- Mustered in as Private 18 Feb 1864 at Detroit, Mich. in Co. B, 1st Regt., Mich. Sharpshooters for 3 years (Adjutant General report 30 Dec 1865).
- On muster out roll of Co. B, dated 2 Jul 1865, reporter died while a prisoner of war at Andersonville, Ga. 27 Aug 1864 of chronic diarrhea (Adjutant General report 30 Dec 1865).

Clark Fox, Jr. Enlistment, Service, Death

- Enrolled 15 Feb 1864 at Detroit, Mich. in Co. B, 1st Regt., Mich. Sharpshooters for 3 years (Adjutant General report 24 Jul 1865).
- Mustered in as Private 15 Feb 1864 at Detroit, Mich. in Co. B, 1st Regt., Mich. Sharpshooters for 3 years (Adjutant General report 24 Jul 1865).
- On Quarterly Report of Deceased Soldiers for second quarter of 1865 [sic], reported "Died of wounds at Spotsylvania May 12th 1864." (Adjutant General report 24 Jul 1865).

- Mustered in as Private Recruit 13 Feb 1864 at Detroit, Mich. in Co. C, 1st Regt., Mich. Sharpshooters for 3 years (Adjutant General report 17 Jul 1866).
- Records on file report him died at Andersonville, Ga. 27 Aug 1864 while a prisoner of war (Adjutant General report 17 Jul 1866).

- Died 27 Mar 1865 of pneumonia in General Hospital, Annapolis, Md. (Adjutant General report 12 Sep 1885).
