sooner discharged by proper authority: Do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as
are, or may be, established by law for volunteers. And I, *Nicholas Corey*
do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the UNITED STATES OF
AMERICA, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all of their enemies or opposers
whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the
orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.
