, (now) Washington Co, RI. He removed with his family to Colrain, Hampshire (now Franklin) Co, MA, where he enlisted in Capt. Hugh McLellan's company, Col. Maxwell's regiment of Minute-Men, probably in the later part of November, 1774. He remained in readiness until 21 or 22 April 1775, when he was assigned to Capt. Oliver's company, Col. Doolittle's regiment, and his company was ordered to march to Cambridge, MA in response to the Lexington Alarm. He participated in the Battle of Bunker (Breed's) Hill, then marched to Winter Hill, where he remained until 1 January 1776, participating in the siege of Boston. He remained with his company and reenlisted about 10 or 15 days later for one month. He was discharged in the last days of February and returned to his home in Colrain. His rank during this service was Private.

Thomas responded to a call on 25 June 1776 for 5000 men to reinforce the armies in Canada until the first of December 1776. He enlisted for five months and received a warrant as Second Sergeant. While some of the Hampshire Co troops went to Canada, Thomas' regiment marched to Ticonderoga on Lake Champlain. They remained there under General Gates until their term was up on 1 December 1776, when he was discharged and returned to Colrain.

Thomas married Esther (Henry) Carswell in Colrain about 16 December 1777. She was the daughter of Nathaniel Carswell, who also served in the Revolution in Charlotte (now Washington) Co, NY. Unfortunately, I have no burial data on him. Thomas moved his family to Salem, Washington Co, NY in 1816, then to the Town of Richland, Oneida Co (now the Town of Sandy Creek, Oswego Co), NY, where he remained until his death on 14 January 1840, at the age of 88. He is buried in the Noyes Cemetery in the southeastern region of the Town of Sandy Creek. I have visited his grave and can attest that this information is correct.

I will be looking forward to the forthcoming book of graves registrations, because I have several other Revolutionary War ancestors for which I have no definite death dates or places, and I hope to find that information in the book if I'm lucky enough to have someone else supply it.

Also, while the applications of Mrs. Hemphill and Mrs. Sharpe were made about 30 years ago, there is a good chance that either or both of them are still alive. Is there any way to obtain the current addresses of these ladies through the NSDAR records, or lacking that, having letters forwarded to them through the NSDAR?

As I said in my previous letter, my daughter is Judith Niles. Her application in the Katuktu Chapter in Tustin, California (based on a Porter ancestor) is being processed.
