ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is descended from a man or woman who, with unflinching loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Bylaws, Article III, Section 1.)

ANCESTOR'S SERVICES

My ancestor's (Nathaniel Carswell) place of residence during the Revolution was Salem New York, Washington Co. (formerly Charlotte Co. N.Y.)

My ancestor, Nathaniel Carswell, assisted in the establishment of American Independence during the War of the Revolution as follows:

Certificate 8633 for 16 shillings bearing interest from the 4th of November, 1779 was issued for services to Private Nathaniel Carswell under Captain M'Nitt in Colonel Alexander Websters Regiment of Charlotte County militia. (Charlotte became Washington County after the Revolution)

Certificate 9434 for 1 lb. 12 sh. bearing interest from 15th November, 1781.

These late incursions of British and Indians came through the area as far south as Schuylers "burning and marauding". Older men were then called upon for service.
